The biodistribution data of **Table 1** in section 4 of the “Results and Discussion” part are shown in a graphical representation in the following figure:




Figure 1: Biodistribution of (S)- and (R)- $[^{18}\text{F}]8$ in BALB/c mice with subcutaneous DBT tumors. These data are identical to the data presented in Table 1 of the manuscript.
