

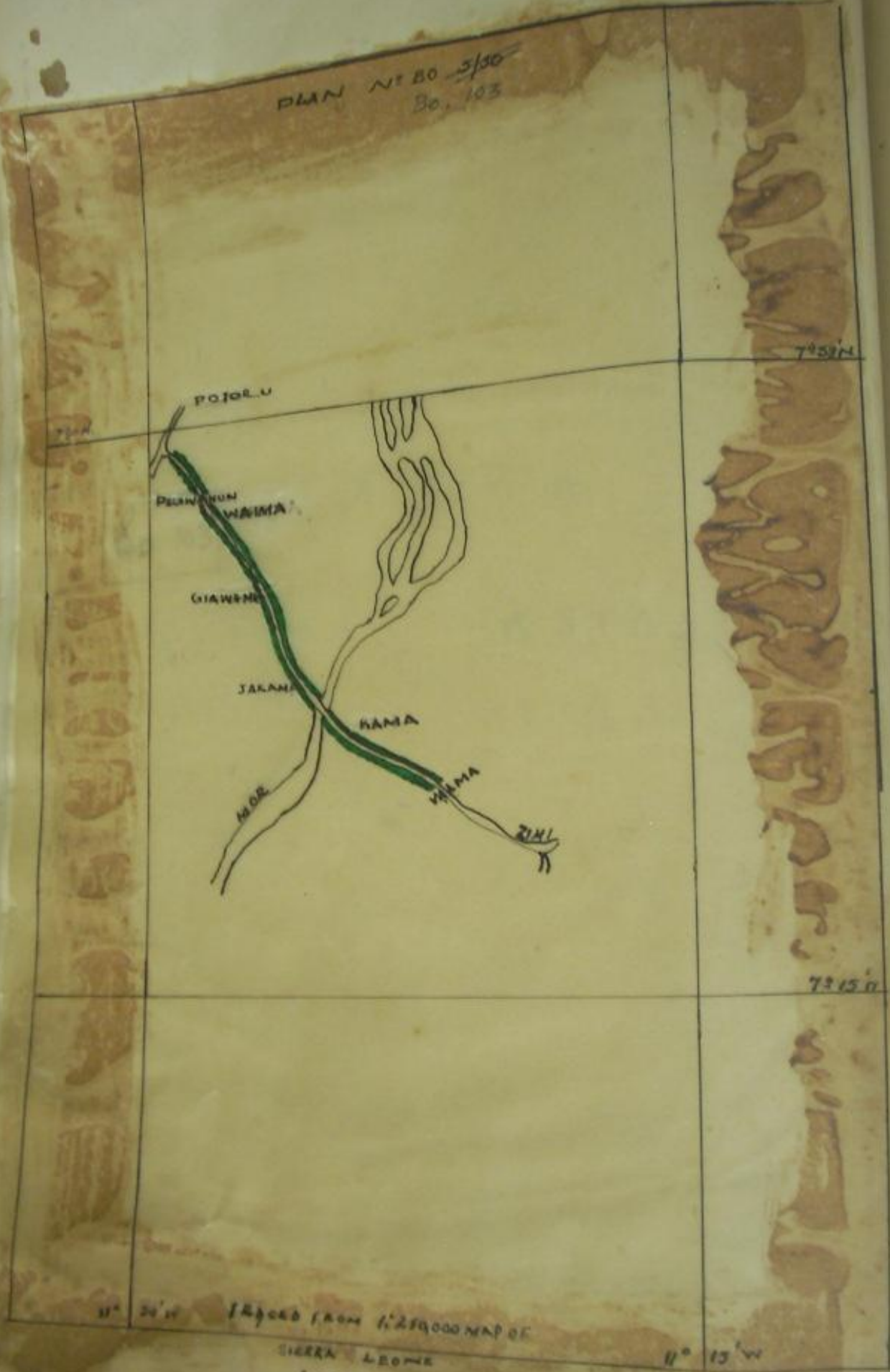

THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (BARI PROTECTED FOREST NO. 1) ORDER
IN COUNCIL, 1952

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority of the Bari Chieftdom, Pujehun District, South-western Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Bari Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1952.

2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OR PARCEL OF LAND comprising 243 acres or thereabouts lying within 220 feet on either side of the centre of the motor road from Potoru to Zimmi and bounded by a cleared trace commencing on the left hand side about 500 feet and on the right hand side about 1,150 feet in a South-easterly direction from milestone 35 and ending about 90 feet in a South-easterly direction from milestone 49 at the Majai River.

Provided that the following areas shall be excluded from the Protected Forest:—

- (i) Between points distant about 580 feet and 680 feet on the east side from the starting point measured in a south-easterly direction which includes an unnamed swamp.
- (ii) Between points distant about 2,030 feet and 7,470 feet on the east side from the starting point measured in a south-easterly direction which includes Maisala Village and the Mapui Stream.
