





# THE 2021 MASTERS COURSE: BUSINESS & HUMAN RIGHTS

Implementing the Responsibility to Respect

Rafto Roundation for Human Rights, University of Bergen, Department of Comparative Politics, and the Institute for Human Rights and Business present:

Masters-level course exploring the links between human rights risks and corporate activity and the importance of international standards in strengthening respect for and protection of human rights.

#### Features:

- Taught by a faculty of global experts from the worlds of business, academia and civil society.
- Case studies in a range of industries, delivered by business experts.
- Hear first-hand experience of human rights defenders.
- Discussion and analysis with business professionals on possible **solutions to human rights challenges** facing companies.
- **Explore dilemmas** where local standards and rules vary from and sometimes contradict global standards or policies.
- Develop strong, **sophisticated approaches** based on assessment **methods and tools companies** use for human rights due diligence.

### Content:

- Ethical and legal standards, duties, and expectations of companies.
- Practical guidance for developing corporate strategies and due diligence consistent with international human rights standards.
- Sector-specific and thematic issues on the human rights and business agenda, including issues of contemporary relevance such as operating during pandemics and dealing with challenges of technology.
- Effectiveness of existing and proposed national and international standards, both mandatory and voluntary.

Course themes are driven in part by topical issues in business and human rights - details of 2021 curriculum will be announced early summer.

- Online over 4 weekends: 17-19 Sept, 15-17 Oct, 12-14 Nov, 26-28 Nov 2021
- A mixture of lectures, group work, and mandatory written assignments
- Available to masters students, professionals and anyone interested in business and human rights (15 ECTS)
