1. General Information

Unless otherwise noted, all reactions were carried out under an atmosphere of argon in flamedried glassware. Reaction temperatures are reported as the temperature of the bath surrounding the vessel unless otherwise stated. CH₂Cl₂ was purified by distillation over CaH₂, Et₂O by distillation over Sodium and transferred under Argon. Anhydrous 1,2-dichloroethane and DMF was purchased from Acros Organics and stored over molecular sieves under argon.

Commercially available chemicals were obtained from Acros Organics, Aldrich Chemical Co., Strem Chemicals, Alfa Aesar, ABCR and TCI Europe and used as received unless otherwise stated.

NMR-spectra were recorded on a Bruker ARX-300, AV-300, AV-400 MHz or a Varian Unity Plus 600 or 500 INOVA. Chemical shifts (δ) are quoted in ppm downfield of tetramethylsilane and were referenced to the solvent peak (for CDCl₃, ¹H NMR: 7.26 ppm, ¹³C NMR: 77.16 ppm, for DMSO-*d*₆, ¹H NMR: 2.50 ppm, ¹³C NMR: 39.52 ppm and for CD₂Cl₄, ¹H NMR 5.91 ppm). Coupling constants (*J*) are quoted in Hz. ¹H- and ¹³C-peak attributions were determined by DEPT, ¹H-¹H gCOSY, ¹H-¹³C gHSQC, ¹H-¹³C gHMBC or by analogy. To describe the multiplicities of the signals, the following abbreviations were used: s: singlet, bs: broad signal, d: doublet, t: triplet, q: quartet, m: multiplet,

Infrared spectra were recorded on a Varian Associated FT-IR 3100 Excalibur with ATR unit. The wave numbers (v) of recorded IR-signals are quoted in cm⁻¹.

ESI mass spectra were recorded on a Bruker Daltonics MicroTof.

Analytical thin layer chromatography was performed on Polygram SIL G/UV254 plates. Visualization was accomplished with short wave UV light and/or KMnO4 staining solution followed by gentle heating.

Flash column chromatography was performed on Merck silica gel (40-63 mesh) by using standard laboratory techniques. Solvents used for flash column chromatography were distilled before use.

2. Substrate preparation

The benzamide substrates were prepared from commercially available acyl chlorides or acids using General Procedure A or B.

General Procedure A^[1]

To a round bottom-flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon the amine (1.10 equiv), Et₃N (1.25 equiv) and dichloromethane (0.5M). The acyl chloride (1.00 equiv) was added in one portion and the reaction mixture was stirred at room temperature until completion (typically 30 min). The mixture was diluted with dichloromethane and washed successively with 1N HCl and brine. The organic layer was dried over MgSO₄, filtered and concentrated under reduced pressure. The residue was purified by flash column chromatography on silica gel.

General Procedure B^[2]

To a round bottom-flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon the carboxylic acid (1.00 equiv), DMF (1.50 equiv) and dichloromethane (0.5M). The mixture was cooled to $0\,^{\circ}$ C and the oxalyl chloride (0.98 equiv) was added in few portions. The reaction was allowed to stir at room temperature until completion (typically $1-4\,\mathrm{h}$). Separately, the solution of the amine (2.25 equiv) in dichloromethane (0.5M) was prepared under argon. The solution of the acyl chloride was added in one portion to the solution of the amine and the reaction was stirred at room temperature until the TLC control showed

completion of the reaction. The mixture was filtered through a pad of silica gel, washed successively with 2N NaOH, brine, 1N HCl and brine. The organic phase was dried over MgSO₄, filtered and evaporated under reduced pressure. The residue was purified by flash column chromatography on silica gel.

(3) *N*,*N*-diisopropyl-3-methylbenzamide: From 3-methylbenzoic acid and diisopropylamine using a slightly modified General Procedure B.

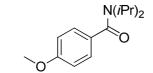
To a round bottom-flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon 3-methylbenzoic acid (2.72 g, 20.0 mmol, 1.00 equiv), DMF (2.3 mL, 30 mmol, 1.5 equiv) and THF (40 mL). The mixture was cooled to 0 °C and the oxalyl chloride (1.68 mL, 19.6 mmol, 0.98 equiv) was added in few portions. The reaction was allowed to stir at room temperature for 1 h. Separately, the solution of diisopropylamine (6.35 mL, 45.0 mmol, 2.25 equiv) in dichloromethane (25 mL) was prepared under argon. The solution of acyl chloride was added in one portion to the solution of amine and the reaction was stirred at room temperature for 1 h. The mixture was diluted with EtOAc and filtered through a pad of silica gel. The volatiles were removed under vacuum, the residue was dissolved in EtOAc and washed successively with 2N NaOH, brine, 1N HCl and brine. The organic phase was dried over MgSO₄, filtered and evaporated under reduced pressure. The product was purified by SiO₂ gel column chromatography (65 x 220 mm, pentane/EtOAc = 19/1). 67% isolated yield (white solid).

(4) *N,N*-diisopropyl-4-methoxybenzamide: From 4-methoxybenzoic acid and diisopropylamine using slightly modified General Procedure B.

To a round bottom-flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon carboxylic 4-methoxybenzoic acid (3.04 g, 20.0 mmol, 1.00 equiv), DMF (2.3 mL, 30 mmol, 1.5 equiv) and THF (40 mL). The mixture was cooled to 0 °C and the oxalyl chloride (1.68 mL, 19.6 mmol, 0.98 equiv) was added in few portions. The reaction was allowed to stir at room temperature for 1 h. Separately, the solution of diisopropylamine (6.35 mL, 45.0 mmol, 2.25 equiv) in dichloromethane (25 mL) was prepared under argon. The solution of acyl chloride was added in one portion to the solution of amine and the reaction was stirred at room temperature over night. The mixture was diluted with EtOAc and filtered through a pad of silica gel. The volatiles were removed under reduced pressure. The product was purified by SiO_2 gel column chromatography (50 x 130 mm, pentane/EtOAc = 8/2). 33% isolated yield (colorless viscous oil).

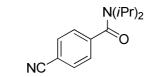

(9) 4-cyano-*N***,***N***-diisopropylbenzamide**: From 4-cyanobenzoic acid and diisopropylamine using a slightly modified General Procedure B.

To a round bottom-flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon 4-cyanobenzoic acid (734 mg, 5.00 mmol, 1.00 equiv), DMF (2 drops) and CH_2Cl_2 (15 mL). The mixture was cooled to 0 °C and the oxalyl chloride (761 μ L, 6.00 mmol, 1.20 equiv) was added in few portions. The reaction was allowed to stir at room temperature for 5 h. The CH_2Cl_2 and the volatiles were removed under reduces pressure. In a separate flame-dried flask under Argon, a solution of diisoproylamine (843 μ L, 6.00 mmol, 1.20 equiv) and

triethylamine (901 μ L, 6.50 mmol, 1.30 equiv) in CH₂Cl₂ (7 mL) is cooled down to 0°C and the crude acid chloride is dissolved in CH₂Cl₂ (3 mL) and added dropwise herein. The mixture is then stirred at room-temperature for 4 h, washed successively two times with 1N HCl and brine. The organic layer was dried over MgSO₄, filtered and evaporated under reduced pressure. The product was purified by SiO₂ gel column chromatography (30 x 100 mm, pentane/EtOAc = $8/2 \rightarrow 7/3$). 53% isolated yield (white solid).

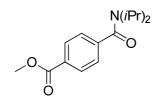

(10) Methyl 4-(diisopropylcarbamoyl)benzoate. From mono-Methyl terephthalate and diisopropylamine using a slightly modified General Procedure B.

To a round bottom-flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon mono-Methyl terephthalate (900 mg, 5.00 mmol, 1.00 equiv), DMF (2 drops) and CH_2Cl_2 (15 mL). The mixture was cooled to 0 °C and the oxalyl chloride (514 μ L, 6.00 mmol, 1.20 equiv) was added in few portions. The reaction was allowed to stir at room temperature for 3 h. The CH_2Cl_2 and the volatiles were removed under reduced pressure. In a separate flame-dried flask under Argon, a solution of diisoproylamine (843 μ L, 6.00 mmol, 1.20 equiv) and triethylamine (901 μ L, 6.50 mmol, 1.30 equiv) in CH_2Cl_2 (7 mL) is cooled down to 0°C and the crude acid chloride is dissolved in CH_2Cl_2 (3 mL) and added dropwise herein. The

mixture is then stirred at room-temperature for 3 h, washed successively two times with 1N HCl and brine. The organic phase was dried over MgSO₄, filtered and evaporated under reduced pressure. The product was purified by SiO_2 gel column chromatography (30 x 110 mm, pentane/EtOAc = 9/1). 88% isolated yield (colorless liquid).

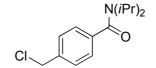

3. Catalysis

General Procedure:

To a flame-dried screw-capped test tube equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon [RhCp*Cl₂]₂ (6.2 mg, 0.01 mmol), AgSbF₆ (13.7 mg, 0.04 mmol) and PivOH (112.3 mg, 1.1 mmol). 1,2-DCE (5 mL), the substrate (1-26) (1.0 mmol) and NXS (1.1 eq.) were added. The closed tube is added to a pre-heated oil-bath and stirred for 16h. The mixture was then allowed to cool down to room temperature, diluted with EtOAc (20 mL) and filtered through a short pad of silica gel and eluted with EtOAc (100 mL). After removing the solvent under reduced pressure, the product was purified by flash chromatography.

5. Mechanistic Experiments

5.1 KIE intermolecular competition experiment

To a flame-dried screw-capped flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon [RhCp*Cl₂]₂ (6.2 mg, 0.01 mmol), AgSbF₆ (13.7 mg, 0.04 mmol) and PivOH (112.3 mg, 1.1 mmol). DCE (5 mL), the benzamide **1, 1-d₅** (each 0.5 mmol) and NBS (1 mmol, 1.0 equiv) were added. The closed tube is added to an pre-heated oil-bath (60 °C) and stirred for 35 min. The mixture was then diluted with EtOAc (20 mL) and filtered through a pad of silica gel and eluted with EtOAc (100 mL). After removing the solvent under reduced pressure, the product and starting material were separated by SiO₂ gel column chromatography (30 x 300 mm, toluene/EtOAc = 9/1). The product and the reisolated starting material were submitted for ESI H.R. analysis to determine the deuteration grade.

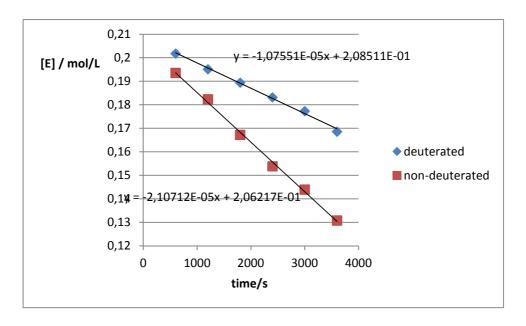

5.2 KIE initial rate constants

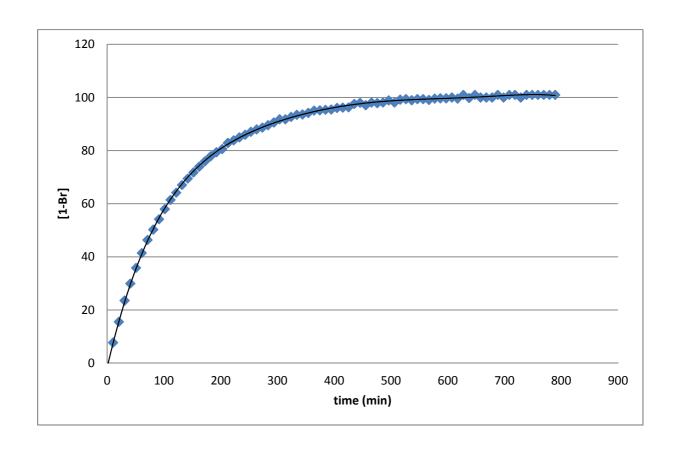
To a flame-dried screw-capped flask equipped with a magnetic stir bar were added under argon [RhCp*Cl₂]₂ (3.1 mg, 0.0050 mmol), AgSbF₆ (6.9 mg, 0.020 mmol) and PivOH (56.2 mg, 0.550 mmol). DCE (2.5 mL), the benzamide **1** or **1-d**₅ (0.5 mmol), NBS (0.55 mmol, 1.1 equiv) and an internal standard (1,3,5-Tri-tert-butylbenzene, 123.18 mg) were added. The closed tube is added to an pre-heated oil-bath (60 °C) and stirred. For one hour, every ten minutes an aliquot (~20 μ l) is collected and submitted to GC analysis to determine the conversion.

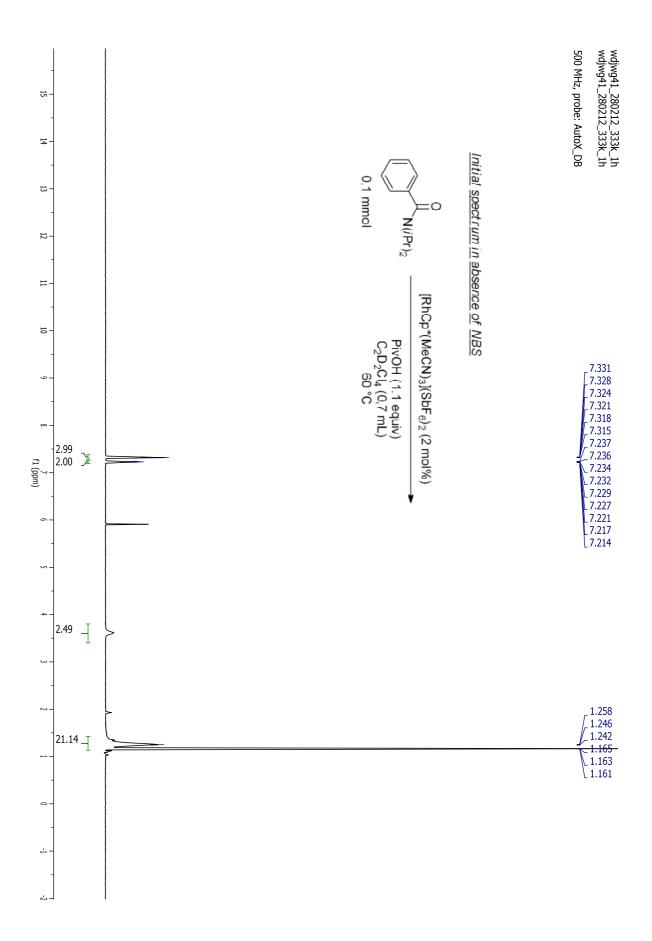


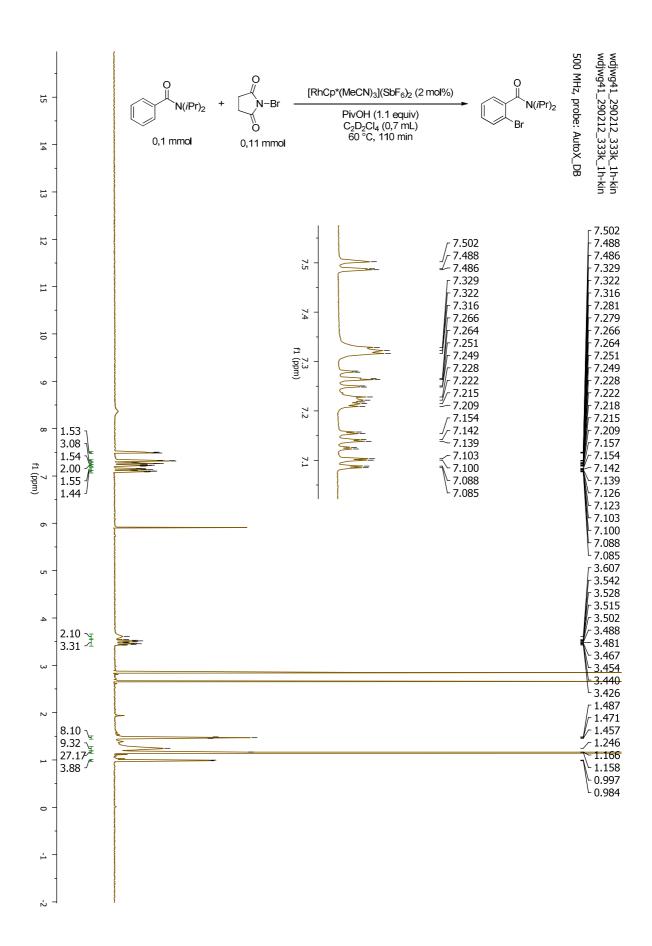

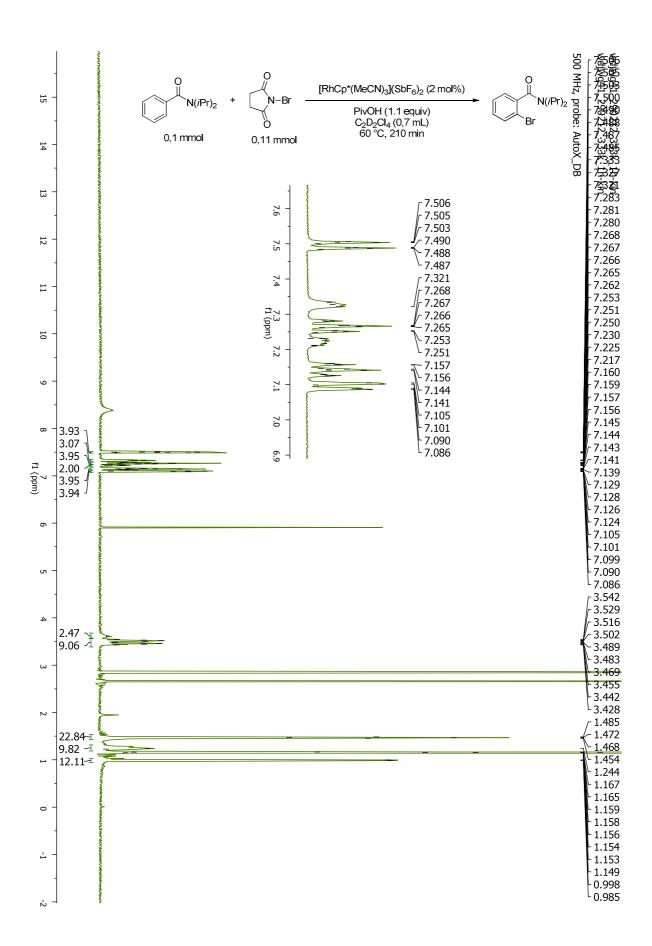
5.3 NMR Experiments

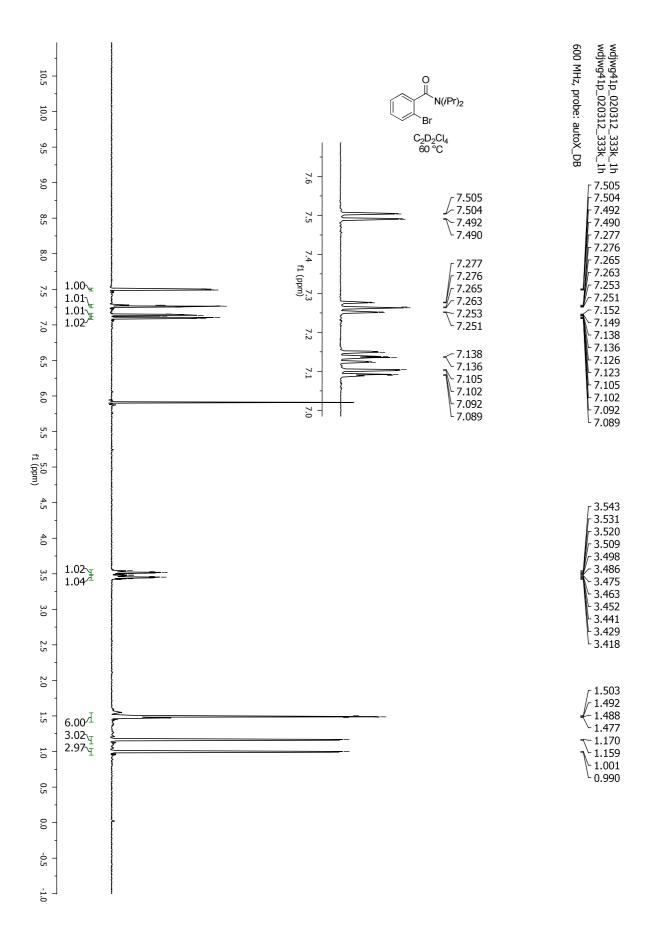
The flame dried Schlenk tube was charged with $[RhCp^*(MeCN)_3](SbF_6)_2$ (1.7 mg, 2 mol%), substrate 1 (20.5 mg, 0,10 mmol) and PivOH (11.2 mg, 0.11 mmol). The Schlenk was filled with argon and 0.7 mL of $C_2D_2Cl_4$ were added. The mixture was stirred at room temperature. After 15 min the reaction mixture was transferred to an NMR tube prefilled with Argon. The initial NMR spectrum was acquired at 60 °C. Then NBS (19.6 mg, 0.11 mmol) was added. The kinetic was followed by NMR at 60 °C. The results are presented as a time dependence of the concentration of product 1-Br.
