## **Experimental section**

## I. Chemistry

## General methods and materials

THF was freshly distilled from LiAlH<sub>4</sub> before use. DMF was stored over 4Å molecular sieves. All the other solvents were used as received. Starting materials were commercially available. Reactions were performed under anhydrous conditions unless noted otherwise. Reactions were followed by TLC analysis on Merck TLC aluminum sheets Silicagel 60 F254. Flash column chromatography was performed on silicagel, 30-60  $\mu$ m (J.T. Baker). Melting points were measured on an Electrothermal IA9200 apparatus or a Mettler FP-5 + FP-052 apparatus equipped with a microscope and are uncorrected. <sup>1</sup>H NMR spectra were recorded on a Bruker AC 200 (<sup>1</sup>H NMR:  $\delta$  200.1 MHz). The <sup>1</sup>H NMR chemical shifts ( $\delta$ ) are expressed in ppm values relative to CDCl<sub>3</sub> ( $\delta$  = 7.26 ppm). Abbreviations used in description of NMR spectra: s = singlet, d = doublet, t = triplet, q = quartet, dd = double doublet, dt = double triplet, m = multiplet and bs = broad singulet. All phthalazinones had an elemental analysis (C, H and N) within  $\pm$ 0.4% of the theoretical value.

## General procedure for the N-alkylation of phthalazinones

Sodium hydride (60% dispersion in mineral oil, 1.1 equivalent) was added to a suspension of phthalazinone 2a (5.0 to 25 mmol) in DMF (25 to 250 mL). After stirring the reaction mixture for 2 h, the selected alkyl halide (1.1 equivalent) was added and the resulting mixture was stirred for another 4 h. The reaction mixture was poured into water and the product was extracted with ethyl acetate. The combined organic layers were washed with water and brine and dried over MgSO<sub>4</sub>. Removal of the solvent under reduced pressure and crystallization or flash column chromatography followed by crystallization yielded the pure products. Experimental data for the separate compounds are listed below.

Purified by flash column chromatography using dichloromethane. Crystallized from diethyl ether/petroleum ether (60-80). Yield 17%. - cis-2-tert-Butyl-4-(3,4-dimethoxyphenyl)-4a,5,6,7,8,8a-hexahydro-2*H*-phthalazin-1-one (3e) A mixture of γ-keto acid 1a (2.0 g, 6.85 mmol), tert-butylhydrazine hydrochloride (5.0 g, 40.1 mmol) and triethylamine (5.6 mL, 40.3 mmol) in toluene (50 mL) was heated for 20 h in a Dean-Stark apparatus. The reaction mixture was concentrated *in vacuo*, the residue dissolved in ethyl acetate and washed with 1N NaOH, 1N HCl and water. The organic layer was dried over MgSO<sub>4</sub> and the solvents were removed under reduced pressure. The residual oil was purified by flash column chromatography using dichloromethane and the title compound was crystallized from petroleum ether (60-80) at -20 °C. Yield 73%.
