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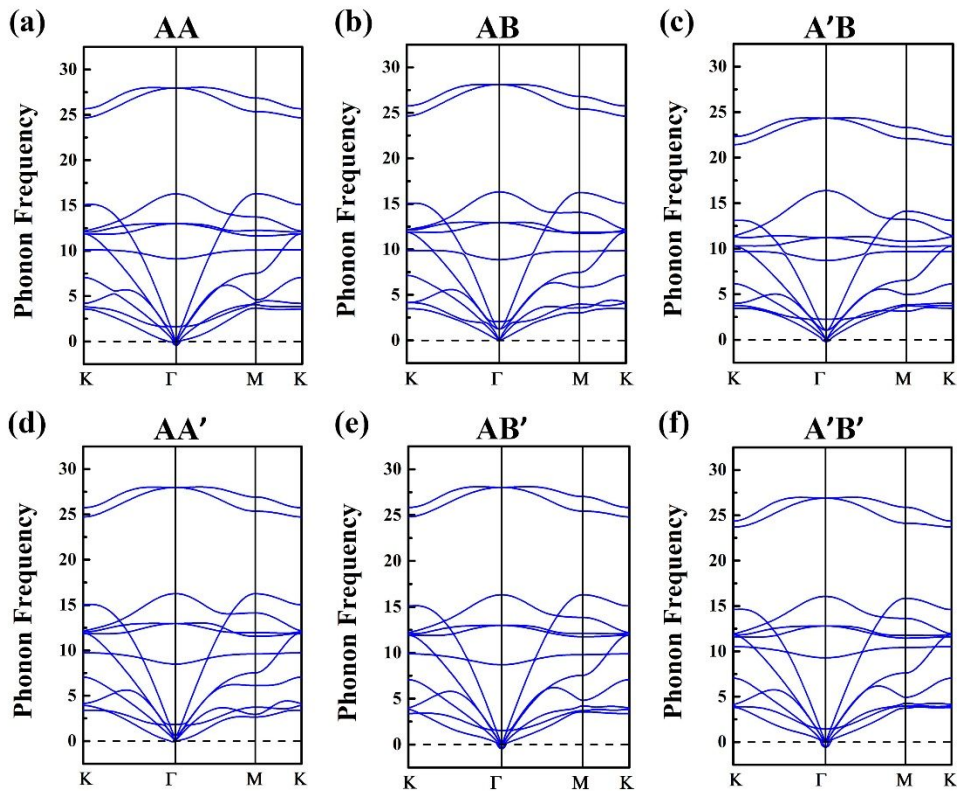


Figure S1. The phonon frequency for each stacking pattern.

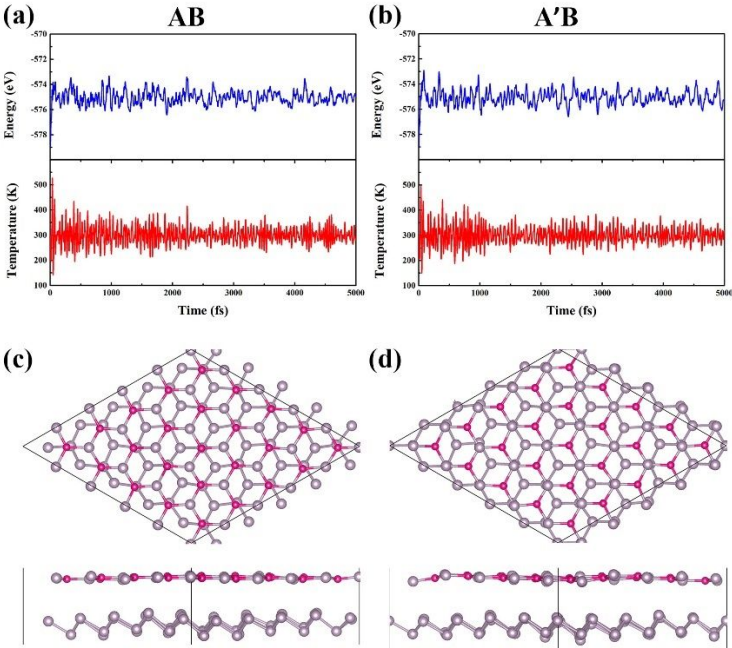

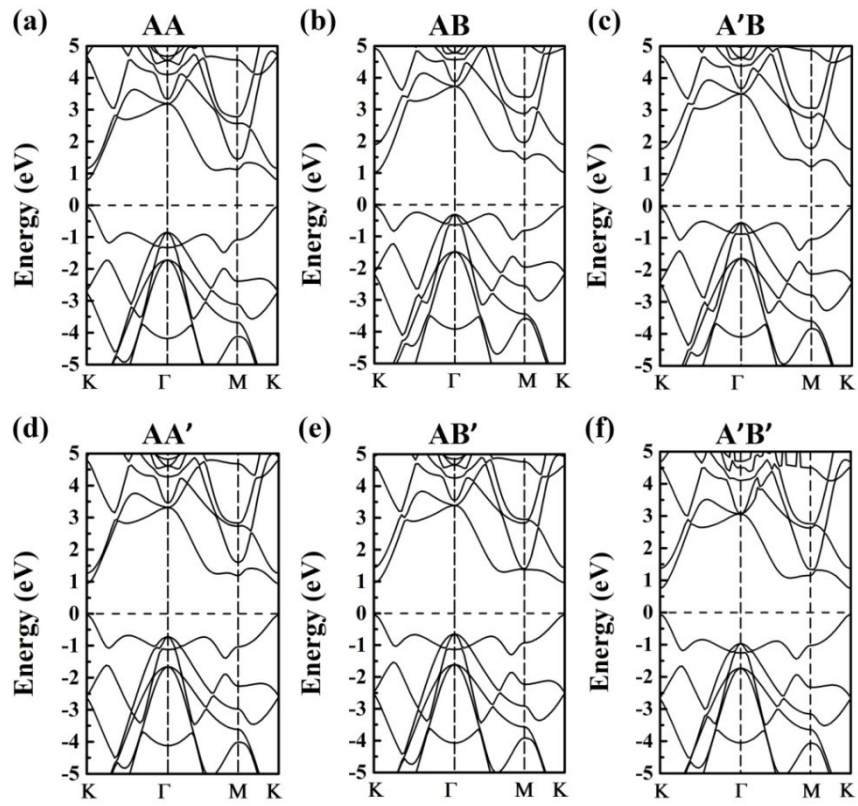

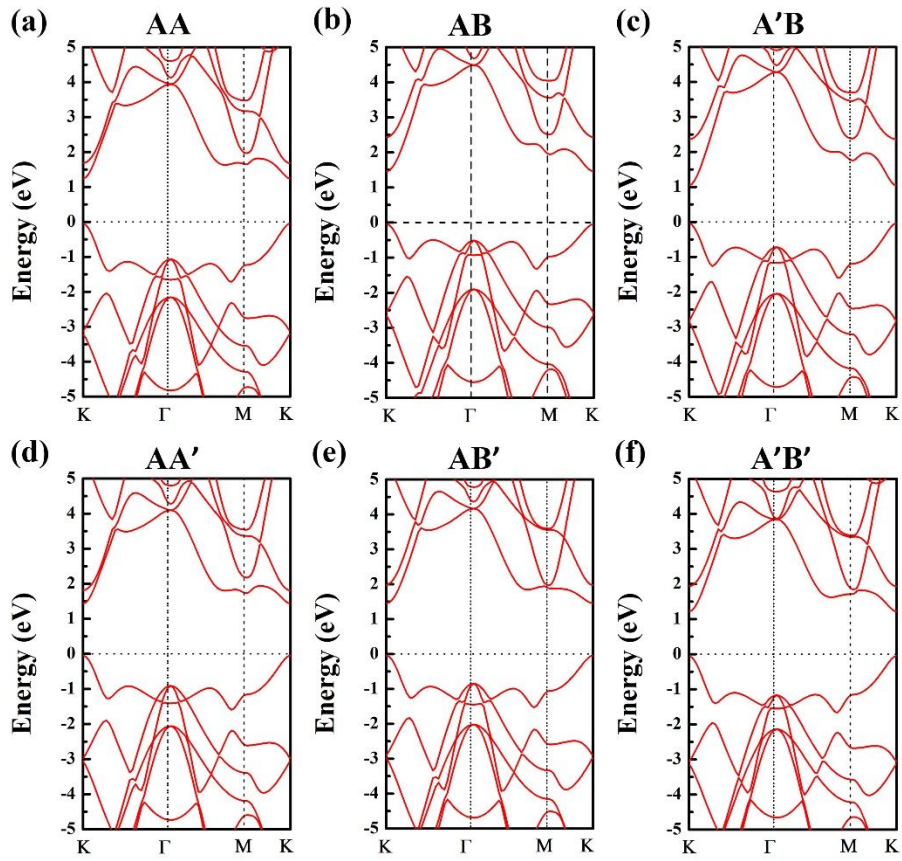

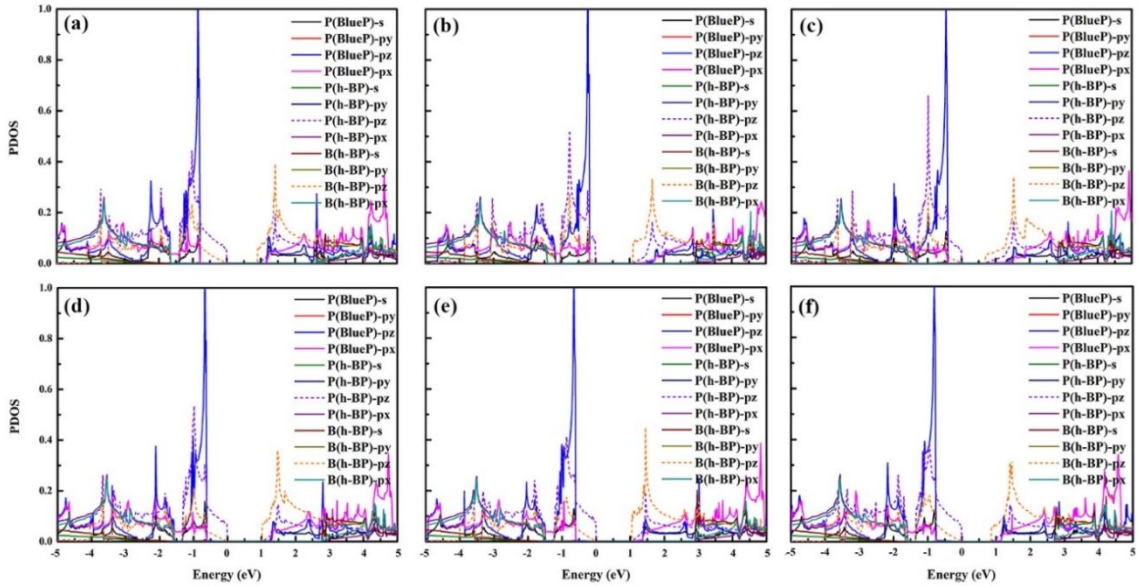

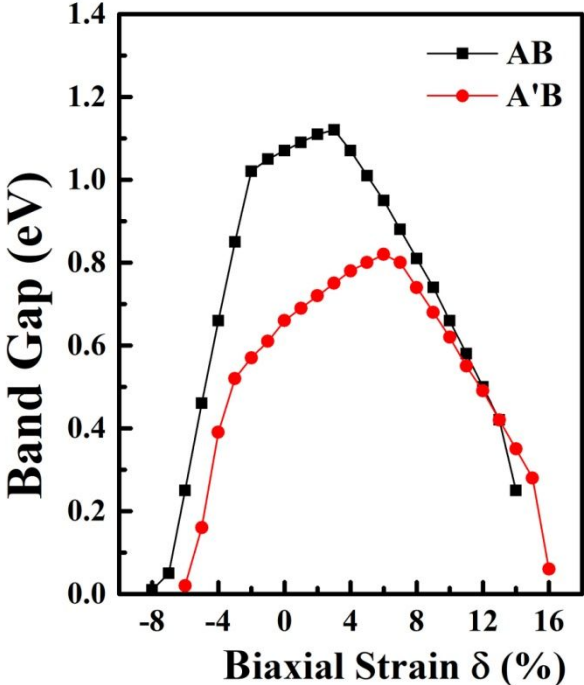


Figure S6. Energy band gap as a function of biaxial strain δ .
