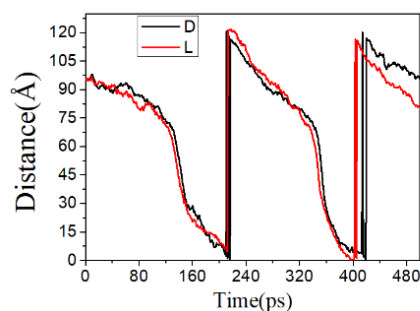


Figure S1. Trajectories of *D*- and *L*-phenylalanine translocating through alanine-free (pure) CNTs with the pore size of 2.0 nm.

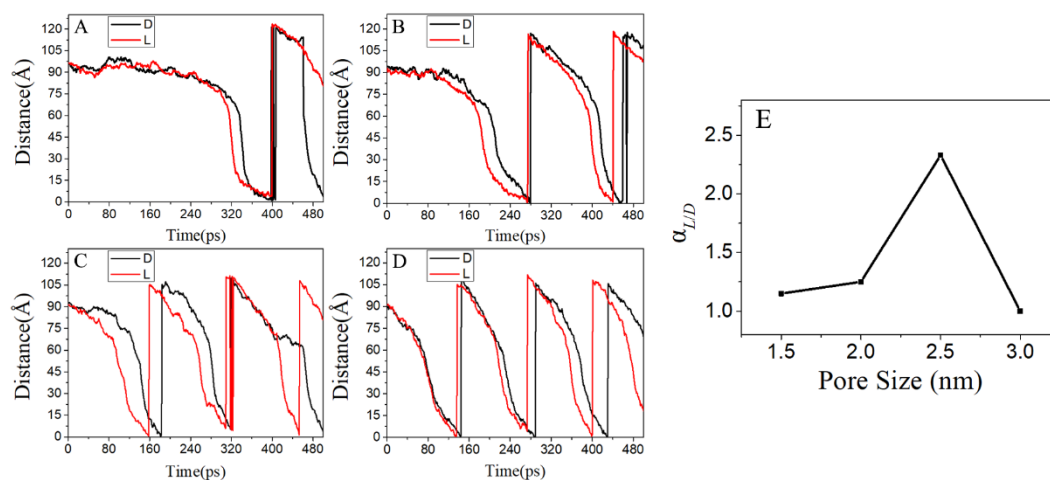


Figure S2. Trajectories of *D*- and *L*-phenylalanine translocating through CNTs,
