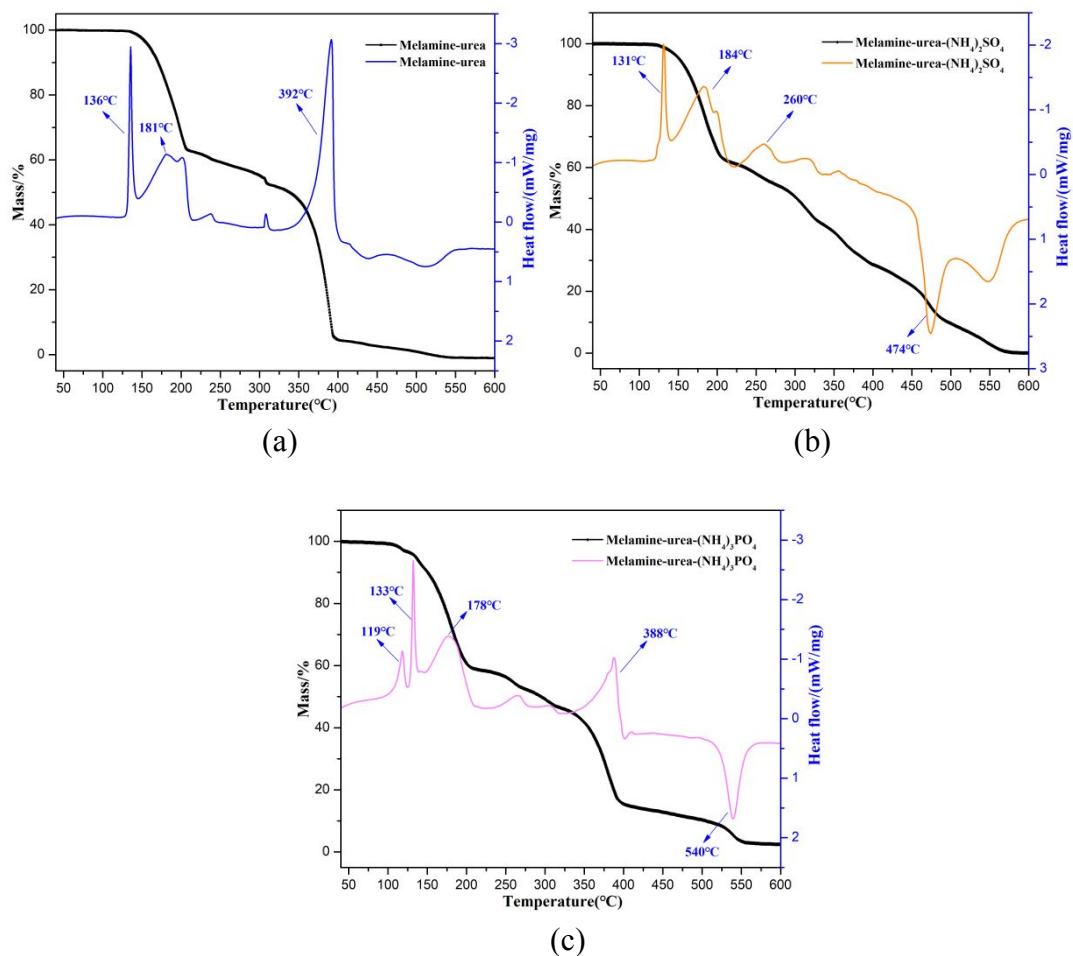

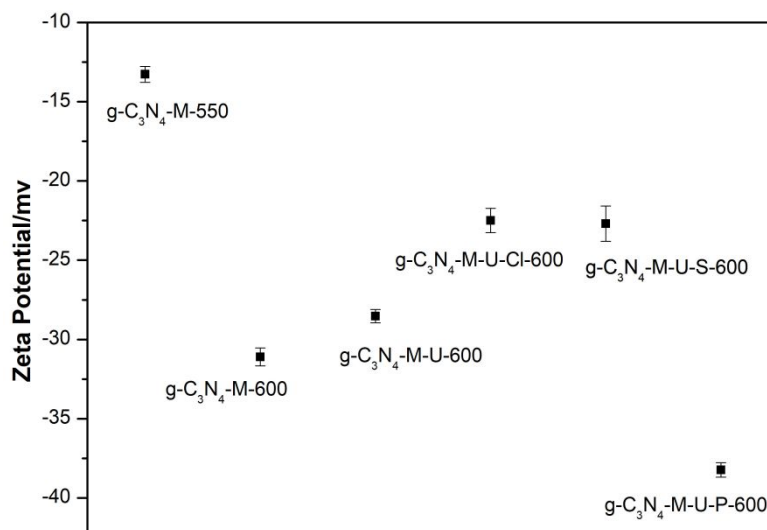


Figure S2. The Zeta potential of the adsorption samples dispersed in deionized water.

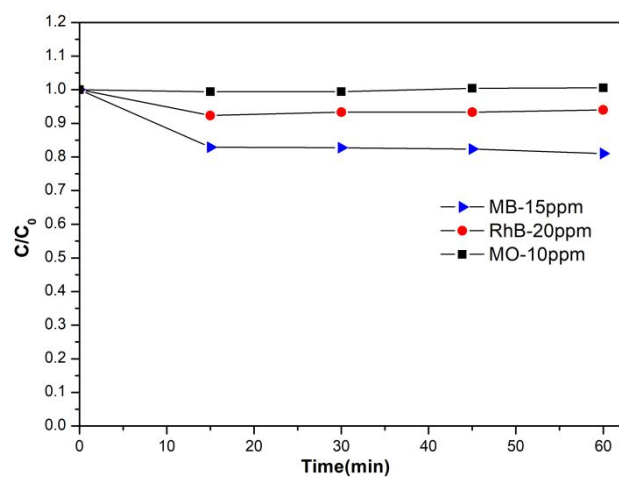


Figure S3. The dye adsorption vs time in the dark condition of g-C₃N₄-M-550.
