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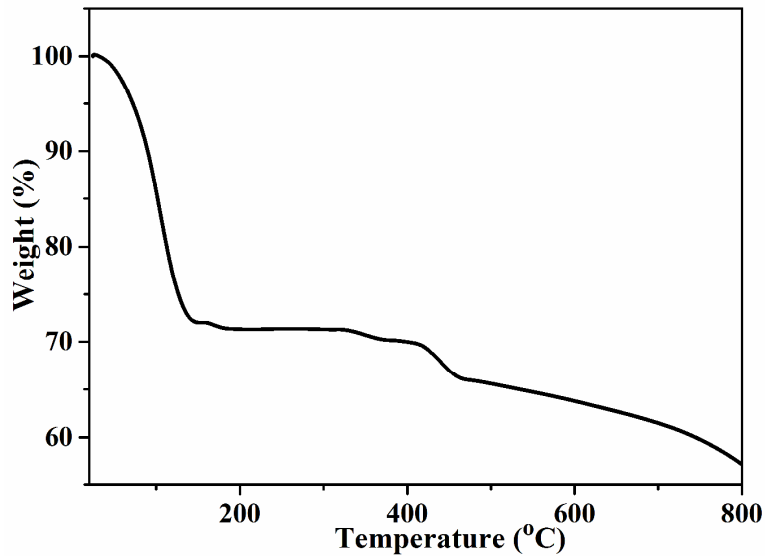


Figure S1. The TGA curve for **1**.

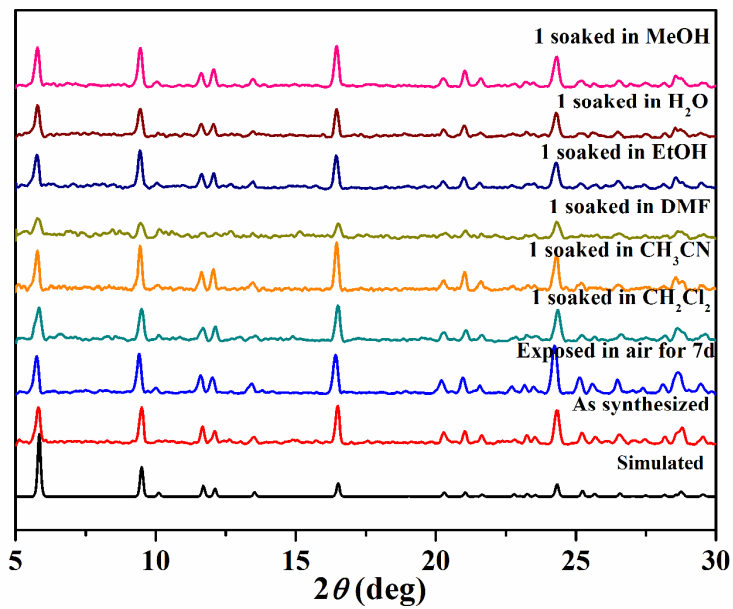


Figure S2. The PXRD patterns of **1** under different conditions.

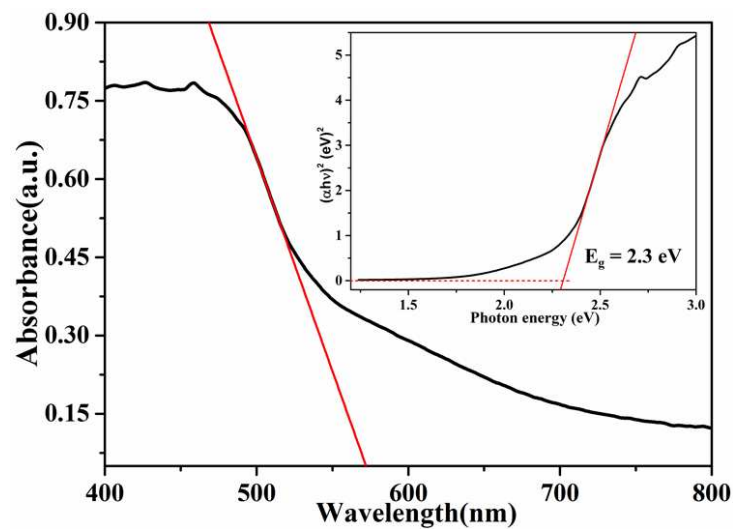

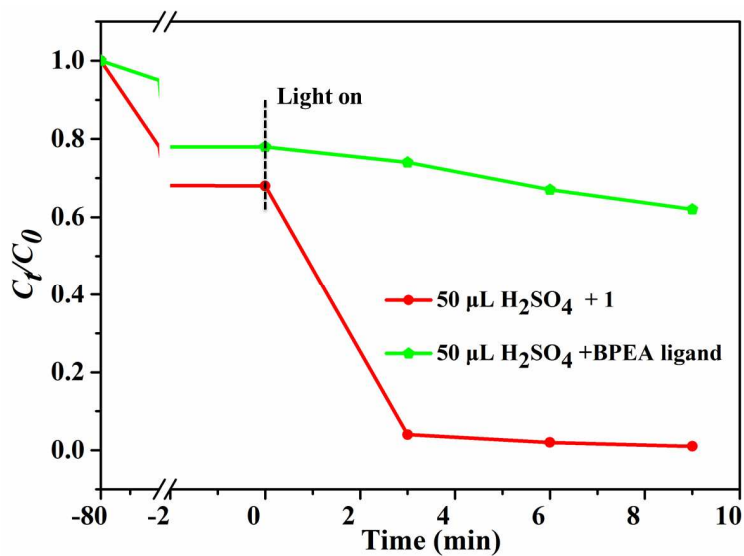


Figure S4. A comparison study of the photocatalytic reduction of Cr(VI) over **1** and BPEA ligand under the same condition.

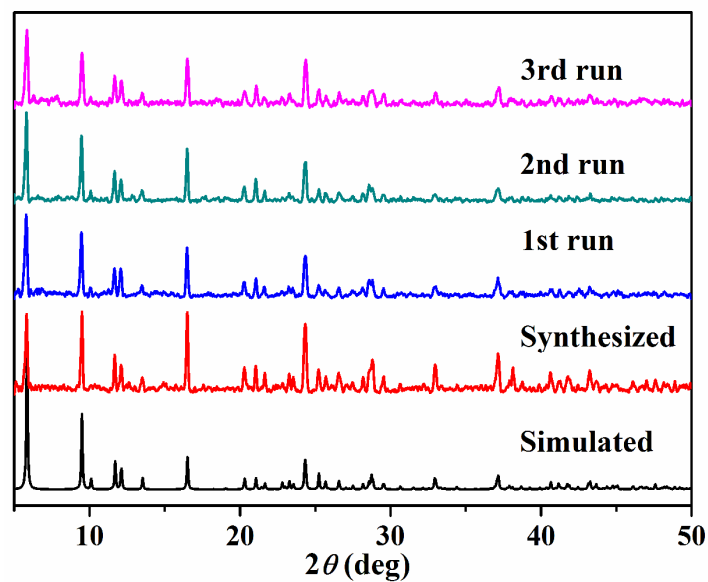


Figure S5. The PXRD patterns of **1** in the three cycles of photocatalytic reduction of Cr(VI) processes.

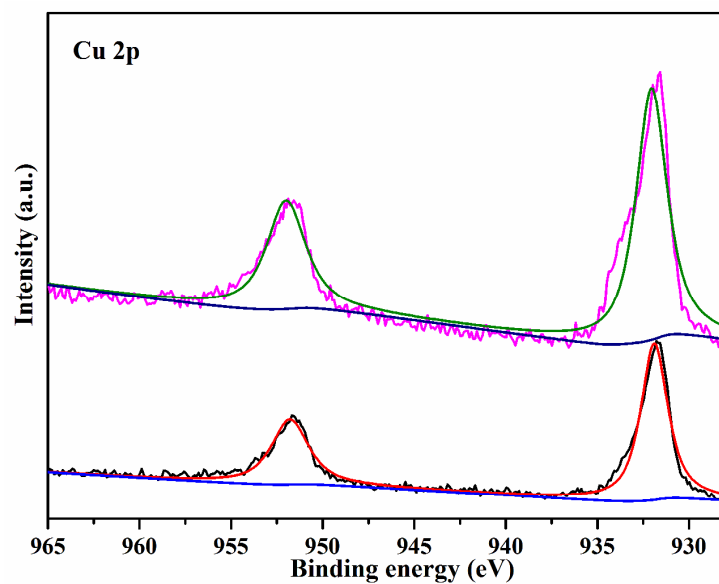


Figure S6. XPS of Cu in **1** before and after photocatalytic reduction of Cr(VI) processes.

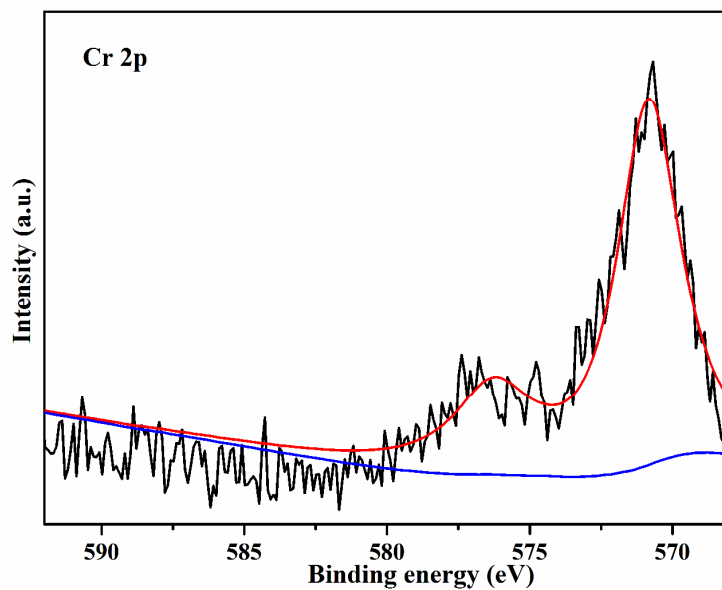


Figure S7. XPS of Cr in **1** after photocatalytic reduction of Cr(VI) processes.

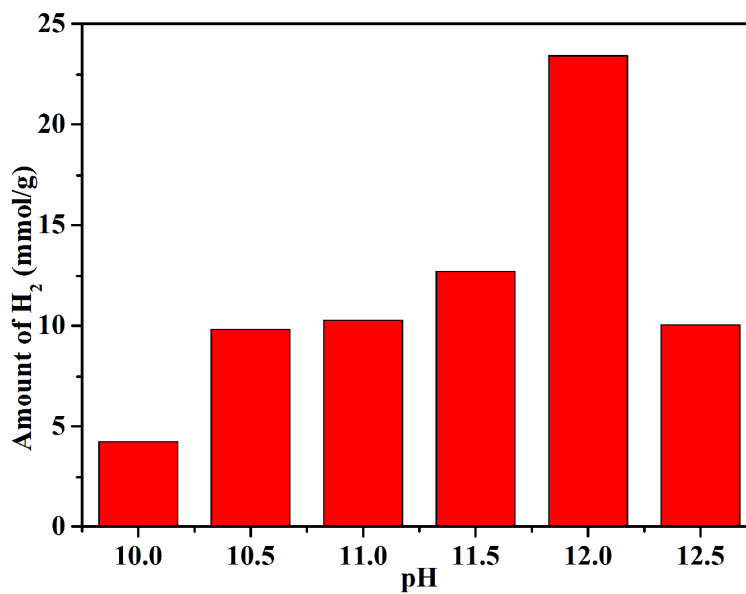


Figure S8. The photocatalytic H₂ evolution amount of **1** in five hours under different pH values.

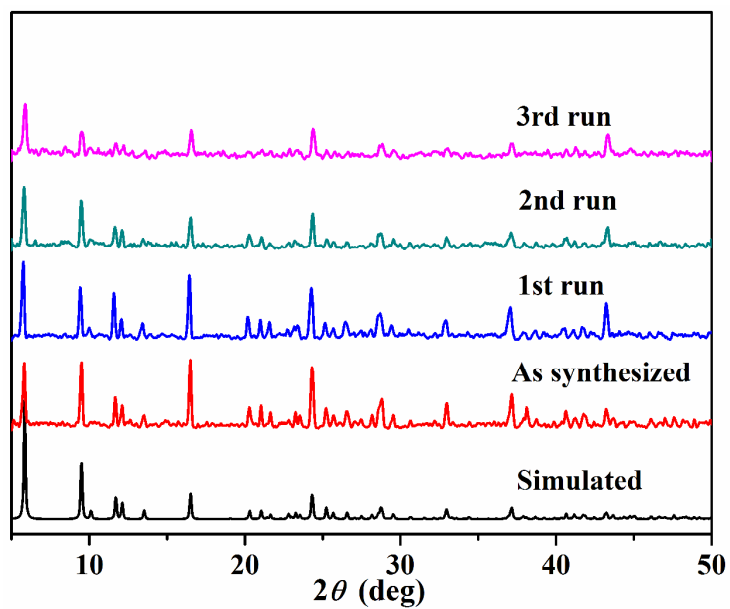


Figure S9. The PXRD patterns of **1** in the three cycles of photocatalytic H₂ evolution processes.

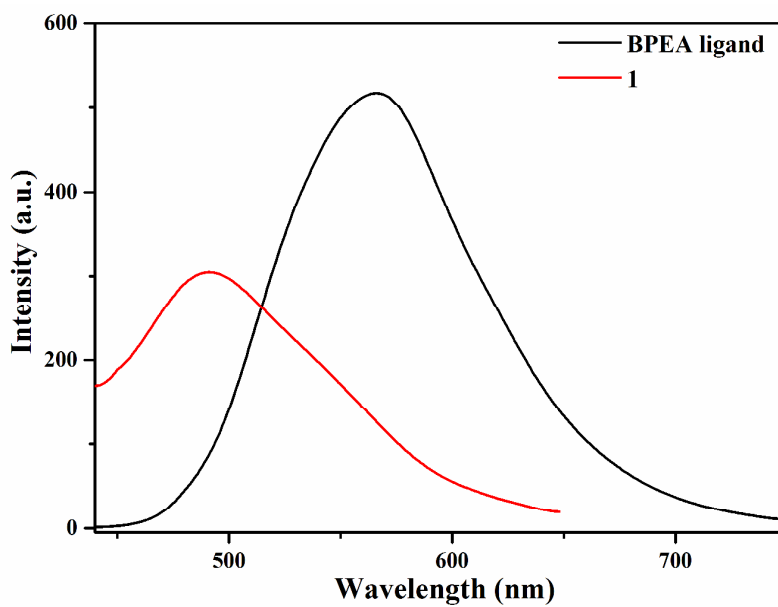


Figure S10. The solid-state PL spectra for BPEA ligand and **1**.
