## Synthesis.

**Synthesis of 2-hexylthiophene (1)** n-butyl lithium (2.5M in hexane) (60ml, 0.15mol) was added dropwise to a solution of thiophene (15g, 0.18mol) in 150ml of THF at -78°C. After 45 minutes upon addition, 27g of 1-bromohexane (0.11mol) were added to the solution. The reaction mixture was then warmed to room temperature, stirred for another 3 hours and poured into water. The mixture was extracted with ether, dried over magnesium sulfate, and the solvent evaporated. The compound was purified by vacuum distillation. 24.2g of pure product (colorless liquid) were obtained. **Synthesis of 2-Bromo-5-hexylthiophene (2)** 25.6g of NBS in 50ml of DMF was added dropwise under darkness to a solution of 24g of 2-hexylthiophene in DMF at 0°C.

The reaction mixture was stirred at room temperature for another 10 hours before being poured into water. After extraction with methylene chloride, the organic phase was separated, dried over magnesium sulfate. The pure product (colorless liquid) was obtained through vacuum distillation. **Synthesis of 5,5"-Dihexyl-[2,2';3',2"]terthiophene (3) (3T)** The Grignard reagent formed from 23.5g of 2-Bromo-5-hexyl-thiophene (95mmol) and magnesium was slowly added to a mixture of 2,3-dibromothiophene (40mmol), NidpppCl<sub>2</sub> (0.4mmol), and 100ml ether at 0°C, then warmed to room temperature. The reaction was quenched by dilute HCl after 20 hours. The organic phase was separated, and combined with the ether extraction from the aqueous phase. The solvent was evaporated after drying over magnesium sulfate. The residue was then run though a flash column using hexanes as eluent. Pale yellow viscous liquid was obtained. Synthesis of Tributyl-(5,5"-dihexyl-[2,2";3",2"]terthiophen-5"-yl)stannane (4) BuLi (2.5M in hexane) (6.4ml, 16mmol) was added to a solution of (5,5"-Dihexyl-[2,2";3",2"]terthiophene (6.0g, 14.5mmol) in THF at -78°C. After lithiation, tributyltin chloride (5.2g, 16mmol) was added to the mixture. The reaction was allowed to warm to room temperature for 3 hours. Synthesis of 2,3-di(5,5"-dihexyl-[2,2';3',2"]terthiophen-5'-yl)thiophene (5) (7T) In a one-neck flask was charged 9g of (4), 1.0g of 2,3-dibromothiophene (4mmol), 0.1g of Pd(PPh<sub>3</sub>)<sub>4</sub>, and 30ml of DMF. After three freeze-thaw cycles, the mixture was heated up to 100°C for 20 hours under nitrogen. After cooling to room temperature, the reaction mixture was poured into water, extracted with methylene chloride, and washed thoroughly with KF solution to remove tributyltin chloride. The organic layer was then dried over magnesium sulfate, and the solvent evaporated. The residue was purified by flash column using hexanes/ethyl acetate (10:1) as eluent. **Synthesis of Tributyl-{2,3-di(5,5"-dihexyl-[2,2';3',2"]terthiophen-5'-yl)thiophen -5-yl}stannane (6)** The procedure is the same as with compound (4). This compound was used without further purification. **Synthesis of (8) (6T)** 0.9ml (2.3mmol) of BuLi (2.5M in hexane) was added dropwise to a solution of 0.8g (1.9mmol) of **3T** in THF at -78°C. After stirring at this temperature for another 45 minutes, the mixture was transferred to another flask charged 0.77g (5.7mmol) of CuCl<sub>2</sub> in 10ml of THF at -78°C. The solution was allowed to warm to room temperature and reacted overnight. After normal workup, the residue was purified by flash column using hexanes/ethyl acetate (10:1) as eluent. Synthesis of 4,5,4',5'-Tetrabromo-[3,3']bithiophenyl (10) 2,3-dibromothiophene was lithiated by LDA using 1.65ml of BuLi (2.5M in hexane) and 0.64g of diisopropylamine, then coupled by CuCl<sub>2</sub>. The crude product was run though a short column using hexanes as eluent, and then recrystallized form hexanes. 0.6g of yellow crystals were obtained.
