Step 1 – compose a rhythm. (Ex. Ta ta tika tika ta/ ta ta z ta)

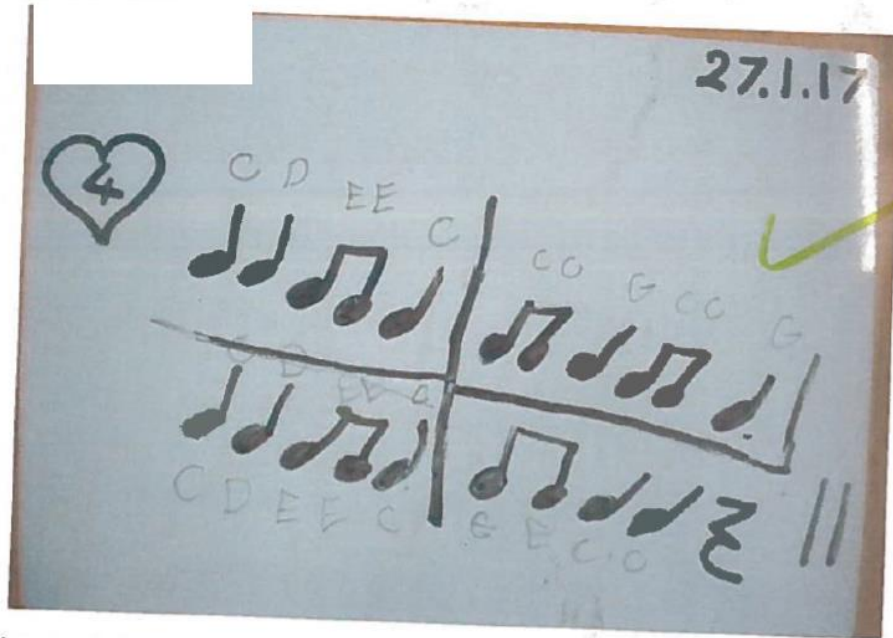
Step 2 – choose a few notes to go along with your rhythm. Stick to only 3-5 notes.
