

# COVID-19 VACCINE

## What to expect



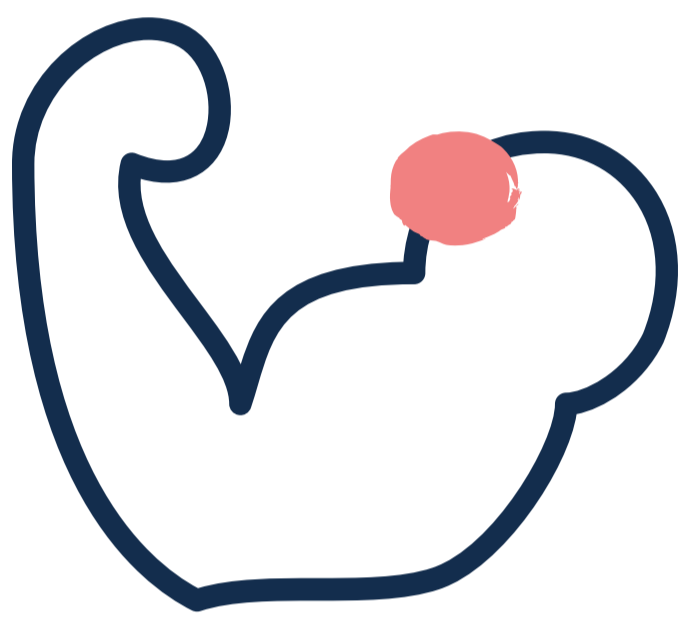
Side effects are typically mild or moderate and last 24-48 hours.

You cannot get the virus from the vaccine. Side effects may actually mean your immune system is activating to protect you, which means it's working.



## Common Side Effects

## Precautions



### Sore arm

Pain & redness near injection site



### Fatigue

Fatigue or tiredness



### Aches & pains

Headaches and muscle or joint pain



### Fever or chills

Drink plenty of fluids to reduce discomfort



### Wait 15 - 30 minutes

After getting vaccinated, you will be asked to wait 15-30 minutes so that healthcare staff are on hand if you experience any immediate side effects. Sites have epinephrine to treat allergic reactions.

If side effects last more than 7 days or worry you, seek medical help.

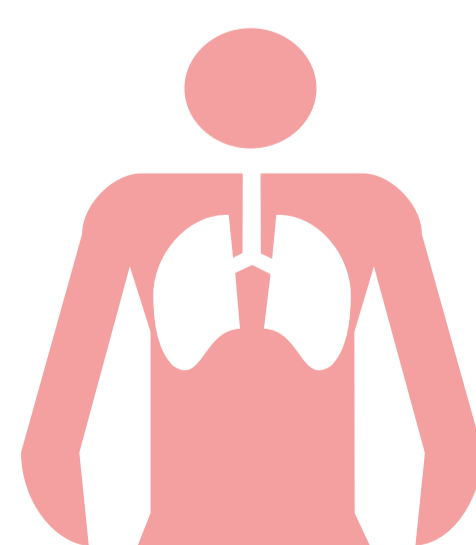
