

Now that you've received your COVID-19 vaccine, GET YOUR DIGITAL VACCINE RECORD



What is a Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record (DCVR)?

DCVR is an electronic record that shows the same information as your paper CDC vaccine card.

What information does the DCVR include?

The DCVR has your name, date of birth, vaccination dates, and the vaccine brands you received.

Where do I access my Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record?

Visit myvaccinerecord.cdph.ca.gov to access your record. You will need to enter your first and last name, date of birth, and mobile number or email address. You will create a PIN which will be required to obtain your DCVR when the link to your record is provided to you.

When will my vaccine dose be available in my digital vaccine record?

We recommend waiting 7 days for your dose to show up in the system.

What if I get another shot?

If you receive an additional dose or booster dose, it will not automatically reflect on your digital vaccine record. Simply revisit the Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record portal to retrieve a new QR code.

Can I use my DCVR instead of my physical vaccine card?

Yes. You can present your DCVR anywhere that asks for proof of COVID-19 vaccination, along with a government-issued ID. Using the DCVR is optional.
