3/ Revise adjectives describing animals (grand, petit, énorme, gros, gentil, rigolo, intelligent, féroce) including colours. Please see below some new adjectives, you don't need to learn them all!

Now make a sentence describing an animal! For example: Le singe est rigolo. (The monkey is funny.) or L'ours est énorme et gris. (The bear is enormous and grey.)

You could draw an animal and describe it by writing a sentence in French.

Remember the rule, if the noun is feminine (une, la) you need to add “e” at the end of the adjective.
