1/ Listen to this video to learn the members of the family in French. The ones you need to know are “père, mère, grand-père, grand-mère, frère, soeur”. Don't worry too much about “oncle et tante” but it is up to you if you want to learn them! ☺
Make sure you listen a few times to familiarise yourself with the pronunciation of the words. Remember to repeat after each word in French.

The very first part of the video you will hear some Arabic being spoken, the French part begins after that.

For example: Voici **mon** père. (This is my father.)

Voici **ma** mère. (This is my mother.)

Also pay careful attention to “**mon, ma**” and the difference between them.
