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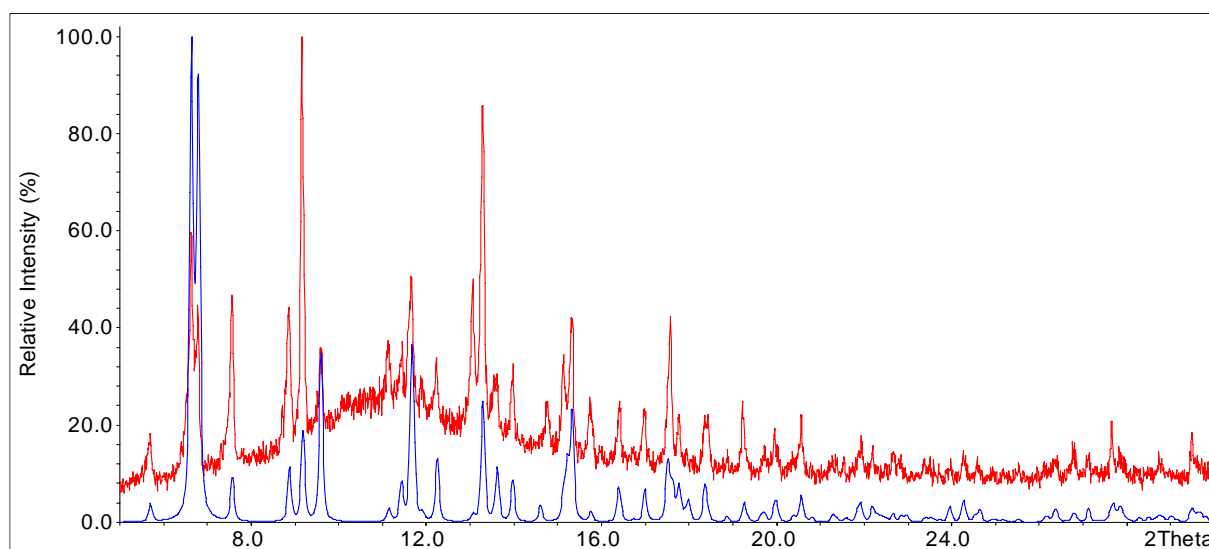


Figure S1. Experimental (red) and theoretical (blue) powder pattern of $[\text{Mn}(\text{CO})_6][\text{BF}_4] \cdot \text{SO}_2$. The calculation of the theoretical powder pattern utilises the atomic parameters of the 100 K single crystal structure in combination with the RT cell parameters of the experimental powder pattern.

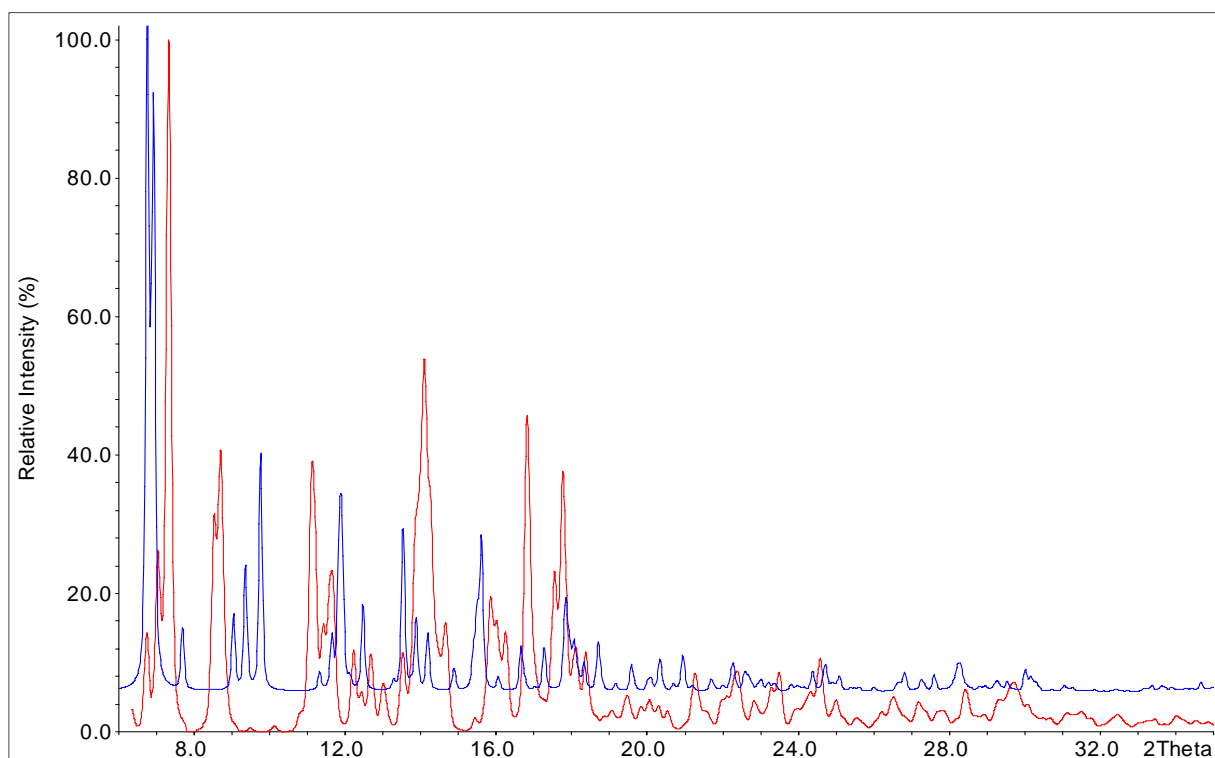

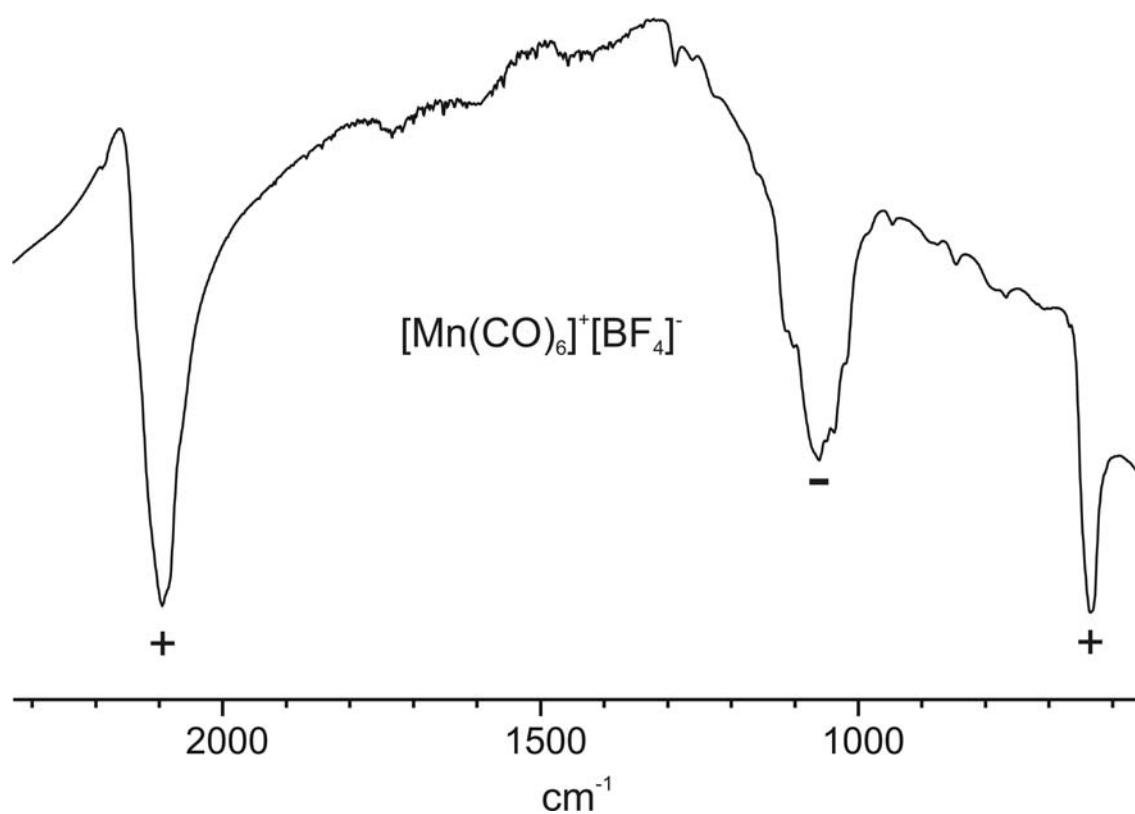


Figure S3: IR spectrum of solid $[\text{Mn}(\text{CO})_6][\text{BF}_4]$. Cation bands +, Anion bands -.

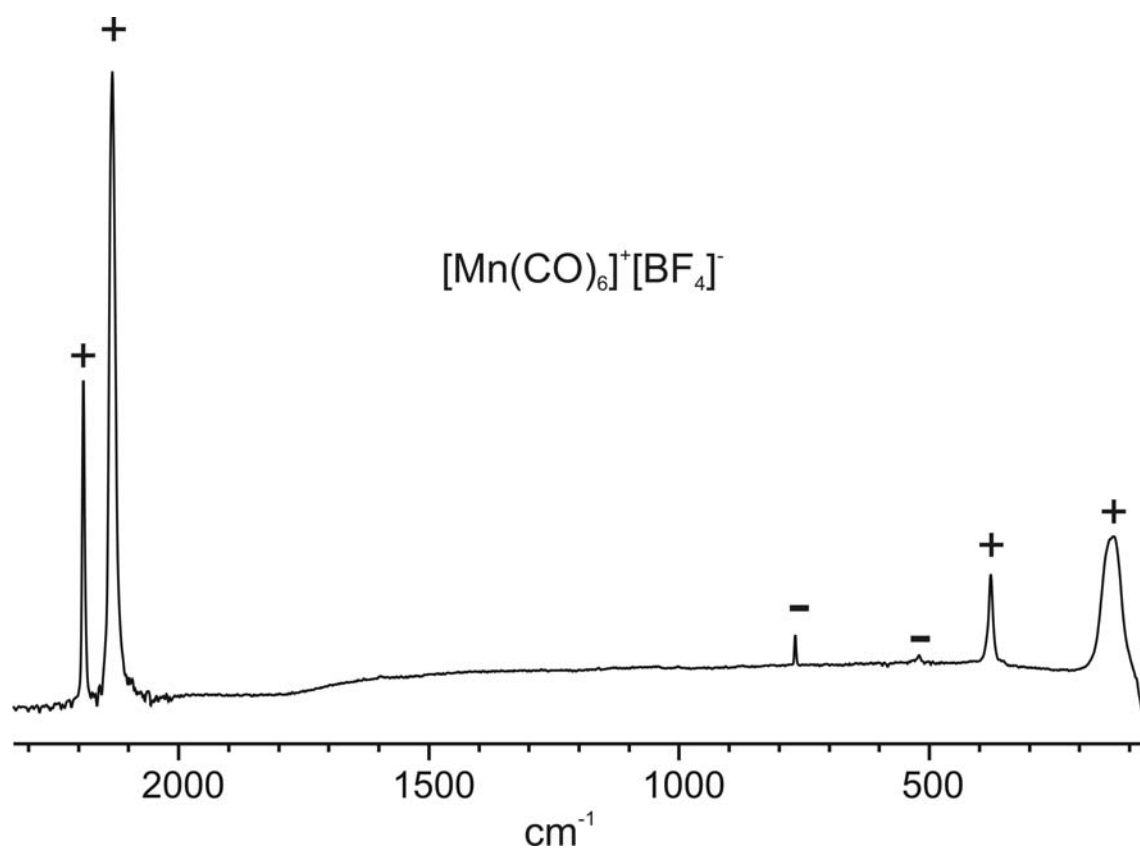

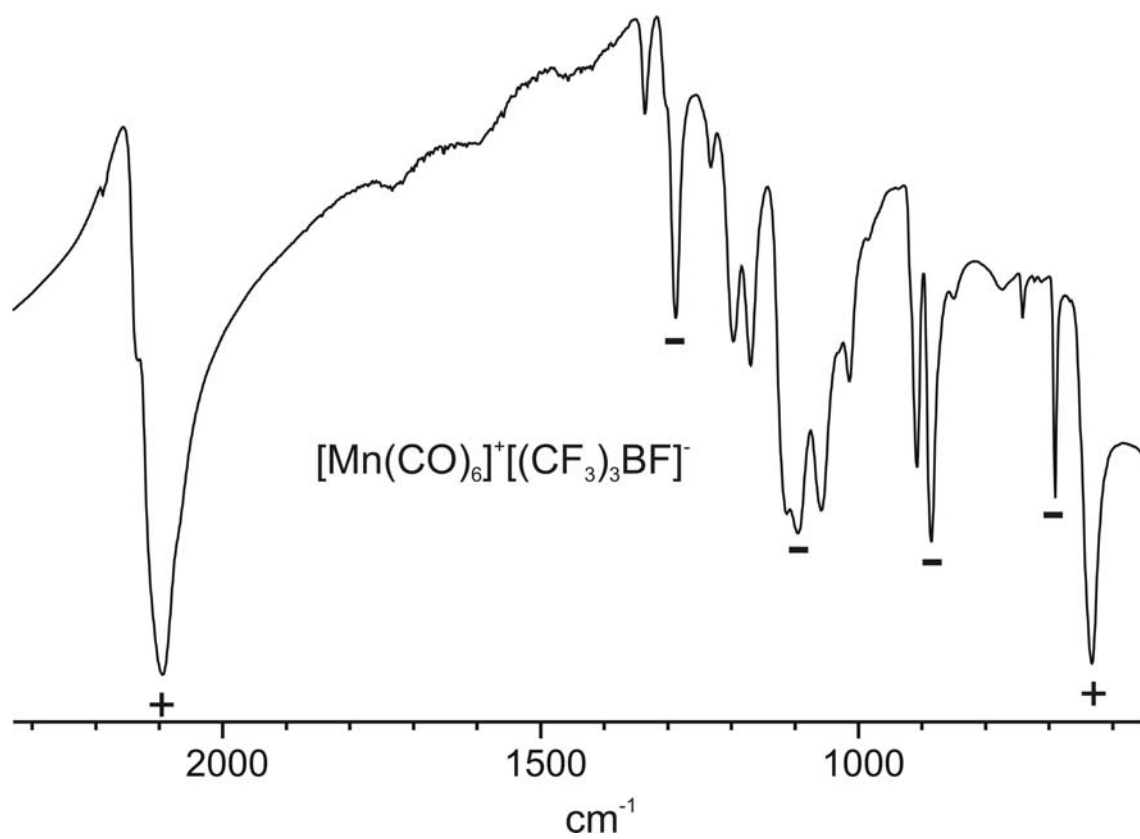

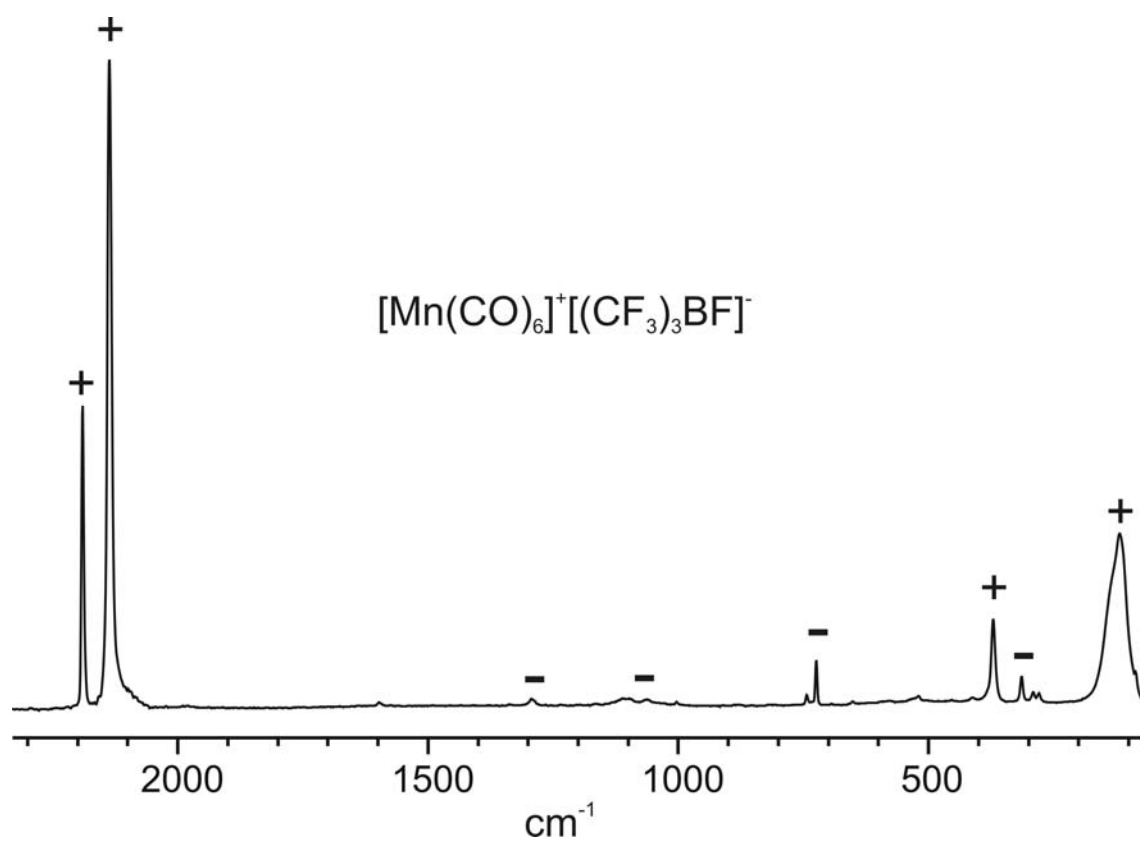

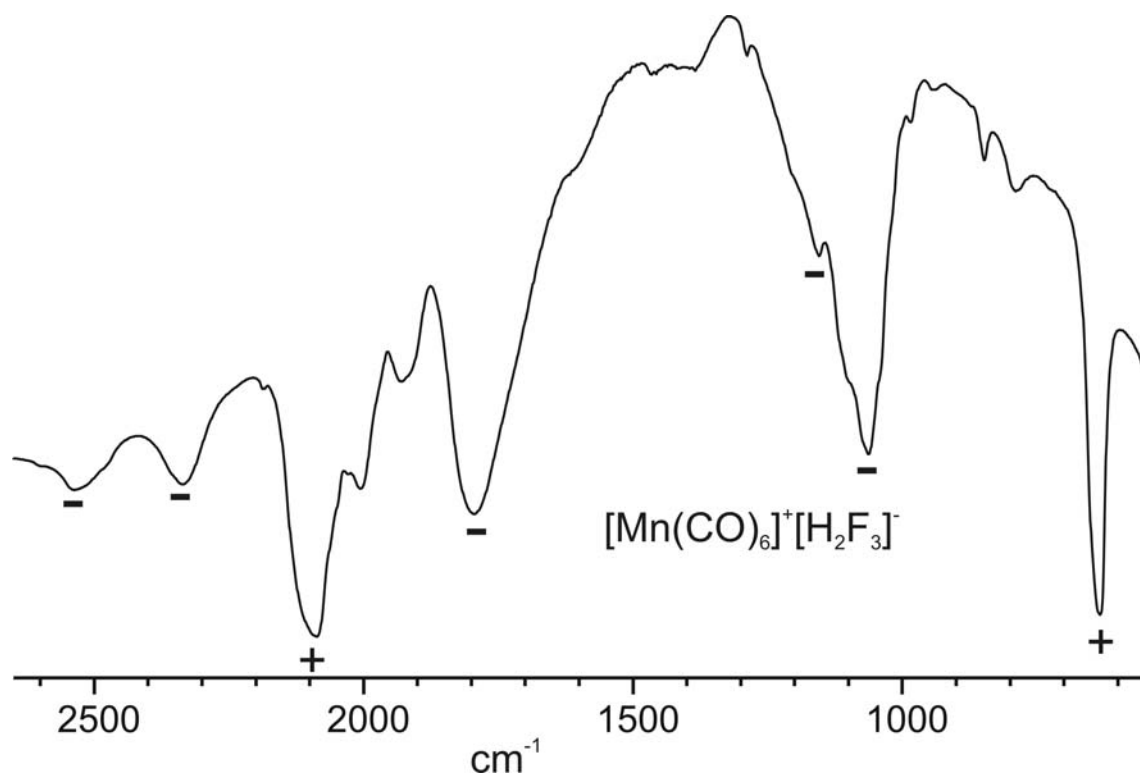

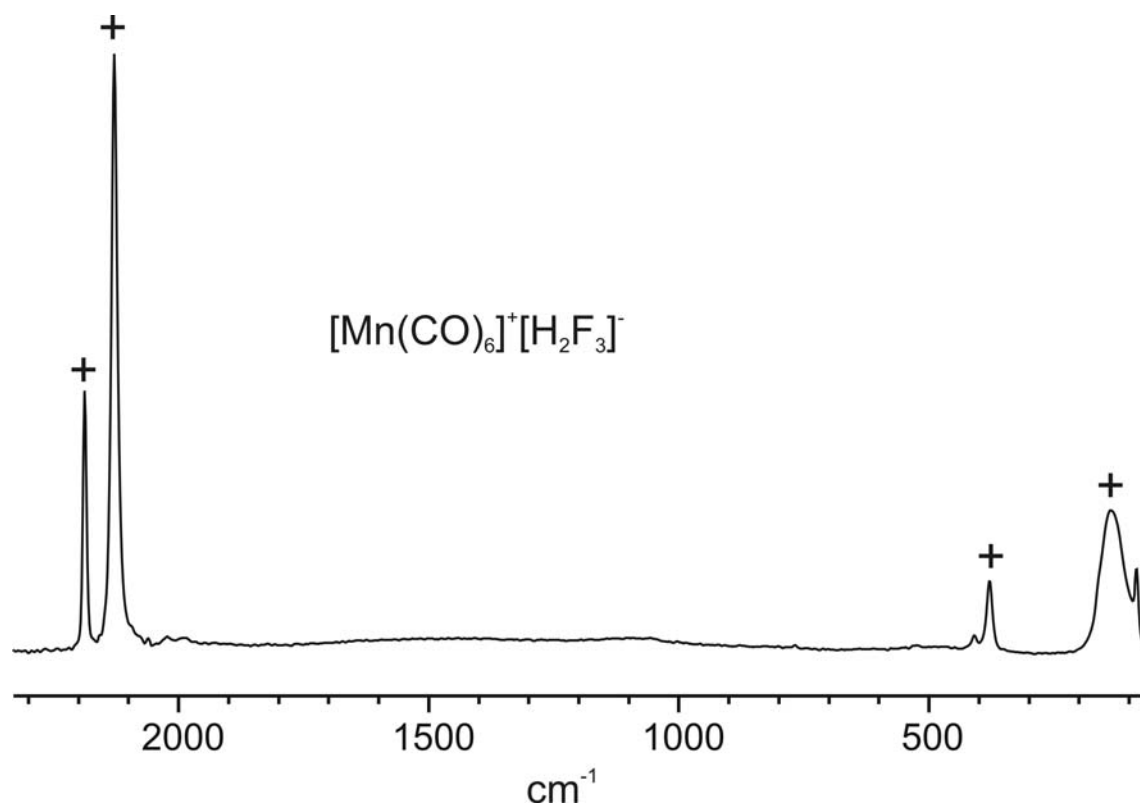
