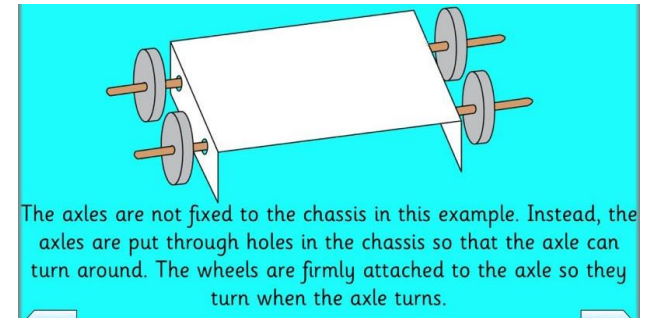


The aim of this unit is for children to understand the importance of the axle and make a moving vehicle. Use these pictures to help draw your design.



The axles are not fixed to the chassis in this example. Instead, the axles are put through holes in the chassis so that the axle can turn around. The wheels are firmly attached to the axle so they turn when the axle turns.

Ideas of resources you can use to help make your chosen vehicle.

Bottle lids as wheels., pipe cleaners, lolly sticks, pencils or straws as the axle to hold the wheels.

Cardboard box for the main chassis of the vehicle eg tissue box, juice carton box, cereal box, egg tray.
