Erasmus

Why add funding to your ORCID record?

- Component of your record of contributions
- Easy to share with other funders & publishers
- Long term: link a grant to research outputs

Funding in ORCID

Funding types:

- **Award:** Peer-reviewed funding providing direct research costs through competitions.
- **Contract:** Works commissioned by external public agencies or industry building on research expertise and aimed at deliverables. Include research contracts awarded by federal agencies for both direct and indirect costs, and honoraria. Discussion
- **Grant:** Peer-reviewed funding providing direct research costs through competitions.
- **Salary award:** A competitive, peer-reviewed award that is paid as salary to the awardee/faculty member.

Other required fields:

- Title of the funded project
- Funding agency: name, city, country, identifier – often autopopulated from FundRef Registry

Optional fields:

- Description, funded amount, start & end date, URL
- Grant/contract/award number

Adding funding to your ORCID record

- Using DimensionsWizard (Search & Link Wizard)
- Manually
- Auto-update by the funder (trusted organization)
 - You give the funder permission to add/update the information

 - Database from Digital Science
- Search & Link Wizard in ORCID – give permission
 - Previously called Uberresearch

Note: Name searches are not case sensitive. Also, an entry like 'M Smith' will not bring back 'Mike Smith' so please enter the name as it would have appeared. You may also use the "*" wildcard. For example, 'Mi*' will bring back 'Mike', 'Michael' etc. Only the first 1000 matching grants will be retrieved.
