



Snakes and Ladders Ideas

If you have a snakes and ladders board, try some of these ideas to practice lots of number skills as you play!

Roll the dice and count on ensure that one space is moved to count on each spot on the dice

Roll the dice and count on the number of spaces relating to the number on the dice

Roll the dice and find its number bond to 10 and move that number forward (e.g. roll a 6, so move on 4 because $6+4=10$)

Roll 2 dice and move on the number bond to 20 (e.g. roll $6+6=12$, so move on 8 because $12+8=20$)

Roll 2 dice and move on the total of the 2 dice

Roll a digit dice and a spotty dice, put the first number in your head and count on to find the total

Roll the dice and double the number, moving forward that number of spaces

Roll 2 dice and find the difference - then move that number forwards

Roll the dice, if it is odd double it, if it is even halve it and move that number forward

Start at the finish of the board, roll a dice and subtract that number (e.g. start at 50, roll a 7, $50-7=43$ so move to number 43)

Roll the dice, if you land on an odd number move on an extra 2 spaces

Roll the dice, if you land on a multiple of a number move on an extra space (e.g. practicing 5 x table, if you land on multiple of 5 move on extra space)
