## Halogen derivatives of toluene under high pressure

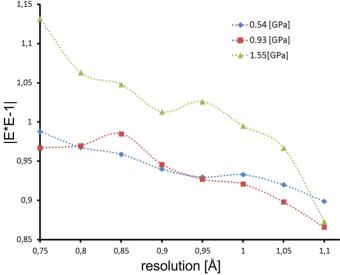
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**DFT calculations in CRYSTAL14.** DFT calculations to obtain the Equation of State (EoS) for 4-fluorotoluene were conducted within the pressure range from 0.1 to 3 GPa. Energy optimization was performed with the use of range-separated hybrid functional LC-wPBESOL. An additional dispersion correction was not included because of the existing parametrizations for weak forces in this type of functionals. A full relaxation of atomic coordinates and unit cell parameters by means of analytical energy gradients was applied. The 6-31G\*\* basis set was used for all elements. This particular basis set was chosen deliberately, because it was recently shown that, in comparison with some larger triple- $\zeta$  basis sets such as 6-311G\*\* and pob-TZVP (in the case of similar small organic compound), computational cost is drastically lower for 6-31G\*\* basis set and the quality of results is very similar.

**4-chlorotoluene, polymorph \beta.** Theoretically possible transformations of P2<sub>1</sub>/n (the  $\beta$  phase) unit cell to P2<sub>1</sub>/c (the  $\alpha$  phase) give the unit cell with parameters significantly different than in the  $\alpha$  phase and completely not comparable. After such transformation, the  $\beta$  angle is equal to ca. 53°, which is rather unexpected and is one of the reasons why the unconventional P2<sub>1</sub>/n cell setting was chosen.

## 4-fluorotoluene, space group.



**Figure 1.**  $|E^2-1|$  statistics as a function of resolution of the X-ray measurement. Figure 1 presents calculations of  $|E^2-1|$  statistics for the X-ray measurements of 4-fluorotoluene (conducted for three different pressures) as function of resolution. Although the  $|E^2-1|$  factor is changing with the lowering resolution of measurement, it still corresponds to the centrosymmetric structure rather than the acentric one. This suggests that in the case of 4-fluorotoluene the Pnma space group is a better choice than  $Pna2_1$ .
