


Author Visit with Clare Helen Welsh

Dear Children and Families,



Lenny the Lemur is on holiday in the Amazon rainforest. He's just settling down for a nice snooze, when a very yucky smell wafts past. Poo-ie!


What or *who* could it be?

Learn about wolves, mountain goats, caribous and more in this piddle-tastic tale *Wee? It Wasn't Me!*




AERODYNAMICS OF BISCUITS (paperback)




