English

Reading focus

- To infer from characters feelings and actions.
- To deduct information from texts.
- To make predictions based on clues from the text.

Genres of writing that will be covered

- Fiction: Legends
- Non-fiction: Discursive writing.

Science

Living things and their habitats. Teeth and the digestive system

<u>Computing</u>

 Repetition in shapes: How can we use programming language to draw shapes? Data logging: How can data help an investigation?

History and Geography

- Natural Resources, Renewable Energy and
- Sustainable: Do we, as humans, do enough to preserve our supplies?

Art and D&T

- Print making: What is a relief painting?
 Exploring different techniques
- Textiles: Why are there different types of stitches?

Physical Education

- Dance: Constructing more complex motifs using own ideas for movement.

Mathematics

Multiplication and division

- Recall multiplication and division facts for up to 12 x 12.
- Multiplying three numbers together.
- Multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100.
- Solving story problems.
- Known facts: Ex: if I know 7 x 3 = 21, then I know 3 x 7 = 21, 21 ÷ 3 = 7, 21 ÷ 7 = 3, 30 x 7 = 210 etc.

Fractions / Decimals

- Adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator.
- Identifying equivalent fractions.
- Finding common denominators.
- Comparing fractions.
- Mixed numbers and improper fractions.
- Solving story problems.

PSHE and RE

<u>PSHE</u>

- Dreams and goals: learning about jobs and careers
- Healthy me: Looking at healthy diets and lifestyles

<u>RE</u>

 What is the significance of Easter? How do sacred scriptures inform religious beliefs?

French

- Topics are: describe yourself, zoo animals, Easter.
- Recognise noun, verb and adjective in a sentence.
- Exploring sounds in words through rhymes and songs and listening to short stories.

Music

- Explore instrument families through the works of famous composers.
- Develop singing and performance skills in preparation for the year group assembly.
