Opinions et matières (School subjects) + why

1/ Revise opinions, school subjects plus “why” using the pdf file. You should be able to say which school subject you like or don’t like and say why. All examples are in the pdf file, please read each slide carefully. I also talk about adding adverbs in your sentences (you learnt them previously alongside Hobbies).

2/ Make a colourful poster about which school subject you like or don’t like and why. Draw yourself with speech or thought bubbles around it. In each bubble, write a sentence about which school subject you like or don’t like and why. Draw the school subjects that you are talking about as well.

Toolkit of your poster:

1. You need a A4 or A3 plain paper.
2. Draw yourself neatly with a pencil or colour pencils (no pens please!)
3. Write each sentence neatly and correctly spelt in each speech or thought bubbles.
4. Make your own sentences!
5. Write a **minimum** of four sentences.

Safe: Example: J’aime le français parce que c’est intéressant.

Stretch: Example (use “et”, “mais” or “aussi”): J’aime le français parce que c’est intéressant **et** amusant.

Super-stretch: Example (use “et”, “mais” or “aussi” and adverbs, see list on the pdf file): J’aime le français parce que c’est **toujours** intéressant **et** amusant.

You could write a range of safe, stretch and super-stretch sentences if you like! 😊

6. Make your poster colourful and well-presented!
