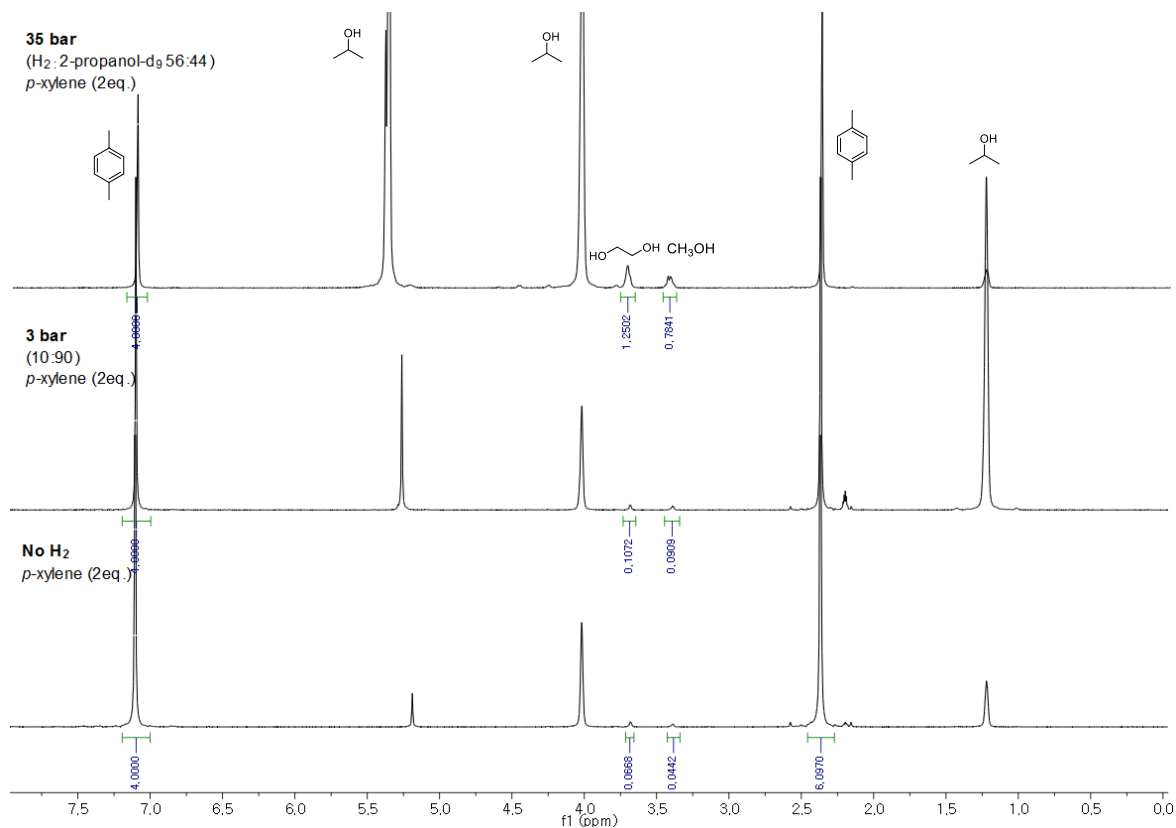

**Figure S2. <sup>1</sup>H NMR Spectra for Deuterium Incorporation Study (entries 3, 5, and 7, Table 5)**

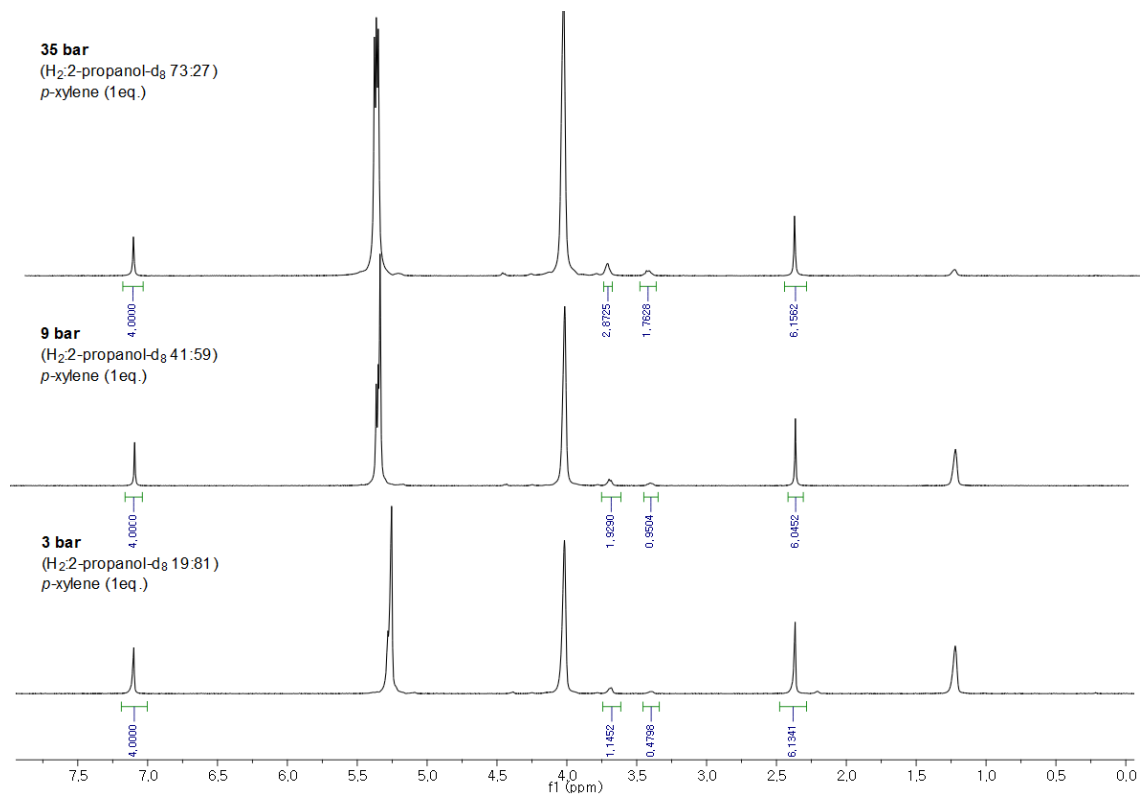
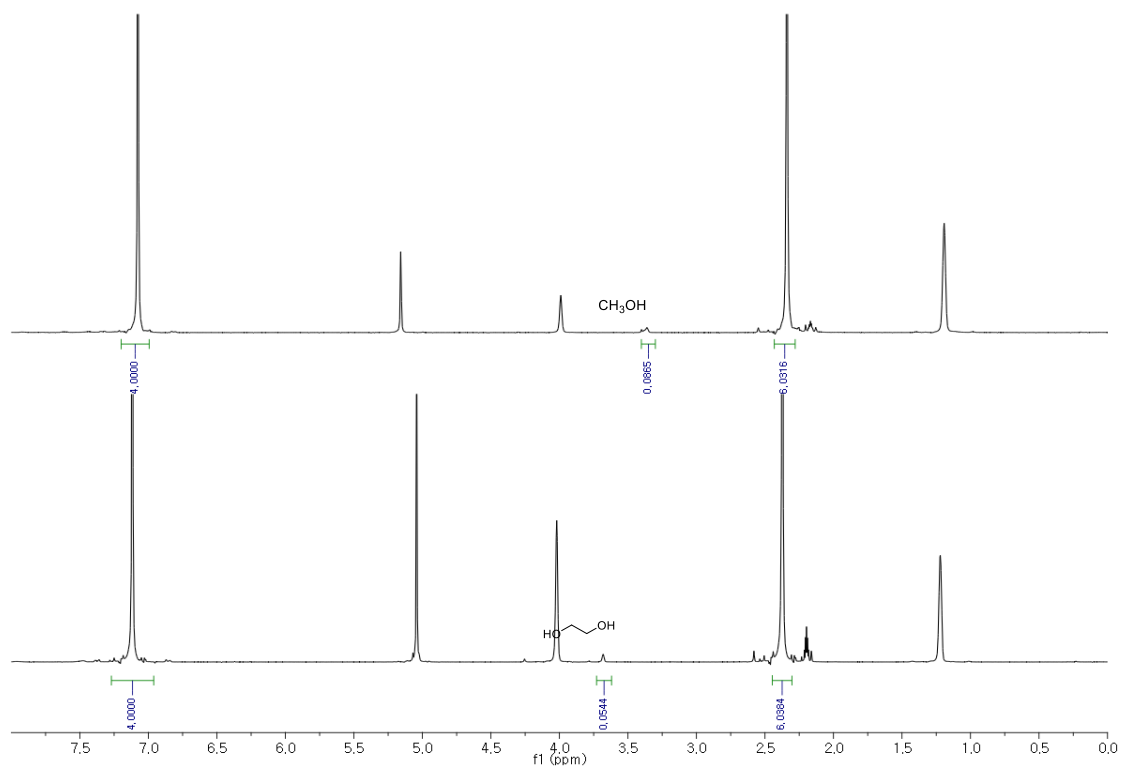
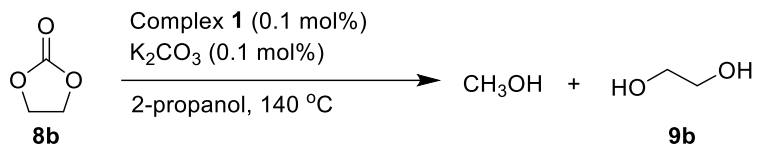


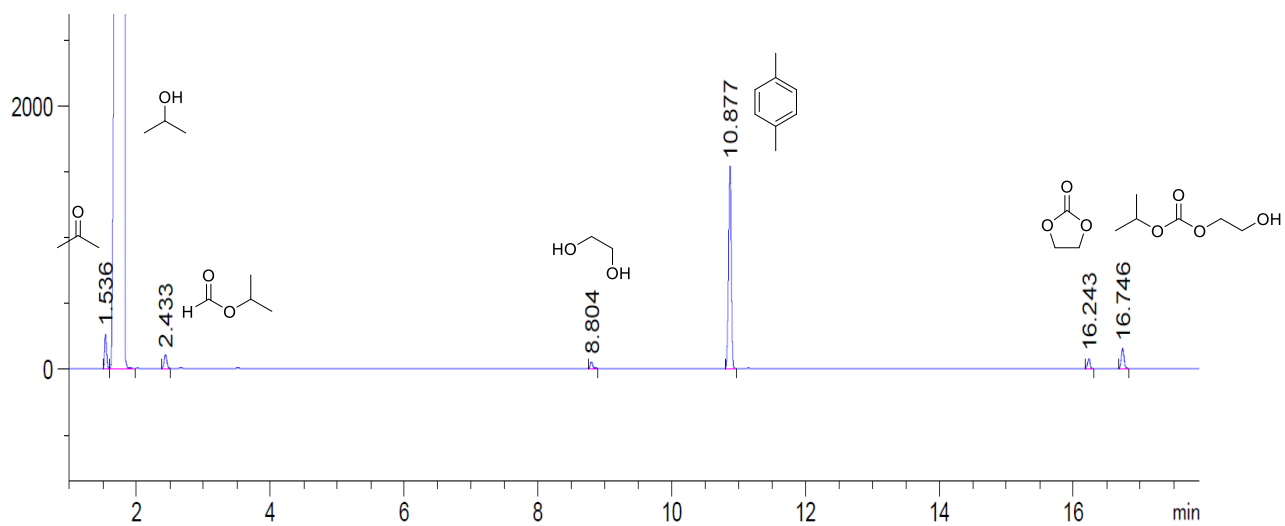
Figure S3.  $^1\text{H}$  NMR Spectra for Deuteration of 1,2-Ethandiol and Methanol



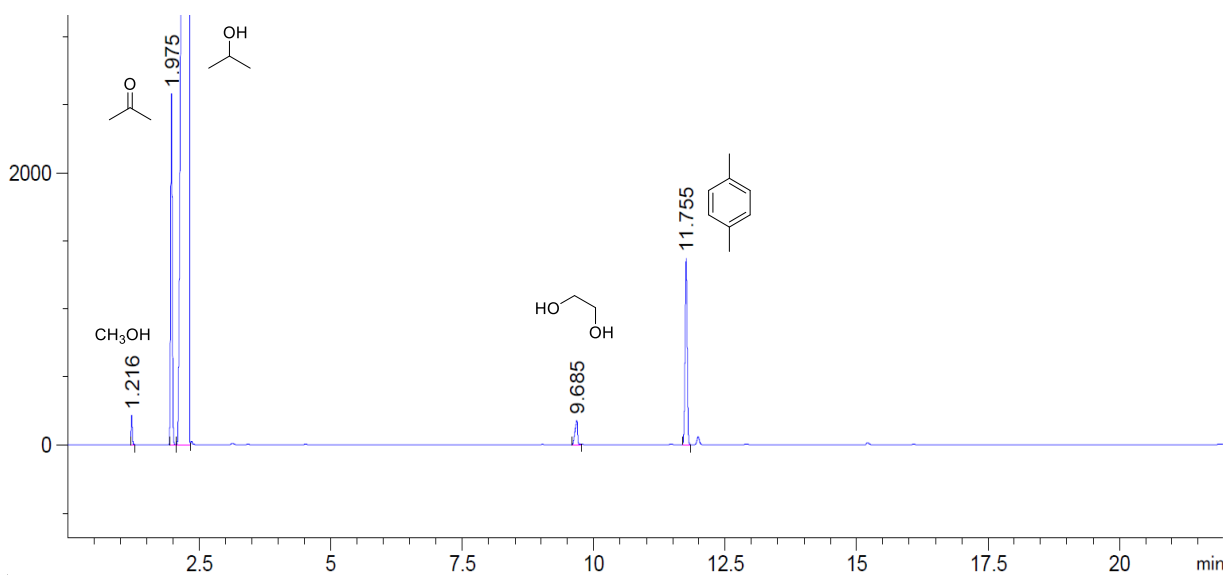
**Figure S4. GC Charts for Transfer Hydrogenation**

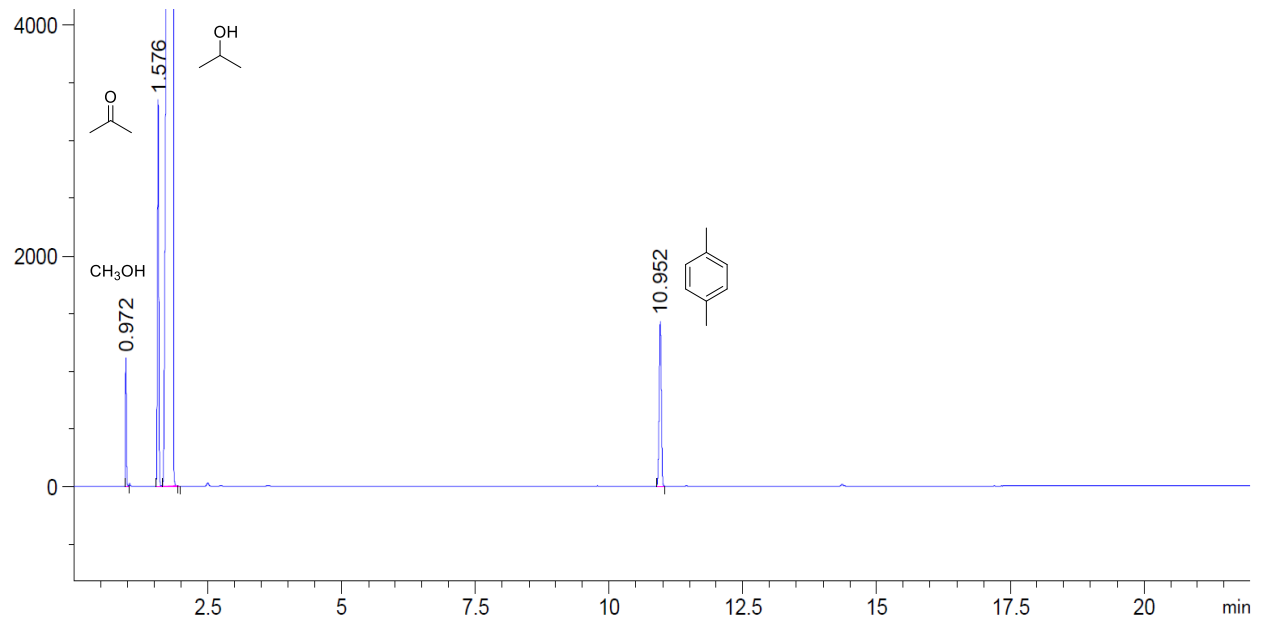
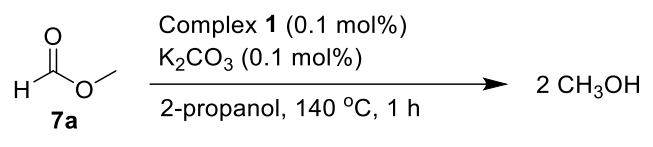
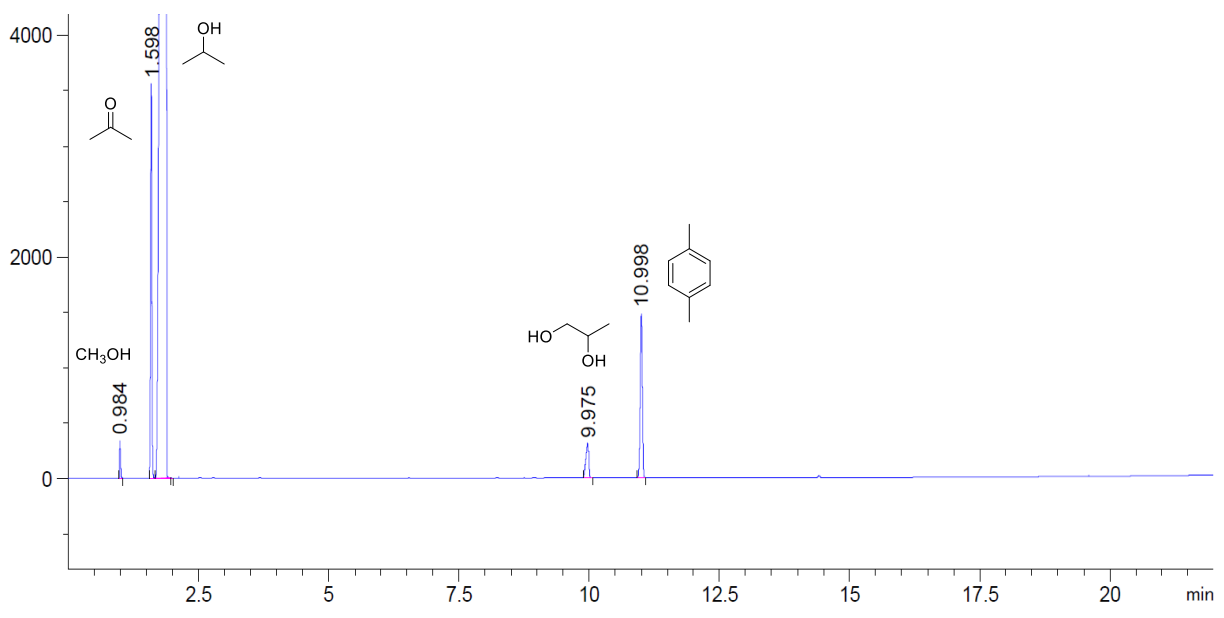
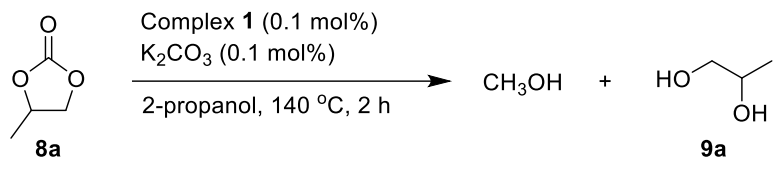


Figure S5. <sup>1</sup>H NMR Spectra
