DRAFT ORDER

The Forestry Ordinance, 1924.
(Cap. 74)

Forestry (Buspe Protected Forest No. 3) Order in Council, 1946

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 14 of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924, the following order is hereby made at the request of the Paramount Chief and Tribal Authority of the Buspe Chiefdom:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Forestry (Buspe Protected Forest No. 3) Order in Council, 1946.
2. The lands described in the schedule to this Order are hereby constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Ordinance, 1924.

SCHEDULE.

All that land which lies within 210 feet on either side from the centre of the motor road between Matru junction and Sabaya. Land within these areas occupied by existing houses and compounds, sacred bush and swamps shall be excluded.
