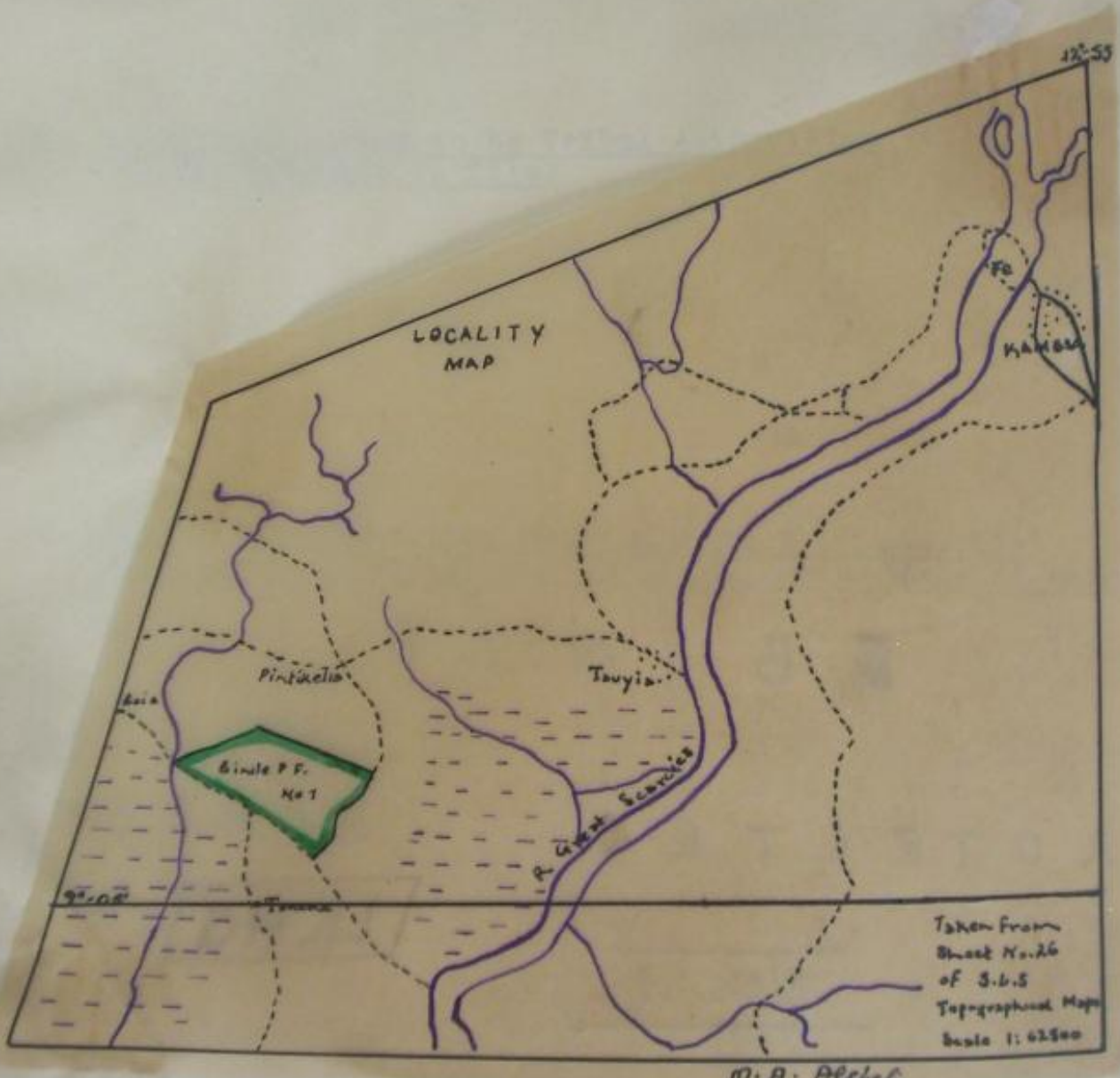

*THE FORESTRY ORDINANCE*  
(Cap. 86)

THE FORESTRY (BINLE PROTECTED FOREST NO. 1)  
ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1956

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, the following Order is hereby made at the request of the Tribal Authority, Gbinle-Dixing Chiefdom, Kambia District, Northern Province:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Binle Protected Forest No. 1) Order in Council, 1956.
2. The lands described in the Schedule to this Order, are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT PIECE OF LAND, comprising 224.79 acres or thereabouts, situated in the Gbinle-Dixing Chiefdom in the Kambia District of the Northern Province of the Protectorate of Sierra Leone and bounded as follows:—

*EAST—*

Starting from Boundary Mark No. 1 which is a stone cairn situated on the western side of the hammock trail from Pintigili to Kaleyiray at a point about 0.33 chains in a southerly direction from the junction of the above-named hammock trail with that from Robis to Kaleyiray; thence by the westerly side of the hammock trail from Pintigili to Katalan for a distance of about 45.63 chains in a southerly direction to Boundary Mark No. 2; thence by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately 232° 00' for a distance of about 12.62 chains to Boundary Mark No. 3, which is situated on the northerly side of the hammock trail from Katalan to Laia; thence

*SOUTH—*

by the northerly side of the above-named hammock trail for a distance of about 59.52 chains in a north-westerly direction to Boundary Mark No. 4; thence

*WEST*—  
by the south-easterly side of a swamp to Boundary Mark No. 5 on a bearing of approximately  $71^{\circ} 00'$  and distant about 30.00 chains, measured in a straight line, from Boundary Mark No. 4; thence

*NORTH*—  
by a demarcated line cut on a bearing of approximately  $98^{\circ} 30'$  for a distance of about 52.61 chains to Boundary Mark No. 1 which is the starting point.

As the same is more particularly delineated on Plan No. BA. 41 in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests and of the Divisional Forest Officer, Batkanu, and is shown thereon verged GREEN.

*Note:*

- (1) All bearings given above are magnetic bearings taken in the year 1951.
- (2) All distances given above are in Gunter's chains of 66 feet.
- (3) All Boundary Marks given above are stone cairns.
- (4) Demarcated lines mentioned above are cleared traces marked at salient points by stone cairns.
