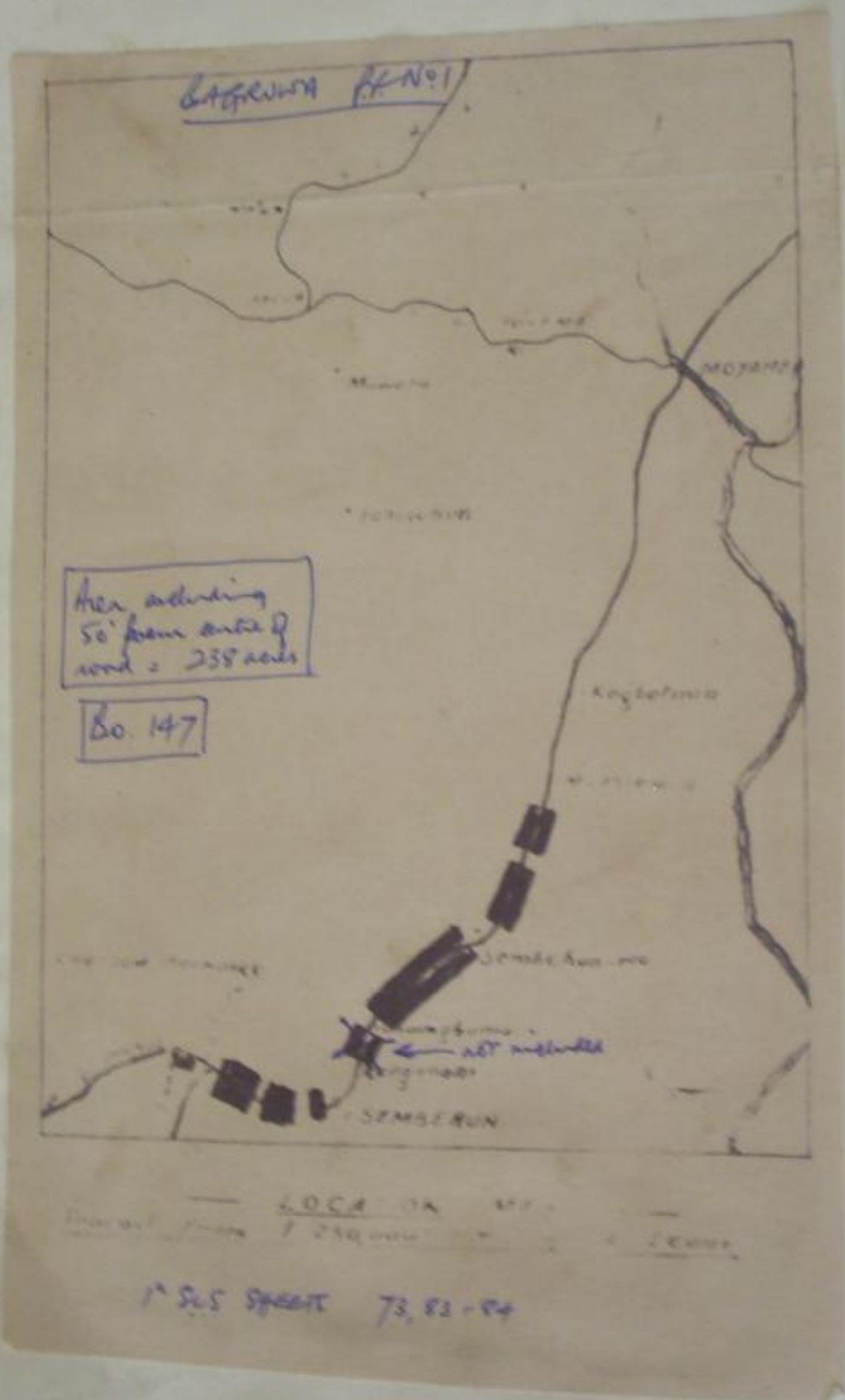


BAGRUWA N.A.

(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (BAGRUWA PROTECTED FOREST NO. 1)
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Bagruwa Chiefdom, Moyamba District, South-western Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Bagruwa Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1960.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 238 acres or thereabouts lying within 220 feet on either side from the centre of the motor road from Moyamba to Shenge in the Bagruwa Chiefdom in the Moyamba District of the South-western Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone starting about 2,951 feet measured along the centre of the motor road in the direction of Shenge from Milestone 11 and ending on the southern side of the road at the Kagboro Chiefdom boundary, and on the northern side of the road at about 2,700 feet east of the Kagboro Chiefdom boundary, provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest—

- (i) 50 feet on either side of the centre of the road and
- (ii) those shown in the following table:—
