f and q = *Majālis al-naḥā’is* of Navā’ī (897/1492, with some manuscripts updating matters to 904/1499). Consulted here, however, are the Persian translations by Fakhrī Hiratī (*Laṭā’if-nāma*) from 1521 (f), and by Muḥammad bin Mubārak al-Qazvīnī in 927–929/1520–1522 (q). Poets mentioned in the *Majālis al-naḥā’is* only appear on this chart as “f” or “q” if an independent entry was devoted to them. Many poets are mentioned, some frequently (e.g. Ḥāfiẓ, Amīr Khusraw), without receiving an entry. So, for example, “q” mentions ‘Asjadī in the entry on ‘Unṣurī, but does not give him an entry of his own, so no “q” appears for ‘Asjadī in the Navā’ī column. Meanwhile, “f” mentions Firdawsī in a poem at the conclusion of his translation, but has no entry for him.
