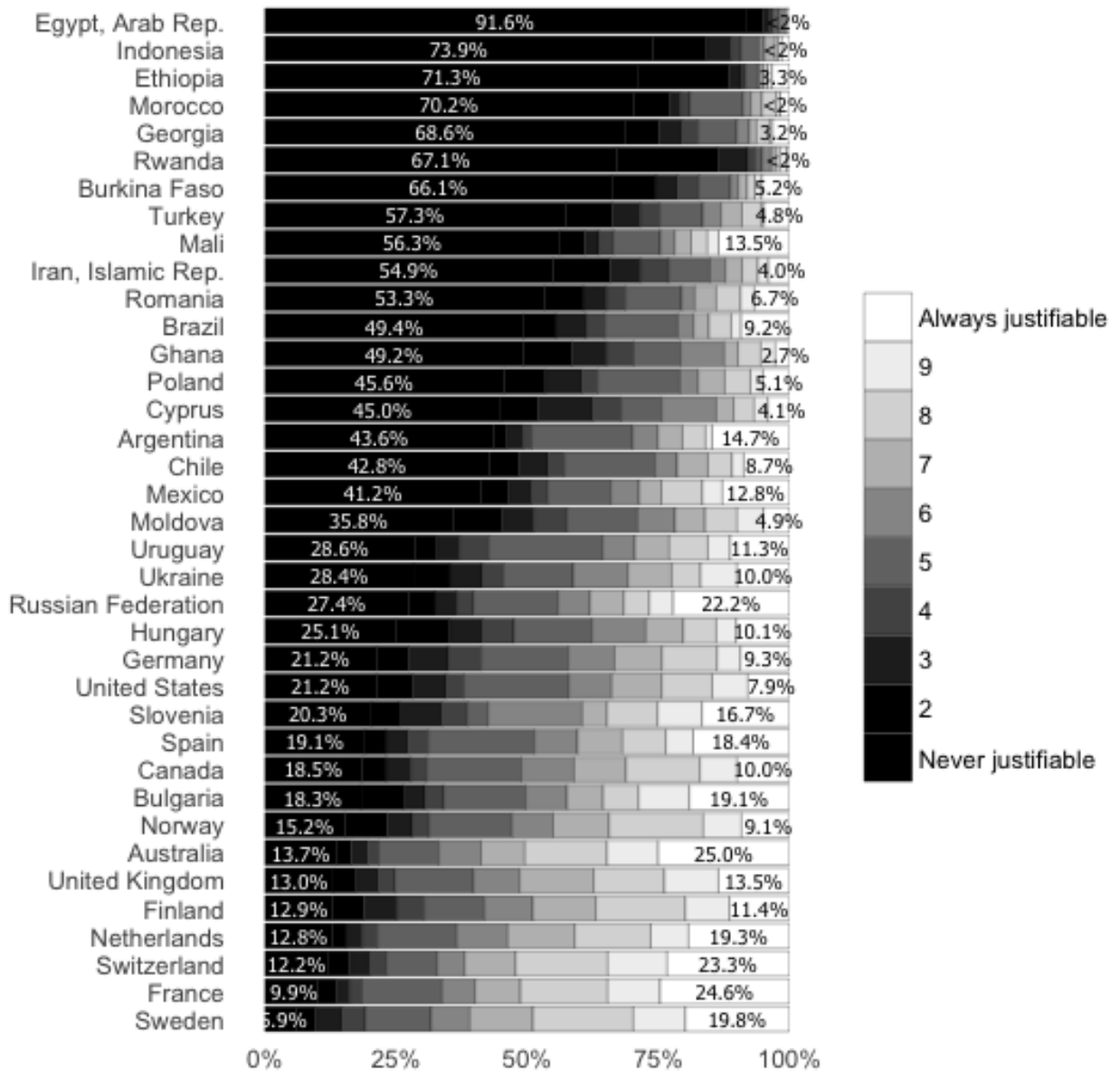


Figure A1. Distribution of answers to the question on the justifiability of euthanasia among the populations of 37 countries.

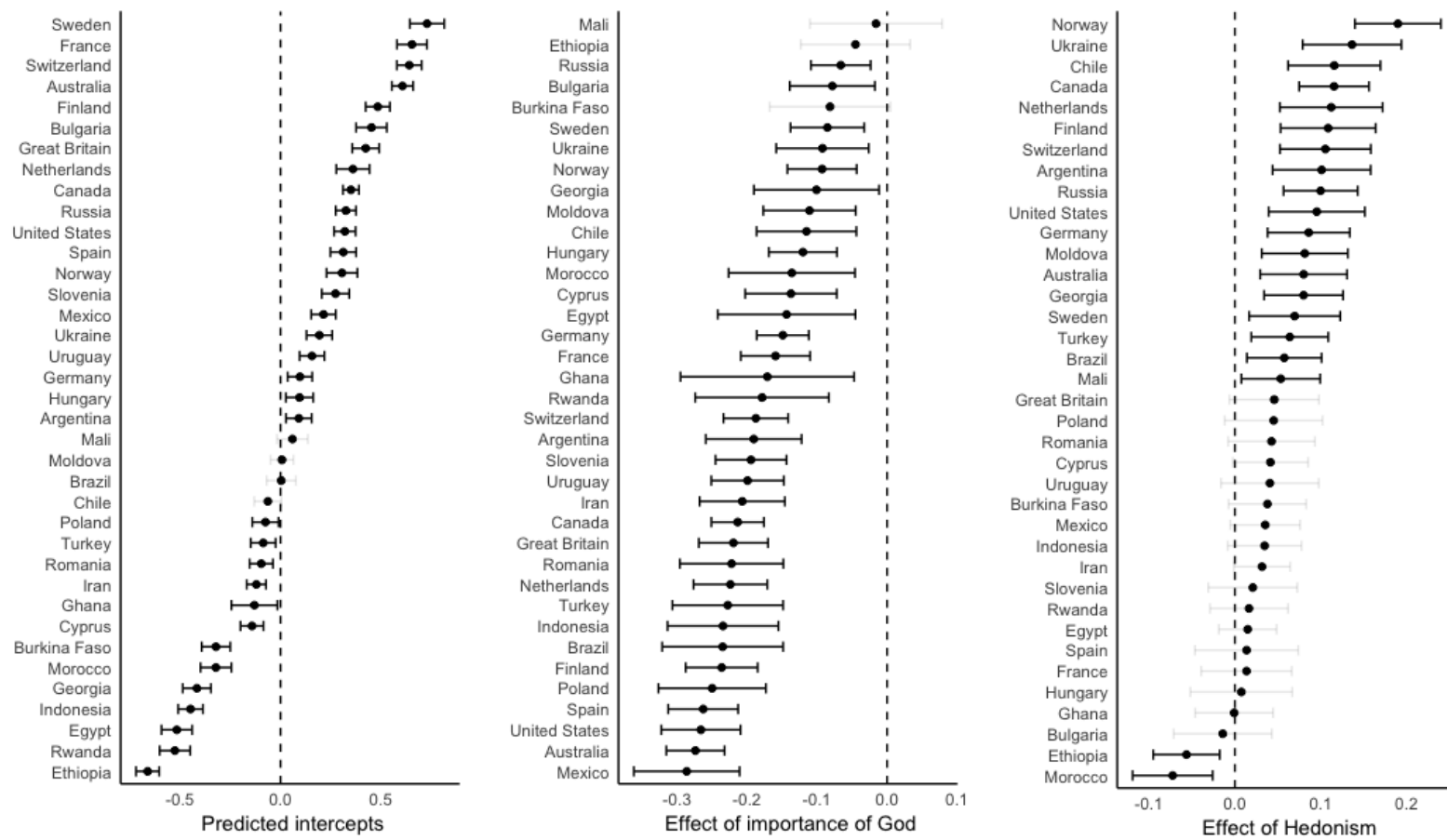
