English

Reading focus

- To infer from characters feelings and actions.
- To deduct information from texts.
- To explain the meaning of words in context.

Genres of writing that will be covered

- Non-fiction: Non-Chronological reports

Mathematics

Number/Place value

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100; find 10 or 100 more or less than a given number
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones)
- Compare and order number up to 1000

Addition and subtraction

- Add & subtract number mentally including:
- Add and subtract numbers with up to three digits, using formal written methods of column addition and subtraction
- Solve problem, including missing number problems, using number facts, place value, and more complex addition and subtraction.

Multiplication and division

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.
