## **Experimental Procedures**

#### 1. Materials

The cobalt salts including  $CoF_2$ ,  $Co(OAc)_2$ ,  $Co(CIO_4)_2 \cdot 6H_2O$ ,  $CoBF_2$ ,  $Co(BF_4)_2 \cdot 6H_2O$ ,  $Co(acac)_2$  and  $Co_2(CO)_8$ , other metal salts including  $Cu(OAc)_2 \cdot H_2O$ ,  $Ni(OAc)_2 \cdot 4H_2O$  and  $Fe(OAc)_2$ , bases including  $K_2CO_3$ , KOH,  $K_3PO_4$ , tBuOK and  $Cs_2CO_3$ , ligands including  $P(CH_2CH_2PPh_2)_3$ , triphos, dppp, BINAP, 2-Bis(diphenylphosphino)ethane, tris(pentafluorophenyl)phosphine, PPh<sub>3</sub>, biPy, o-Phenanthroline and 1,3,5-triaza-7-phosphaadamantane, anhydrous solvents including ethyl alcohol (EtOH), dichloromethane ( $CH_2CI_2$ ), toluene, n-heptane, tetrahydrofuran (THF), 1,4-dioxane, acetonitrile ( $CH_3CN$ ), N,N-dimethylformamide (DMF), dimethyl sulfoxide (DMSO) were purchased from commercial sources (J&K Scientific Ltd. and Innochem Science & Technology Co., Ltd.) and were used without further purification.  $CO_2$  (purify of > 99.99%),  $H_2$  (purify of > 99.99%) was supplied by Beijing Analytical Instrument Factory.

#### 2. Instrumentation

 $^{1}$ H NMR spectra were acquired at 400 MHz from solutions in CDCl<sub>3</sub> on a Bruker Avance NMR spectrometer (400 MHz) at ambient temperature; chemical shifts are given in ppm relative to tetramethylsilane (TMS). GC analysis was performed on Agilent 7890B with a FID detector and a nonpolar capillary column (DB-5) (30 m × 0.25 mm × 0.25  $\mu$ m). The column oven was temperature-programmed with a 2 min initial hold at 323 K, followed by the temperature increase to 538K at a rate of 10 K/min and kept at 538 K for 10 min. High purity nitrogen was used as a carrier gas. The gaseous mixture was collected and analyzed by gas chromatography equipped with thermal conductivity detector (4890, Agilent Technology) with Argon as the carrier gas. The GC-MS analysis was performed using gas chromatography-mass spectrometry (GC-MS, 7890A and 5975C, Agilent).

#### 3. General procedure for the synthesis of 1c

All the reductive coupling reactions were performed in a 16 mL high-pressure reactor with a Teflon inner container in batch operation mode. Typically, in a glovebox, hexylamine (101 mg), cyclohexanecarboxaldehyde (112 mg),  $CoF_2$  (10 mg),  $PP_3$  (34 mg),  $Na_2CO_3$  (160 mg) and EtOH (3 mL) were loaded into the reactor. The autoclave was screwed up, charged with  $CO_2$  to 3 MPa, then  $H_2$  to total pressure of 6 MPa and transferred to an oil bath at 140 °C, which was controlled by a Haake-D3 temperature controller. After the reaction, the reactor was cooled in iced water and the gas inside was carefully vented. The yield was determined by <sup>1</sup>H NMR, calibrated using 1,1,2,2-tetrachloroethane as the internal standard. For yield determination of the products shown in Scheme 2, the reaction mixture was firstly analyzed by GC-MS and <sup>1</sup>H NMR to determine the structures and yield of the unsymmetrical NNFAs products. Then, the crude reaction mixture was concentrated by a rotary evaporator and purified by column chromatography to give the isolated compound. **1c** was obtained and purified by column chromatography, with 93 % isolated yields of **1c** (109 mg), using petroleum ether/ethyl acetate (100 : 1 – 5 : 1) to get the pure product.

### **Results and Discussion**

### 1.Effects of ligands

## **Control experiments**

#### 1. Typical procedures for control experiments

**For Scheme 2a:** CoF<sub>2</sub> (10 mg), P $P_3$  (34 mg), K<sub>2</sub>CO<sub>3</sub> (160 mg), **1a** (101 mg), **1b** (112 mg) and EtOH (3 mL) were loaded into a stainless steel autoclave with a Teflon tube (25 mL inner volume) under N<sub>2</sub> atmosphere. The autoclave was sealed, and the reactor was charged with  $^{13}$ CO<sub>2</sub> up to 1 MPa and then with H<sub>2</sub> until the total pressure reached 4 MPa at room temperature. The autoclave was moved to an oil bath of 140 °C, and magnetically stirred for 24 h. After reaction, the autoclave was cooled down to room temperature, and the gas inside the reactor was vented slowly. The reaction product was analysed by GC and GC-MS.

**For Scheme 2b:**  $CoF_2$  (10 mg),  $PP_3$  (34 mg),  $K_2CO_3$  (160 mg) and EtOH (3 mL) were loaded into a stainless steel autoclave with a Teflon tube (25 mL inner volume) under  $N_2$  atmosphere. After the autoclave was sealed, it was charged with  $CO_2$  up to 3 MPa and then with  $H_2$  until the total pressure reached 6 MPa at room temperature. The autoclave was moved to an oil bath of 140 °C, and magnetically stirred for 24 h. After reaction, the autoclave was cooled down to room temperature, and the gas inside the reactor was vented slowly. The reaction product was analysed by  $^1H$  NMR, calibrated using 1,1,2,2-tetrachloroethane as the internal standard.

For Scheme 2c:  $CoF_2$  (10 mg),  $PP_3$  (34 mg),  $K_2CO_3$  (160 mg), 1a (101 mg), 1b (112 mg) and EtOH (3 mL) were loaded into a stainless steel autoclave with a Teflon tube (25 mL inner volume) under  $N_2$  atmosphere. After the autoclave was sealed, and it was charged with  $H_2$  up to 3 MPa, and then moved to an oil-bath of 140 °C. After magnetically being stirred for 24 h, the autoclave was cooled down to room temperature, and the gas inside the reactor was vented slowly. The reaction product was analysed by GC-MS.

For Scheme 2d:  $CoF_2$  (10 mg),  $PP_3$  (34 mg),  $K_2CO_3$  (160 mg), HCOOH (92 mg), N-hexyl-hexanamine (185 mg) and EtOH (3 mL) were loaded into a stainless steel autoclave with a Teflon tube (25 mL inner volume) under  $N_2$  atmosphere. The autoclave was moved to an oil bath of 140 °C, and magnetically stirred for 24 h. After reaction, the autoclave was cooled down to room temperature. The reaction product was analysed by GC-MS.

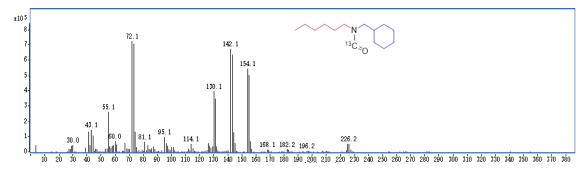
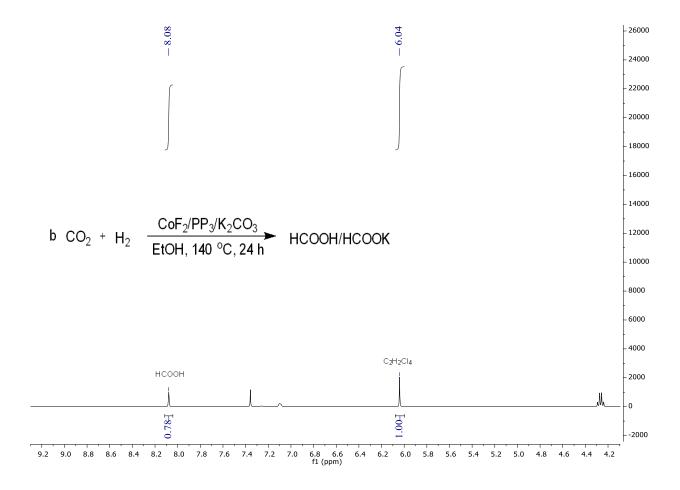

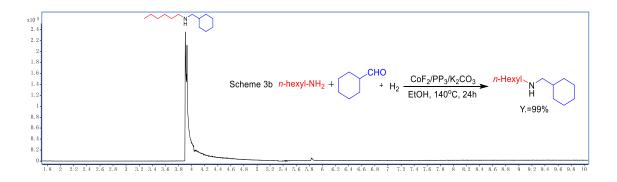


Figure S3 GC-MS spectrum of the product of Scheme 2c.

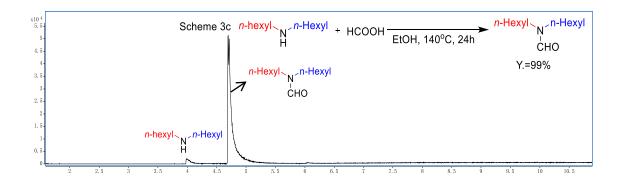
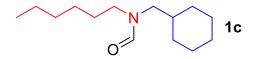
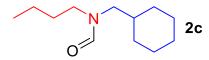


Figure S4 GC-MS spectrum of the product of Scheme 2d.

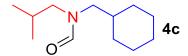
