Starting Situation (July 2017):

- Limited quality awareness in terms of publication targeting
- No proper culture of output documentation

Current Situation (February 2021)

- Doubling of peer refereed journal research in ABS 3 and 4 journals (persons and number of papers)
- All staff have ORCID profiles
- AMBA accreditation completed, AACSB accreditation visit being prepared
- Current project: integration of ORCID feed into individual webpages

Research & Innovation Journey with ORCID (5 steps)

1. Creation of an Augmented Journals List

This includes:

- ~30 Journals in addition to ABS list for disciplines where this is appropriate with relevant info such as citation index/ranking
- Supplementary information for ABS listed journals and the journals listed above regarding aspect such as:
 - Turnaround
 - Acceptance rates
 - Number of reviews(still being collected from colleagues as well as web / published resources)

- 2) Creation of a CUBS Research Strategy which forms part of an overall College (Business & Law) strategy
- 3) Creation of a series of research support activities and workshops
e.g. we organised
 - A workshop on impact in Business Schools with Dr Tsekouras, impact manager at the U of Brighton (rated 5th in the UK on impact)
 - A workshop on increasing your citation impact with Dr David O'Connell (UCC, research office)
- 4) Identification of impact case studies [4pg foldout colour brochure]
 - Ongoing discussions with individual departments and RICUs to identify potential areas and case studies for current and future development
- 5) Introduction of ORCID as data collection system to capture, catalogue and classify intellectual contributions (with interface to Academ [Rima One] accreditation software)

Emphasis on Benefits for Faculty

- Improve visibility of research - most publishers now link directly from articles (both HTML and PDF) to ORCID profiles for readers and potential collaborators
- Eliminate need to manually add or verify new publications, where ORCID is given at manuscript submission stage, publications and datasets listed in CrossRef are automatically added to ORCID profiles
- No need to maintain a separate bibliography or biography for UCC: ORCID information can be automatically synchronised with IRIS
- Easier submissions and reporting to Funding Agencies

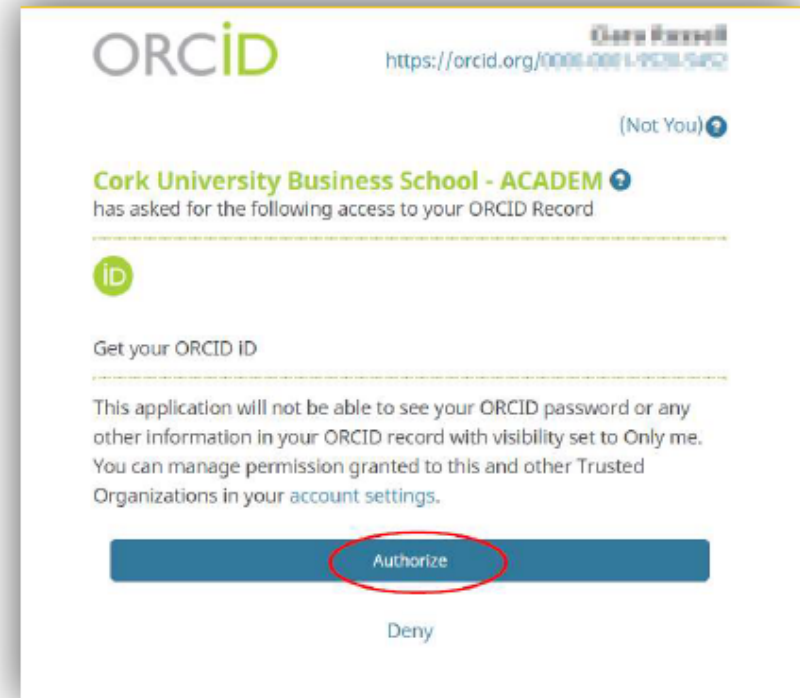













Once you have logged into ORCID you will be shown a page to authorize “*Cork University Business School – ACADEM*”. Please select the “**Authorize**” button.

ORCID Academ Integration

- **Resources:**
 - Dedicated Business School Data Analyst
 - Produced lots of manuals and guides:
 - ‘QRCID Quick Guide’ – 1 page overview
 - ‘ORCID Training Manual’
 - ‘Academ-ORCID Integration Guide’
 - ‘Academ User Manual’
 - Faculty Workshops on using ORCID-Academ
 - One-to-one help for some faculty
 - Dedicated email for all questions, managed by Data Analyst

ORCID Academ Integration

- **Issues:**
 - When importing entries:
 - ‘Search & Link’ using Crossref was the most reliable option
 - Bibtex did not always bring in all the correct data
 - Discouraged manual entry
 - Problems with co-authors not being identified
 - Incomplete data on entries
 - Data coming in duplicates or being mapped incorrectly
 - Some ongoing manual intervention (every contribution is verified)
