Timetable and school subjects

1/ Name as many school subjects as you can! You learnt them last week! If you can't remember them all listen to this video again. Repeat each time.

2/ Practise time, days of the week and school subjects by looking at the timetable written in French. (see folder called "timetable")

I want you to practise talking about the timetable by asking questions and given answers in French. All explanations and examples are given on the following two sheets underneath the timetable including how to say the time in French.

3/ Make your own timetable in French! You can either make up your own timetable or do the one you are doing at home or the one you used to do at school. It is up to you but **it must be only written in French, no English at all!!!!** You can draw your own timetable or you can use the blank timetable from the same folder.

Toolkit of your timetable:

1. Title in French (mon emploi du temps en 6ème année)
2. Days of the week in French
3. Time
4. School subjects in French (apart from English and Maths, I like to see a wide range of subjects! Not just sciences every afternoon of the week for example!)
5. Use a ruler when drawing lines!
6. Neat writing with no spelling mistakes! (everything is provided!)
7. Use different colours for days, time and school subjects
8. Colour in the background
9. Draw some symbols next to the school subjects
For example: Français with a little French flag next to it! 😊
10. Write some questions and answers around your timetable in French!

Numbers 7, 8, 9 and 10 are not compulsory but still it will make your timetable prettier to look at! 😊 Please make sure you keep this timetable safe as I would like to be able to display them when you are back in school! You can always send them to me if you don't want to wait. Hope you have fun doing it! 😊
