English

Reading focus

- Explore and explain new vocabulary.
- Retrieve information from texts.
- Sound out most unfamiliar words accurately.

Genres of writing that will be covered

- Use expanded noun phrases
- Use apostrophes for contractions and singular possession

Multiplication and division

- Solve problems involving multiplication and division

<u>Shape</u>

 Name and describe properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes, including number of sides, vertices, edges, faces and lines of symmetry.

Measurement

- Measure height and length (m and cm)
- Compare and order lengths record the results using >, < and =

Fractions

- Recognise, find, name and write fractions 1/3, 1/4, 2/4 and 3/4 of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.
- Recognise the equivalence of 2/4 and 1/2

Science and Computing

Science

- Materials. How can we describe materials? How do we use materials around us?
- Living Things and Habitats:_What is a habitat? Computing
- Robot Algorithms and Pictograms: Describe instructions as a sequence. Recognise pictorial tallies.
