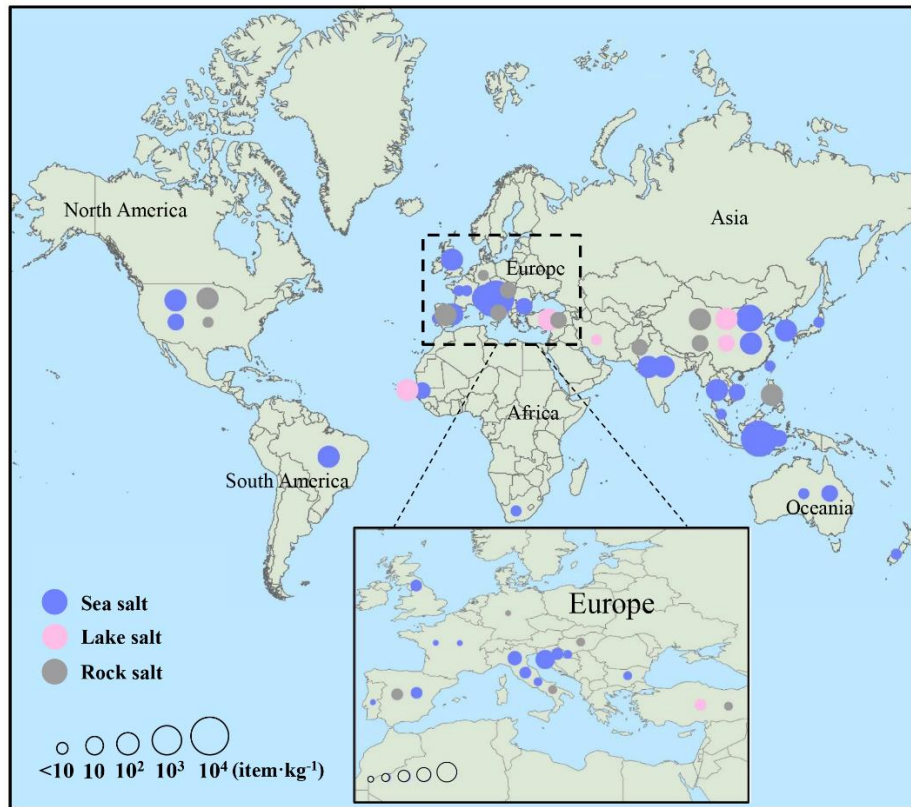


Figure S1. Geographical distribution of microplastic pollution in table salt covering 28 countries.
