

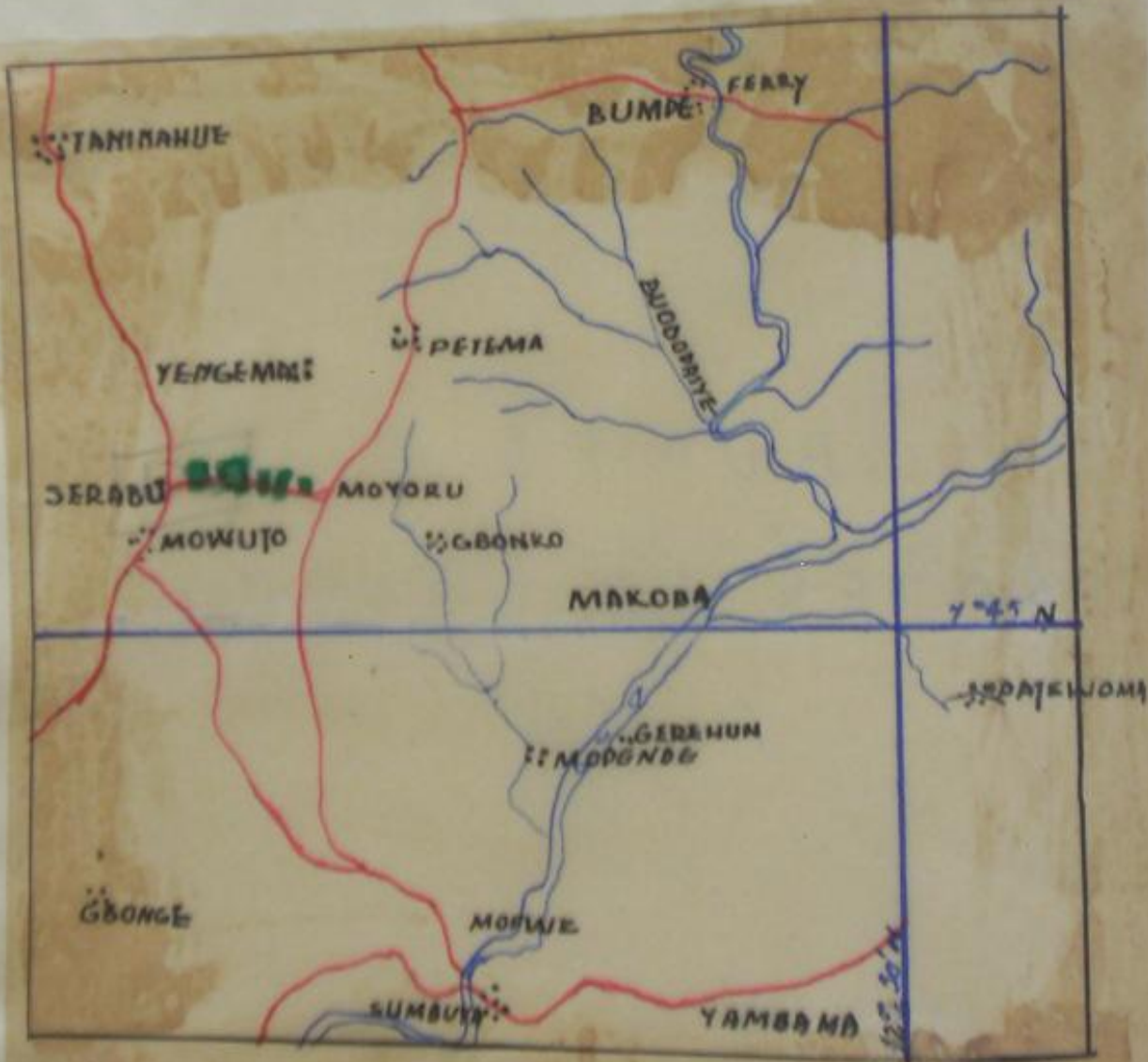

(Cap. 189)

THE FORESTRY (BUMPE NO. 4 PROTECTED FOREST) ORDER, 1970 Short title.

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 14 of the Forestry Act, the Chiefdom Council of Bumpé Chiefdom in the Bo District of the Southern Province of Sierra Leone have requested that the land described in the Schedule hereto be constituted a Protected Forest within the meaning of the Forestry Act:

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 14 of the aforesaid Act, the Governor-General acting in accordance with the advice of the Minister of Agriculture and Natural Resources hereby makes the following Order:—

1. The land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby constituted a Protected Forest.
2. The Forestry (Bumpé Native Administration Protected Forest No. 4) Order, 1950 is hereby revoked.

THE SCHEDULE

ALL THAT LAND comprising 110 acres or thereabouts in the Bumpé Chiefdom of Bo District in the Southern Province of Sierra Leone, lying on the right hand side of the centre of the motor road from Moyoru Village to Serabu, proceeding from Moyoru to Serabu, and bounded by a cleared trace starting at a point 660 feet from the junction of the said Moyoru to Serabu motor road with the Bo to Matru motor road, ending at a point 79 feet from where the road to Sengima Village branches off the Moyoru to Serabu road and contained in five blocks as follows:
