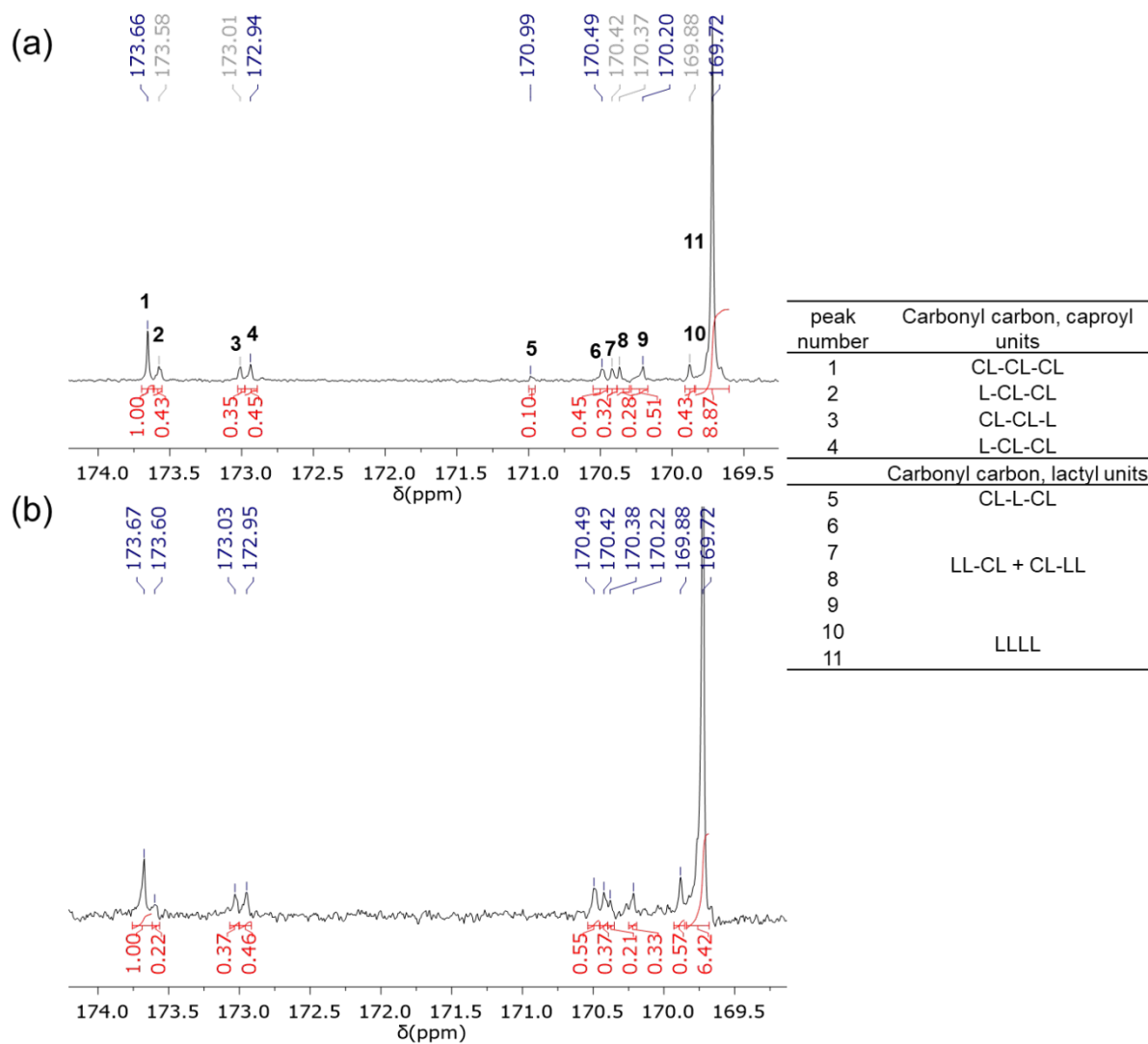


Figure S1. (a) Carbonyl region of ^{13}C NMR spectra of PCLA raw material and (b) PCLA_232.

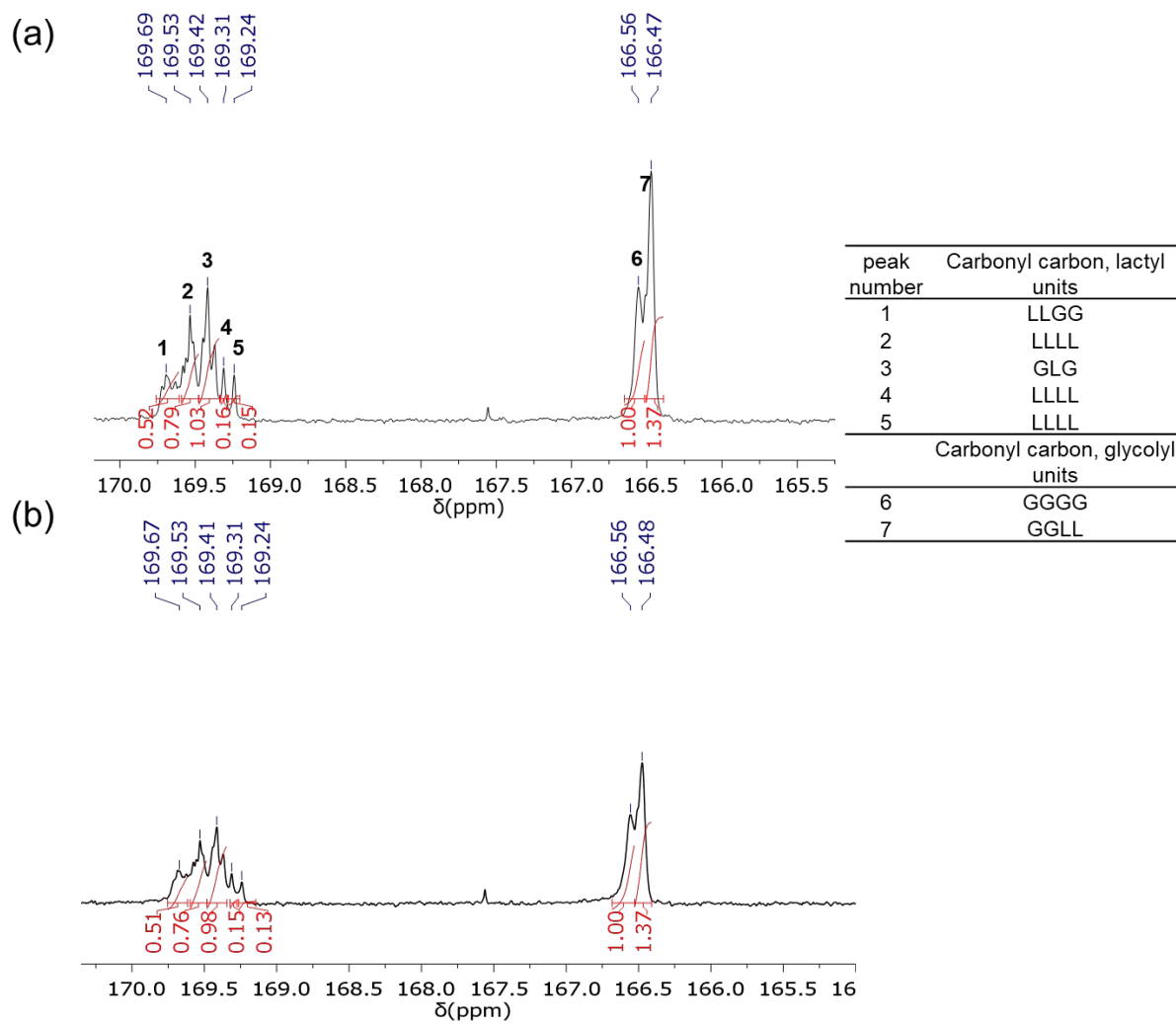


Figure S2. Carbonyl region of ^{13}C NMR spectra of PDLGA raw material (a) and PDLGA_328 (b).
