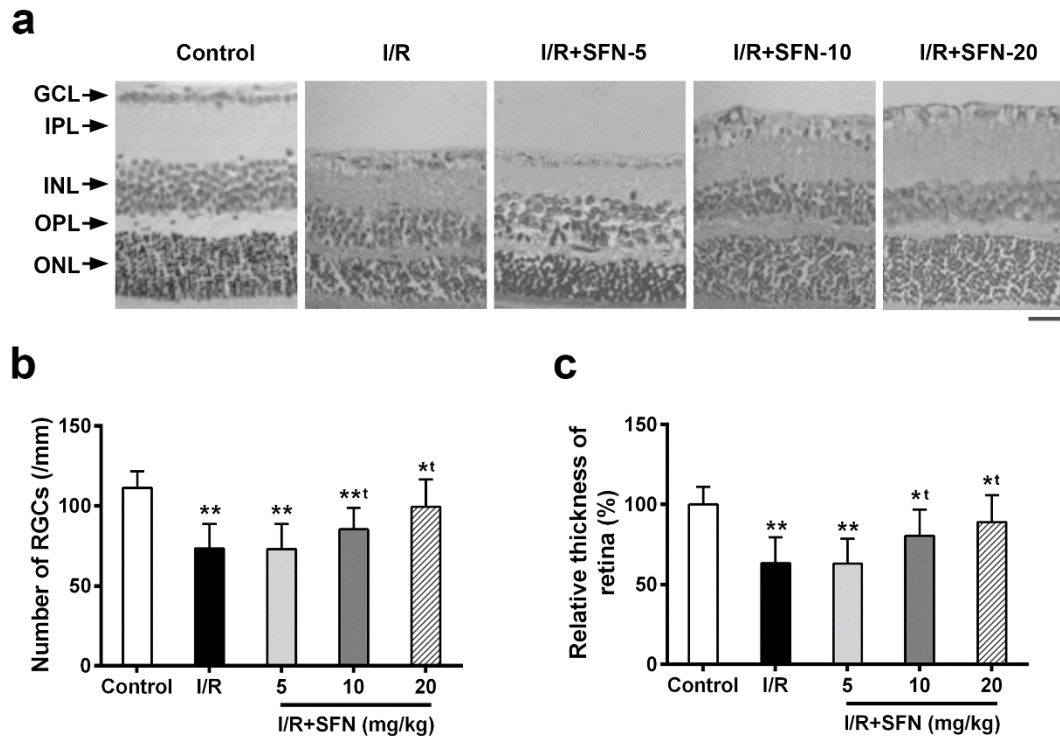

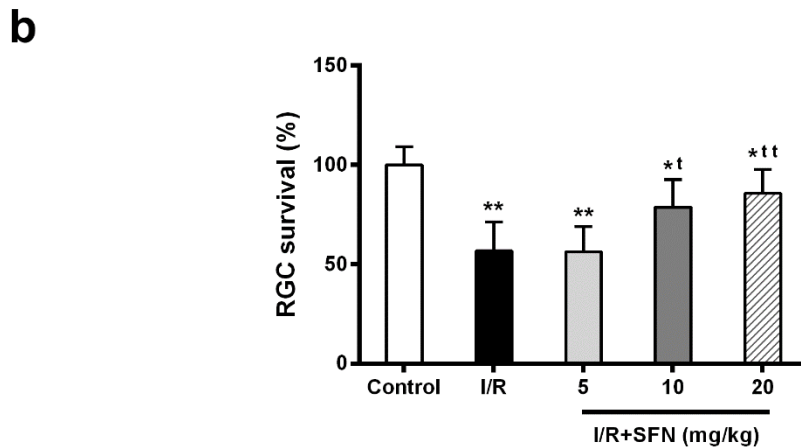
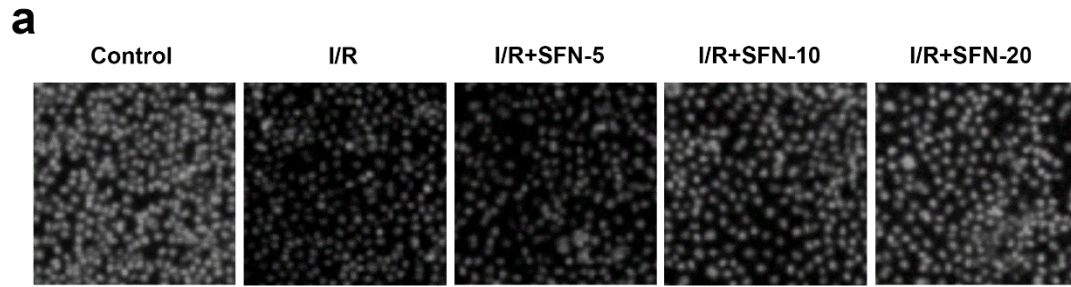

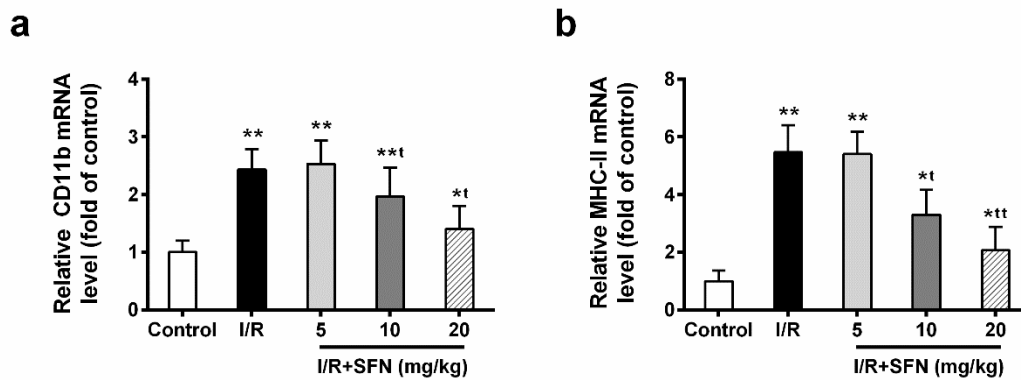


Fig. S3 SFN administration inhibited microglia activation in retinas of I/R rats.
