## NOTES

The publishers' caption "Routledge & Co." was in use before November 1858, when George Routledge took his eldest son Robert Warne Routledge into partnership

The publishers' caption "Routledge, Warne, and Routledge" was in use after May 1859, when William Henry Warne died, aged only 37

Between November 1858 and May 1859 the publishers' caption "Routledge, Warnes, and Routledge" was in use

This publication reproduces a book with same title published by David Bogue in 1856, itself borrowed from Julius Bähr's *Die unartigen Kinder*, illustrated by Theodor Hosemann (Berlin, Stuhr'sche Buchh, 1848)

Title and publication information from upper wrapper, which serves as title page, and from lower wrapper publishers' advertisements
