Weather and cities + song

1/ Recap the weather in French if needed from week 7 and “weather and cities” from week 9. You should be feeling more confident about saying the weather in French!

2/ On the powerpoint (slide 2), do activity “Vrai ou Faux” (True or False).

3/ Listen to the weather song (link below) or the one on the powerpoint (click on “slide show” in the menu and then “from beginning”).

Now write your own French weather song or rhyme using towns! Look at a map of France to find names of towns or use the powerpoints (week 9 and week 10)

For example: A Paris, il y du vent.
A Lyon, il fait beau.

Use the question as much as you want in your song: Quel temps fait-il? or Quel temps fait-il aujourd’hui? (today)

Try using conjunctions in some of your sentences.

For example: A Marseille, Il y a du soleil **et** il fait chaud.
A Bordeaux, Il fait chaud **mais** il y a du vent.

Write a song or rhyme with a minimum of 6 weather sentences with names of towns!
