We are writing to you to share an update on Sports days at the Infant and Junior schools. In line with current guidelines we can only allow 1 parent per child in each class to spectate. There will not be a toilet available for the 30 minute sessions so please plan your morning accordingly. Every parent must wear a face covering while on the school site and maintain social distancing.
