

## Y6 Week 12 French

### Sounds in French and word bank

1/ Listen to the sounds in French in slide 2 and 3 in the powerpoint. Make sure you repeat each time.

2/ Look at the 6 sounds on the slide 4 (on the powerpoint). Find at least 5 French words for each sound. Think of words that we have learnt since year 3! Remember the different topics that we learnt: numbers, colours, fruits, days, months, body parts, size adjectives, personality, zoo animals, family, pets, names of buildings and shops, food and drinks, hobbies and sports, musical instruments, weather, seasons, classroom objects, clothes, school subjects, adjectives describing hobbies and school subjects, adverbs, conjunctions. If you really struggle to find 5 words for each sound, you can also look for new French words. Ensure that you translate all the words as well. Write all French words plus translation on a piece of paper.

3/ Choose some of these words that you have found and make a sentence with them! 😊

**Safe:** Choose 5 words and make 5 sentences.

**Stretch:** Choose 7 words and make 7 sentences.

**Super-stretch:** Choose 10 words and make 10 sentences.
