of the **underlined** words

given.

using your new words.

Write some **facts** you
have learnt from
reading this piece of
non-fiction text.

Reading Task Card 7
Pick a descriptive word from the text, write it down and, using a thesaurus, write down five **synonyms** and **antonyms** for that word.

Reading Task Card 8
Re-read a chapter. Pick out three words that you feel are **powerful words** and that you could use in your own writing in the future.

Reading Task Card 9
How does the story hook you in at the beginning? Make a list of **words and phrases** that you feel are effective in making you want to read on.

Reading Task Card 10
Draw and label a **character** from a description in the book.
