THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

The Forestry (Alabitaia Protected Forest) Order in
Council, 1950.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chiefs and Tribal Authorities of the Wara Wara Yagala and Dembelia Musaia Chiefdoms, Koinadugu District, Northern Province.

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Alabitaia Protected Forest) Order in Council, 1950.

2. The lands described in the schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

All that piece of land comprising 9,763 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Wara Wara Yagala and Dembelia Musaia Chiefdoms in the Koinadugu District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:-

EAST

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1, which is situated on the western side of the motor road from Kabala to Musaia about 615 feet to the north of milestone 80; thence by the said motor road north-eastwards for a distance of about 540 feet to Boundary Mark No. 2, which is situated at the junction of the road with the footpath to Belandugu Village; then by the said footpath in a north-westerly direction for a distance of about 6,000 feet to Boundary Mark No. 3, which is situated on the right bank of an unnamed stream; thence by the right bank of the said stream upstream for a distance of about 3,360 feet; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 33 degrees for a distance of about 140 feet to Boundary Mark No. 4, which is situated on the west side of the footpath from Belandugu to Madogbo; thence by the said footpath in a northerly direction for a distance of about 2,000 feet to Boundary Mark No. 5, which is situated on the left bank of the Turkeware stream; thence by the left bank of the said stream downstream in a northerly direction for a distance of about 6,700 feet to Boundary Mark No. 6; thence

NORTH

by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 257 degrees for a distance of about 7,110 feet to Boundary Mark No. 7, which is situated on the south-eastern side of the footpath from Madogbo to Samamaia; thence by the said footpath in a south-westerly direction for about 14,540 feet to Boundary Mark No. 8; thence
