

Materials and Methods

We reviewed 151 patients treated in our centre with fumaric acid esters (FAEs) for psoriasis between December 2013 and December 2015; 60% were male (91/151), and the age range was 24–89 years (mean 48 years, median 46 years, SD 13 years). In this cohort, 112/151 (74%) remained on treatment for an average of 4.3 years (range 0.2–11.9 years). All patients who are established on FAEs for psoriasis in our centre are reviewed, with laboratory parameters, every 4 months.
