

An attractive 19th century period cottage, with undoubted potential occupying an established and desirable location with easy access to the village centre, mainline station, and open countryside.

THE PROPERTY

The entrance hall gives access to the ground floor cloakroom/utility room and also to the spacious dining room with its open fireplace and fitted units to either side. There is an archway from the dining room which leads to the sitting room which has exposed ceiling timbers, polished wood flooring and an open fireplace. The kitchen is equipped with Shaker units and there is access to the rear lobby which in turn leads to the rear garden. To the first floor there are three good size bedrooms, all with fitted/built-in wardrobe cupboards and the family bathroom is also of excellent size. Off the first-floor landing there is an attic staircase which gives access to the attic room, which is pine clad with heating and a window.











THE GROUNDS

The property is approached by a long shared driveway, which leads to the property, attached single garage and parking for at least four cars, extra parking could be created if needs be by reducing the large lawned area to the front of the property. This area has featured Laurel hedging and post and rail fencing. The rear garden is enclosed and enjoys a high degree of privacy, with two areas of terracing, one of which is raised and paved and surrounded by flower borders. The lawn is level and similarly raised and is surrounded by mature cultivated hedging and established boundaries. The rear garden is south-facing.

SITUATION

88 Midhurst Road occupies an extremely convenient location and is accessible to open countryside, a short walk of the main line station and village centre. The property is set back in a tucked away location, approached by a shared drive and close to the mainline station with its superb services to London Waterloo and the south coast. The village itself provides an excellent range of local amenities including a Sainsbury's superstore, a traditional bakery and a range of other independently owned shops. Within walking distance are some excellent schools including Bohunt Academy with its sixth form, whilst in the private sector there is easy access to both Churchers Juniors and Highfield and Brookham. The surrounding area is noted for its natural beauty much of which is owned by the National Trust or sits within the South Downs National Park. Close by are some excellent walks at Iron Hill, Stanley common and Linchmere Common.








SECOND FLOOR


