#### **General Procedures**

All reactions were carried out in dry solvents. Commercial dichloromethane (DCM) was dried over CaH<sub>2</sub>. Reagents were purchased and used without further purification. Reactions were monitored by thin layer chromatography (TLC), and the products were obtained by column chromatography on silica gel or preparative thin layer chromatography (pTLC). High resolution mass spectra (HRMS) were recorded on a Shimadzu LCMS-IT/TOF quadrupole-time of flight mass spectrometer. NMR spectra were recorded on JOEL JNM-ECA 600, JNM-ECS 400 and JNM-ECA 300 for proton and carbon magnetic resonance spectra (<sup>1</sup>H NMR and <sup>13</sup>C NMR) using tetramethylsilane (TMS) in the solvent of CDCl<sub>3</sub> as the internal standard (<sup>1</sup>H NMR: TMS at 0.00 ppm, CHCl<sub>3</sub> at 7.26 ppm; <sup>13</sup>C NMR: CDCl<sub>3</sub> at 77.16 ppm). The following abbreviations were used to explain the multiplicities: s = singlet, d = doublet, t = triplet, q = quartet, m = multiplet, b = broad.

**Abbreviations:** DMF: *N,N*-dimethylformamide; DMAP: *N,N*-dimethyl-4-aminopyridine; THF: tetrahydrofuran; EtOAc: ethyl acetate; DCM: dichloromethane; Boc<sub>2</sub>O: di-*tert*-butyldicarbonate

## **Experimental Procedures and Characterization Data**

General Procedure for Synthesis of N-Bis(Boc)-Asp(OPht)-OMe (1a) and N-Bis(Boc)-Glu(OPht)-OMe (1b)

M1, M2, M3 were prepared by following the procedures in the reference.<sup>1</sup>

*N*-Boc-Asp(OBn)-OMe (M1a). Boc-Asp(OBzl)-OH (4.8 g, 14.9 mmol) was dissolved in dry DMF (35 mL) in a 100 mL round bottom flask. Finely ground K<sub>2</sub>CO<sub>3</sub> (3.0 g, 22 mmol) was added to the solution. The mixture was cooled to 0 °C in an ice bath over five minutes. Methyl iodide (2.0 mL, 30 mmol) was then added to the flask over 30 seconds. The resulting mixture was stirred at 0 °C for 3 hours. A yellow color developed within 20-30 minutes. The ice bath was removed, and H<sub>2</sub>O (50 mL) was added, producing a grayish white precipitate. The mixture was extracted with EtOAc (3 × 50 mL). The organic layers were combined and washed with saturated NaHCO<sub>3</sub> (50 mL) and saturated NaCl (4 × 50 mL). The organic layer (which was yellow) was dried over Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>, and passed through a plug of silica, eluting with ethylacetate. Evaporation under reduced pressure afforded M1a as a white powder, yield: 4.93 g (98 %).

*N*-Boc<sub>2</sub>-Asp(OBzl)-OMe (M2a). Di-*tert*-butyl dicarbonate (4.78 g, 22 mmol), DMAP (1.79 g, 14.6 mmol) and M1a (4.93 g, 14.6 mmol) were placed into a dry 100 mL round bottom flask. Dry acetonitrile (30 mL) was added to the flask, and the resulting solution was stirred for 24 hours,

during which time the reaction color went from light to dark yellow. Water (50 mL) was added, and the solution became cloudy white. The resulting mixture was extracted with EtOAc ( $3 \times 50$  mL). The combined organic layers were washed with 1 M HCl (50 mL) and saturated NaCl ( $4 \times 50$  mL). The combined organic layers were dried over Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub> and evaporated under reduced pressure to afford **M2a** as a viscous red oil, yield: 6.17 g (96%).

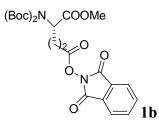
**N-Boc<sub>2</sub>-Asp-OMe (M3a)**. Palladium on activated carbon (1.2 g, 10% by weight) was added to a dry 100 mL round bottom flask charged with **M2a** (6.17 g, 14.0 mmol) and MeOH (30 mL). A H<sub>2</sub> balloon was attached to the reaction vessel equipped with a three way valve. The mixture was degassed by quickly alternating vacuum evacuation and H<sub>2</sub> backfill three times. Then the flask was placed to a 50 °C oil bath for 12 hours. After the reaction completed, the mixture was filtered to remove the Pd/C, and the solvent of the remaining solution was evaporated under reduced pressure to afford **M3a** as a light yellow oil, yield: 4.62 g (95%).

*N*-Boc<sub>2</sub>-Asp(OPht)-OMe (1a). 1a was synthesized by following the procedure in the reference. <sup>2</sup> *N*-Hydroxyphthalimide (2.39 g, 14.63 mmol) was added to a 100 mL round bottom flask charged with M3a (4.62 g, 13.3 mmol) and dry THF (30 mL). After the mixture was stirred for over 10 minutes, DCC (2.74 g, 13.3 mmol) was added to the flask in portions, and the reaction was performed at room temperature for 24 hours. After the reaction completed, the resulting mixture was filtered, the solvent of the remaining solution was removed under reduced pressure, and the crude product was purified by flash silica gel column chromatography (DCM/EtOAc = 60/1,  $R_f = 0.52$ ) to give 1a as a viscous pale yellow oil, yield: 4.9 g (75%).

#### **General Procedure for Synthesis of Diselenides (2)**

Disenides were prepared according to the previous literature.<sup>3</sup> To a 100 mL three-necked flask, 30 mmol of Mg powder (0.72 g), a stirring bar and a small piece of  $I_2$  were added. The flask was then equipped with a condenser and charged with  $N_2$ . Under  $N_2$  protection, anhydrous ether (20 mL) was injected by syringe. A small amount of halogenated hydrocarbon was added, after initiation the rest of the halogenated hydrocarbon (30 mmol) in anhydrous ether (30 mL) was slowly injected with ice-water bath cooling. After the preparation of Grignard reagent, dried selenium powder (30 mmol, 2.4 g) was added slowly. After stirring for 1 h, the mixture was dumped into 100 mL of 1 M HCl solution with ice cooling for acidolysis. The mixture was extracted by ether (3 × 50 mL) and the combined organic layer was dehydrated by anhydrous  $Na_2SO_4$ . The solution was charged with  $O_2$  for 24 h and turned orange. Distillation of solvent afforded the crude diselenide, which could be purified by recrystallization with EtOH– $H_2O$  or column chromatography (eluent: petroleum ether).

#### General Procedure for Synthesis and Characterization of Compounds 3

General procedure for synthesis of compounds 3. [Ru(bpy)<sub>3</sub>]Cl<sub>2</sub> (1.5 μmol, 1.2 mg), diselenides (2) (0.15 mmol) and Hantzsch ester (HE) (0.225 mmol, 57 mg) were added to a 25-mL Schlenk tube equipped with a Teflon septum and magnetic stir bar. The tube was evacuated and

back-filled with argon for three cycles and then sealed under an atmosphere of argon. *N*-Bis(Boc)-Asp(OPht)-OMe (**1a**) or *N*-Bis(Boc)-Glu(OPht)-OMe (**1b**) (0.15 mmol) (0.15 mmol) and DIPEA (0.375 mmol, 63 μL, 32.3 mg) were dissolved in mixed solvent of dichloromethane (DCM) (0.5 mL) and tetrahydrofuran (THF) (0.5 mL), and then the solution was added to the tube by syringe. The tube was irradiated with a 40 W fluorescent lamp at room temperature (approximately 2 cm away from the light source). After the complete conversion of the substrates (monitored by TLC), the reaction mixture was diluted with 20 mL of EtOAc, and the solution was filtered by flash chromatography. The filtrate was evaporated by rotary evaporator, and the residue was purified by silica gel column chromatography or preparative thin layer chromatography (pTLC) to give the desired product (**3**).

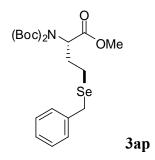

General Procedure for Synthesis and Characterization of Compounds 4 and 5 Synthesis of N-Bis(Boc)-Asp(OPht)-Pro-OMe (4)

Boc-Asp(OBzl)-Pro-OMe (**S2**) was prepared according to the previous reference.<sup>4</sup> Boc-Asp(OBzl)-OH (**S1**) (5 mmol, 1.61 g) was dissolved in dry DMF (35 mL) in a 100 mL round bottom flask. HATU (*O*-(7-azabenzotriazol-1-yl)uronium hexafluoro-phosphate) (5 mmol, 1.91g) was added to the solution. After stirring for 30 min, methyl L-prolinate hydrochloride (5 mmol, 0.83g) and NEt<sub>3</sub> (12.5 mmol, 1.75 mL) were added, and the solution was stirred over night. Water (50 mL) was added to the resulting solution, and the mixture was extracted with DCM (3 × 50 mL). The combined organic layer was washed with 1M HCl (50 mL), saturated NaHCO<sub>3</sub> aqueous solution, and dried over anhydrous Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>. Removal of solvent in the solution under reduced pressure provided Boc-Asp(OBzl)-Pro-OMe (**S2**) (2.06 g, 95%).

Boc-Asp(OBzl)-Pro-OMe (S2) (2.06 g) was dissolved in 30 mL of anhydrous CH<sub>3</sub>CN, and di-tert-butyl dicarbonate (7.5 mmol, 1.08 g), DMAP

(5 mmol, 0.61 g) was added to the solution. After stirring for 24 hours, water (50 mL) was added, and the solution became cloudy white. The resulting mixture was extracted with EtOAc (3 × 50 mL). The combined organic layer was washed with 1 M HCl (50 mL) and saturated NaCl (4 × 50 mL). The organic layer was dried over anhydrous Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub> and evaporated under reduced pressure to afford S3 as a viscous red oil, yield: 2.44 g (96%). S3 was dissolved in CH<sub>3</sub>OH (35 mL), palladium on activated carbon (0.4 g, 10% by weight) was added, and a H<sub>2</sub> balloon was attached to the reaction vessel equipped with a three way valve. The mixture was degassed by quickly alternating vacuum evacuation and H<sub>2</sub> backfill three times. Then the flask was placed to a 50 °C oil bath for 12 hours. After the reaction completed, the mixture was filtered to remove the Pd/C, and the solvent of the remaining solution was evaporated under reduced pressure to afford S4 as a light yellow oil, yield: 1.93 g (95%). N-Bis(Boc)-Asp(OPht)-Pro-OMe (4) was synthesized by following the procedure in the reference. N-Hydroxyphthalimide (4 mmol, 0.72 g) was added to a 100 mL round bottom flask charged with S4 (4 mmol, 1.44 g) and dry THF (30 mL). After the mixture was stirred for over 10 minutes, DCC (4 mmol, 0.825 g) was added to the flask in portions, and the reaction was performed at room temperature for 24 hours. ### Synthesis and Characterization of Compound 5

[Ru(bpy)<sub>3</sub>]Cl<sub>2</sub> (1.5 μmol, 1.2 mg), *N*-Bis(Boc)-Asp(OPht)-Pro-OMe (4) (0.15 mmol, 88.5mg), diphenyl diselenide (2a) (0.15 mmol, 47mg) and Hantzsch ester (HE) (0.225 mmol, 57 mg) were added to a 25-mL Schlenk tube equipped with a Teflon septum and magnetic stir bar. The tube was evacuated and back-filled with argon for three cycles and then sealed under an atmosphere of argon. DIPEA (0.375 mmol, 63 μL, 32.3 mg) wes dissolved in mixed solvent of dichloromethane (DCM) (0.5 mL) and tetrahydrofuran (THF) (0.5 mL), and then the solution was added to the tube by syringe. The tube was irradiated with a 40 W fluorescent lamp at room temperature (approximately 2 cm away from the light source). After the complete conversion of the substrates (monitored by TLC), the reaction mixture was diluted with 20 mL of EtOAc, and the solution was filtered by flash chromatography. The filtrate was evaporated by rotary evaporator, and the residue was purified by silica gel column chromatography or preparative thin layer chromatography (pTLC) to give the desired product (5).

#### Synthesis and Characterization of Rac-3a

D,L-Aspartic acid (1.33 g, 10 mmol) and dioxane (20 mL) were added to a 100mL round bottom glass bottle equipped with a magnetic stir bar, then 3 M NaOH (20 mL) was added to the mixture. After the mixture was stirred for 20 min, Boc<sub>2</sub>O (3.28 g, 15 mmol) in dioxane was added dropwise, and the mixture was stirred at room temperature overnight. Solvent was evaporated under reduced pressure, and the remained aqueous

was washed with Et<sub>2</sub>O ( $2 \times 50$  mL) and the organic phase is extracted with saturated NaHCO<sub>3</sub> ( $2 \times 50$  mL). The combined agueous was acidified with 1M KHSO<sub>4</sub> and extracted with ethyl acetate (3  $\times$  100 mL), and the combined organic phase was dried over Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub> and evaporated to give Boc-Asp as a white solid, yield 2.3 g (98%). The white solid was dissolved in DMF (30mL), and a well grounded K<sub>2</sub>CO<sub>3</sub> (6 g) was added. After the mixture was changed into a white suspension, CH<sub>3</sub>I (4 mL) was added dropwise, and the mixture was stirred at room temperature for over 8 h. Water (50 mL) was added, and the aqueous solution was extracted with ethyl acetate (3 × 100 mL). The combined organic phase was washed with water (3 × 50 mL), brine, dried over Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>, evaporated under reduced pressure to give Rac-Boc-Asp(OMe)-OMe as a colorless oil, yield 2.48 g (97%). According to the previous procedures, <sup>2</sup> Rac-Boc-Asp(OMe)-OMe (1.3 g, 5 mmol) in 55 mL of methanol was added to a 55 mL of 0.1M KOH solution. The mixture was stirred at room temperature overnight, and methanol was evaporated. Remained aqueous solution was acidified with 1 M HCl (6 mL), and extracted with CH<sub>2</sub>Cl<sub>2</sub> (2 × 30 mL), and the combined organic phase dried over Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>, evaporated under reduced pressure to provide the desired product Rac-Boc-Asp(OH)-OMe as a white solid, yield 1.04g (85%). The solid was dissolved in 30 mL dry acetonitrile, and DMAP (1.037 g, 8.5 mmol) was added. Boc<sub>2</sub>O (1.40 g, 6.4 mmol) was added to the mixture in one portion. After stirring at room temperature overnight, water 50 mL was added to the mixture to lead to a white suspension appearing, and then a solution of 1M HCl (10.2) mL) was added. The resulting solution was extracted with ethyl acetate (3 × 50 mL), and the combined organic washed with saturated NH<sub>4</sub>Cl (2 × 40 mL), dried with Na<sub>2</sub>SO<sub>4</sub>, and evaporated. The residue was purified by silica gel column chromatography to give a light brown oil Rac-N-(Boc)<sub>2</sub>-Asp(OH)-OMe, yield 1.18g (80%). Rac-N-(Boc)<sub>2</sub>-Asp(OPht)-OMe was synthsized using the similar procedures as described above as synthesis of N-(Boc)<sub>2</sub>-Asp(OPht)-OMe. Rac-N-(Boc)<sub>2</sub>-Asp(OH)-OMe (1g, 2.9mmol) was added to a solution of N-hydroxyphthalimide (0.52 g, 3.2 mmol) in dry THF (10mL). After the mixture was stirred for over 10 minutes, DCC (0.6 g, 2.9 mmol) was added to the flask in

portions, and the reaction was performed at room temperature for 24 hours. Synthesis of *Rac-*3a. [Ru(bpy)<sub>3</sub>]Cl<sub>2</sub> (1.5 μmol, 1.2 mg), diphenylselenide (2a) (0.15 mmol) and Hantzsch ester (HE) (0.225 mmol, 57 mg) were added to a 25-mL Schlenk tube equipped with a Teflon septum and magnetic stir bar. The tube was evacuated and back-filled with argon for three cycles and then sealed under an atmosphere of argon. *Rac-N-Bis*(Boc)-Asp(OPht)-OMe (*Rac-*1a) (0.15 mmol) and DIPEA (0.375 mmol, 63 μL, 32.3 mg) were dissolved in mixed solvent of dichloromethane (DCM) (0.5 mL) and tetrahydrofuran (THF) (0.5 mL), and then the solution was added to the tube by syringe. The tube was irradiated with a 40 W fluorescent lamp at room temperature (approximately 2 cm away from the light source). After the conversion of the substrates (monitored by TLC), the reaction mixture was diluted with 20 mL of EtOAc, and the solution was filtered by flash chromatography. The filtrate was evaporated by rotary evaporator, and the residue was purified by silica gel column chromatography or preparative thin layer chromatography (pTLC) to give the desired product (*Rac-*3a) in 79% (54.4 mg) yield as a pale yellow oil.

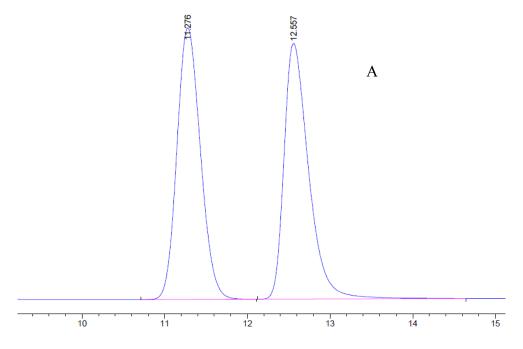

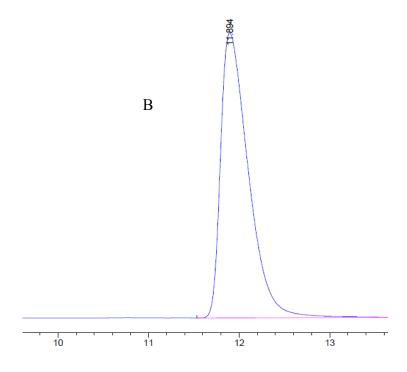

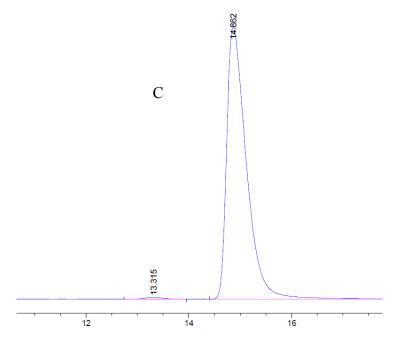

(B) HPLC of **3a** with concentration of 2 mg/mL



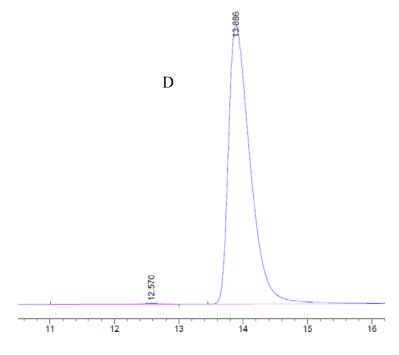
