How advance payment works

Our cheapest tariff is one of the best in the market by making your money work harder.

It's simple, you make one extra payment upfront, on top of your monthly Direct Debit – think of it like paying your deposit and first month's rent together when you move into a new flat

It'll be equivalent to one month's energy use, and means we can buy your energy at cheaper rates, passing the savings on to you. It's an investment, and you'll see the results in no time.

Here's an example...

Meet Mark

Mark's an average energy user on a standard tariff. He's compared prices online and decides to switch to Direct Debit Advance to get a better deal.

He signs up on the 1st of the month, to start the process of switching, and chooses the 27th of the month for his regular Direct Debit. We'll take his automatic upfront payment around 20 days after he signs up and his first Direct Debit follows on the 27th. The switch will usually happen around a month after sign-up.



So Mark makes two payments in the month before his supply goes live, and clears his balance with his previous supplier. It's an unusual month, but he know's he's going to start saving in no time. If he decides to leave or change tariff at any time then we'll refund the credit on his account.





Getting to grips with your rates

Your tariff is made up of a basic daily rate, or 'standing charge', and one or more 'unit rate' for the energy that you use.

You can find your gas and electricity rates over the page. Your gas prices are shown in the first table and they're the same across the UK.

Your electricity prices are a little more complex. First you need to locate your area of the UK on the map, then look at the corresponding row in the table opposite. Most of you will be looking for the results from the first two columns. If you've got an'E7' or Economy 7 meter then see the next three columns, as you'll have a different unit rate at night than during the day.

All our prices are exclusive of VAT at 5%.

Dual Fuel Discount:

All customers who qualify for the dual fuel discount will receive annual discounts of £12 (incl. VAT) per fuel. These discounts are deducted proportionately on a daily basis.

Principal Terms

- 1. This is a variable tariff.
- 2. This is an online, dual-fuel, Direct Debit tariff.
- 3. All communications will be sent electronically.
- The 'advance' element means you will pay two payments in your first month.
 One to cover your upfront payment and the second which will be your normal monthly Direct Debit.
- 5. Your Direct Debit is calculated by estimating your consumption for a year and dividing it by 12 to get a monthly amount.
- 6. Once you've been on supply for a minimum of six months, we'll review your Direct Debit to make sure you're paying the right amount.
- 7. Regular meter reads really help (one per month would be ideal).

- 8. If you join us in the winter months, your Direct Debit will be higher to cover the extra energy that most people use over these months.
- 9. If your payment is due to change, we'll be sure to give you at least ten working days' notice so that you can plan ahead.
- 10. We'll supply you with a electronic statement every three months in your online account so you can keep track of things.
- 11. You can terminate at any time giving us 28 days' notice. There are no exit penalties.
- 12. We will notify you at least 30 days in advance if our prices are going up
