

Supplemental Table 1: Semi-quantitative severity rating scale using WHO functional classification, echocardiographic findings and cardiac catheterization mean pulmonary arterial (PA) pressures when available. Severity scoring modified from McLaughlin et al. 2006 and Mourani et al. 2008.<sup>1,2</sup>
