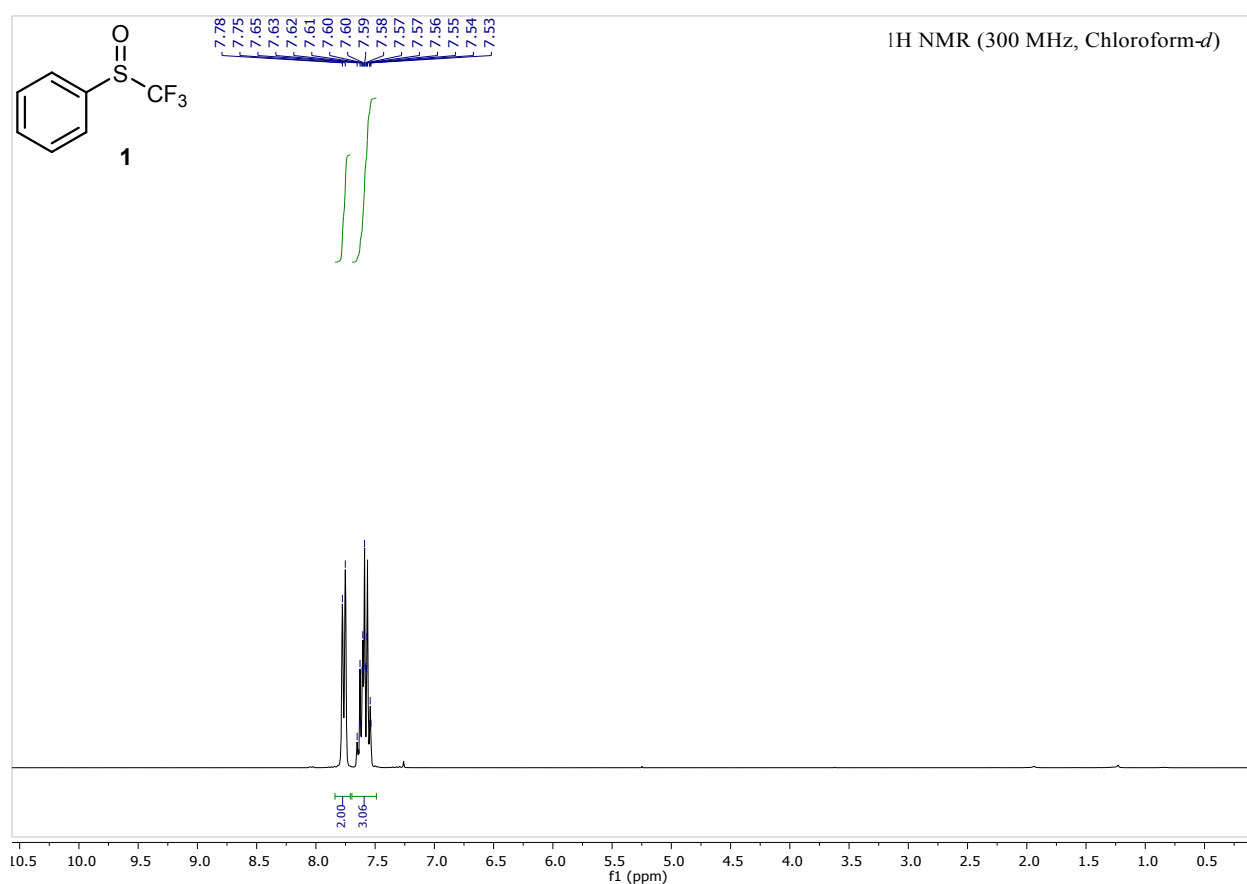
### General information

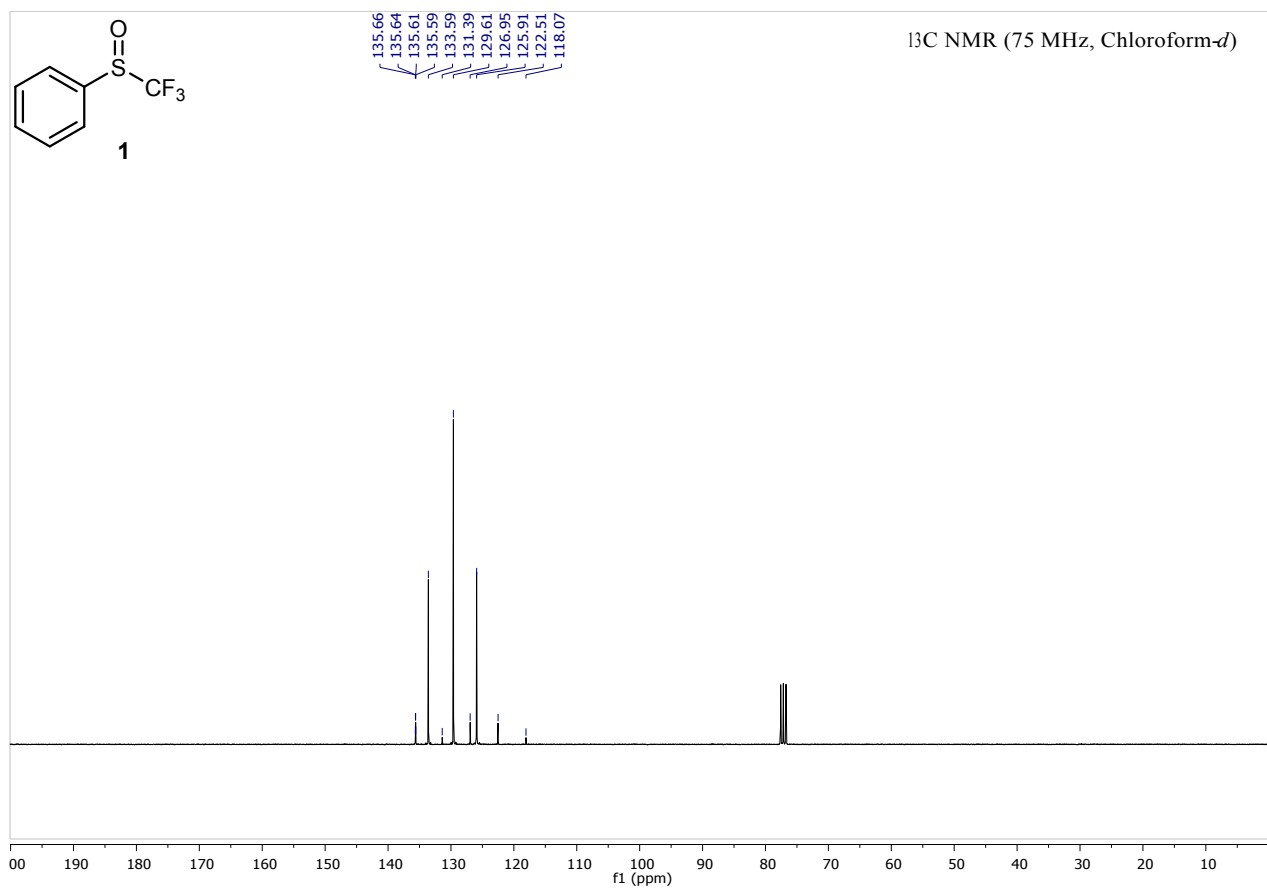
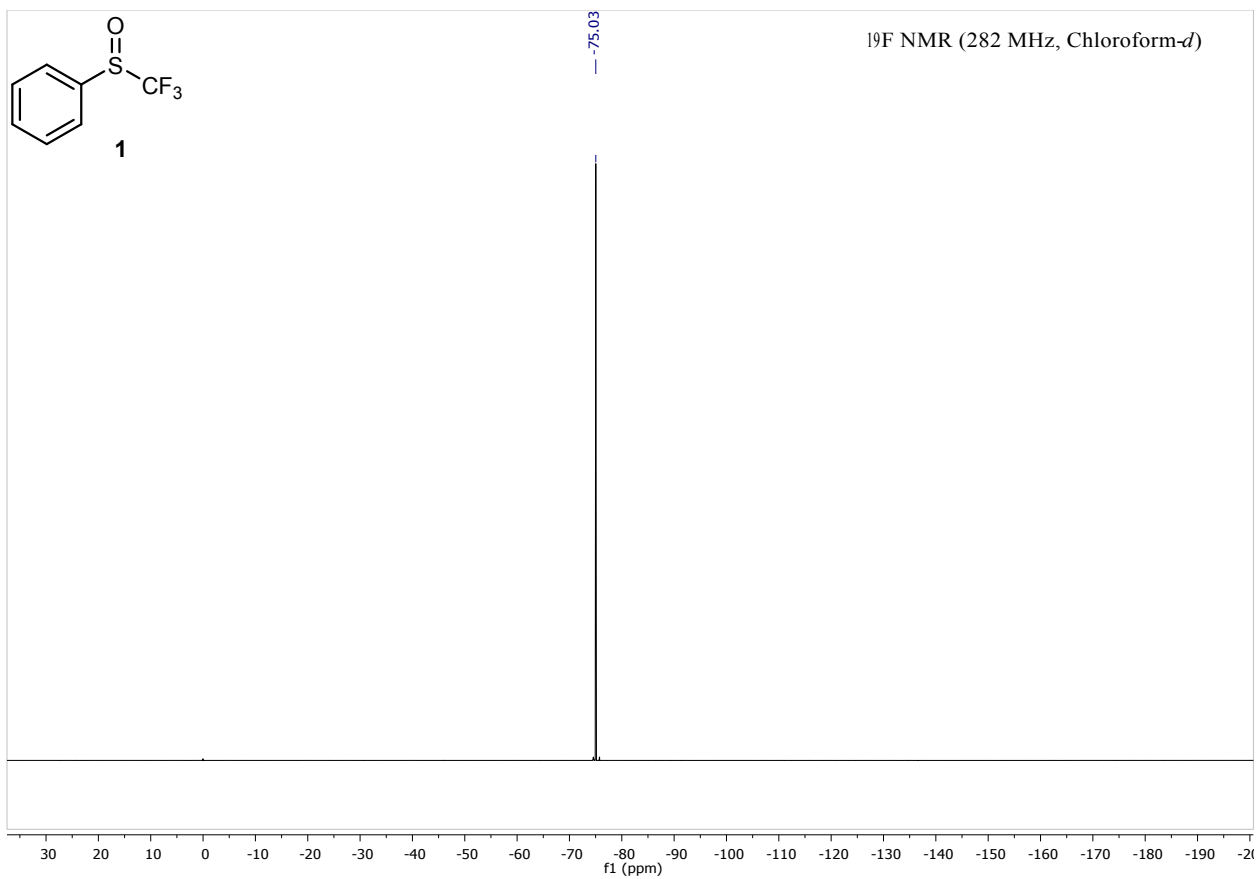
Commercial starting materials and solvents were used without further purification. Nuclear magnetic resonance (<sup>1</sup>H NMR, <sup>19</sup>F NMR and <sup>13</sup>C NMR) spectra were recorded on a Bruker AC-300 spectrometer in CDCl<sub>3</sub>. Reported coupling constants and

chemicals shifts were based on a first order analysis. Internal references were the residual peak of  $\text{CHCl}_3$  (7.26 ppm) for  $^1\text{H}$  (300 MHz) NMR spectra, central peak of  $\text{CDCl}_3$  (77.16 ppm) for  $^{13}\text{C}$  (75 MHz) NMR spectra, and  $\text{CFCl}_3$  (0.00 ppm) as internal reference for  $^{19}\text{F}$  (282 MHz) NMR spectra. Multiplicities are indicated as follows: s (singlet), d (doublet), t (triplet), q (quartet), m (multiplet), br (broad).

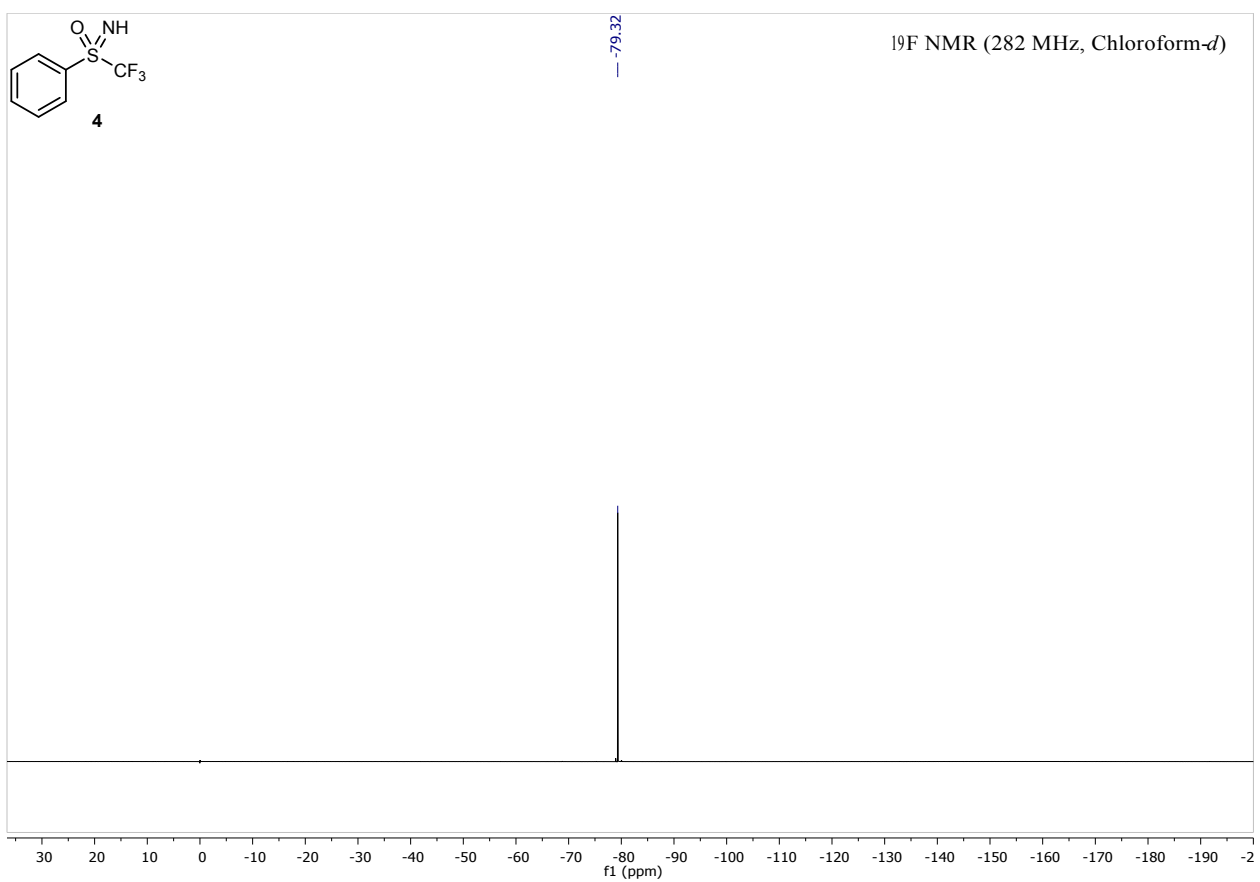
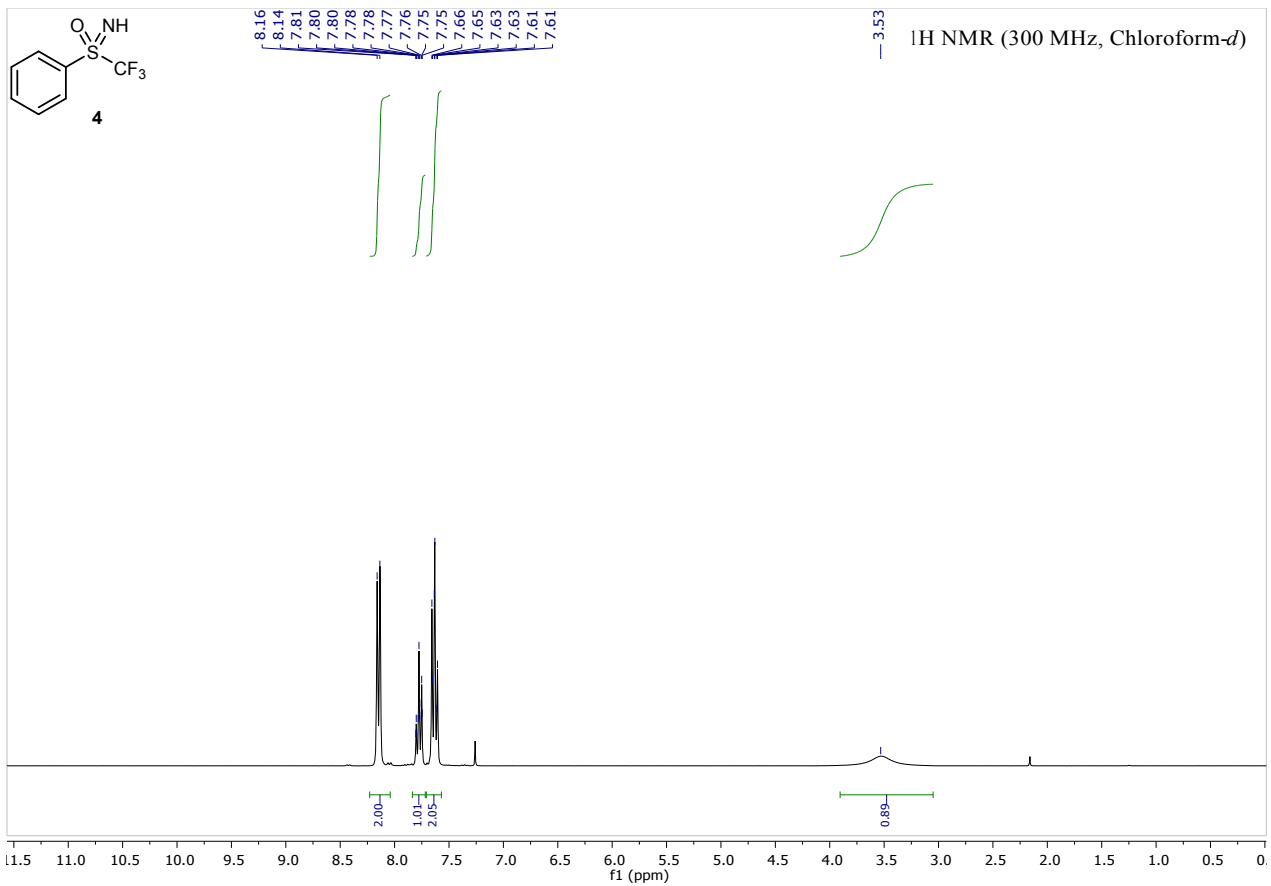
## NMR Spectra of the compounds 1, 4 and 5

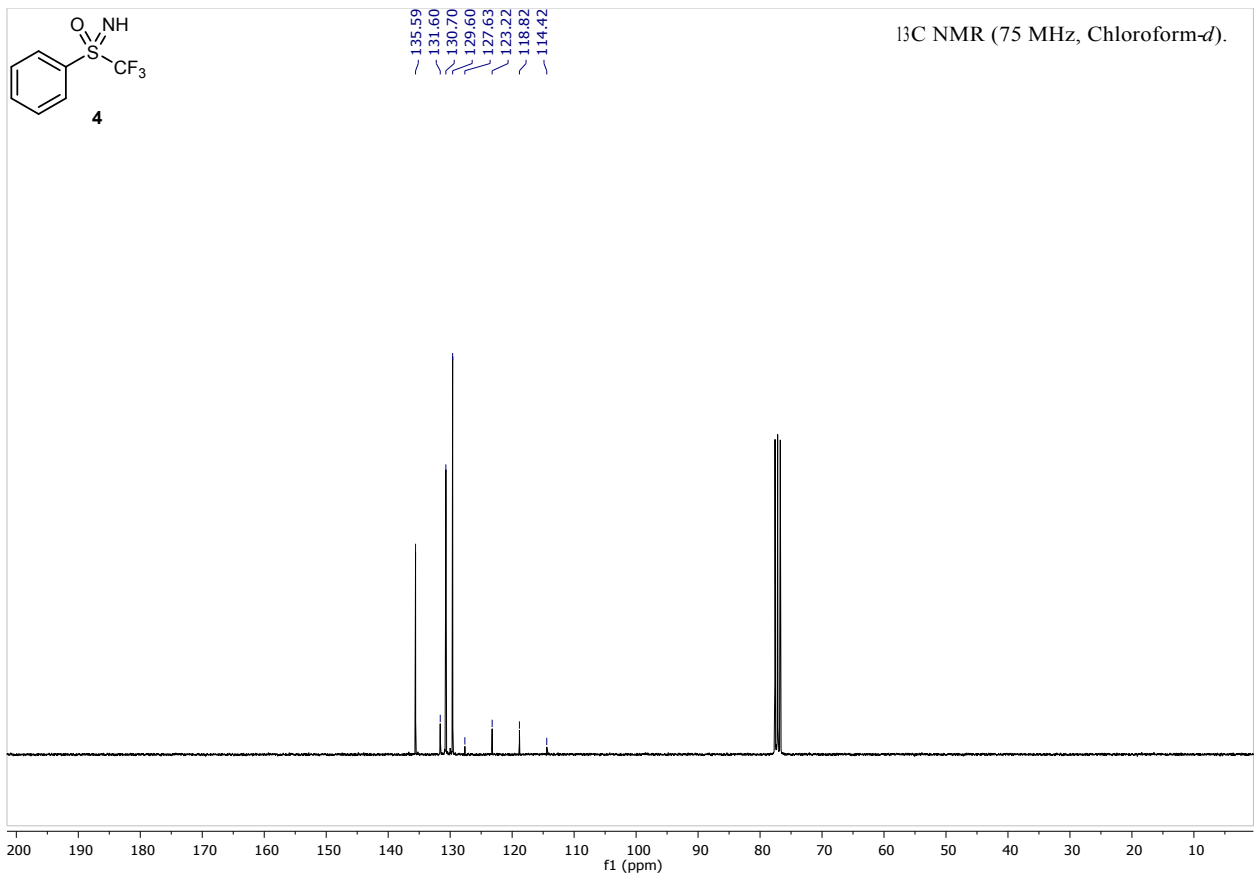
### 1) NMR spectra of 1
